The Representation of the People Act 1983 (as amended by the Electoral Registration and Administration Act 2013) introduced a The Representation of the People Act 1983 (as amended by the Electoral Registration and Administration Act 2013) introduced a compulsory duty for all parliamentary polling districts and polling places to be reviewed every five years. Such a compulsory review in North Tyneside fell due to take place in a period commencing not earlier than 1 October 2023, and public notice of the review was therefore published on 3 October 2023.

This report sets out the Returning Officer's final proposals for polling districts and polling places arising from the compulsory review having considered all responses received during consultation undertaken during the review process.
