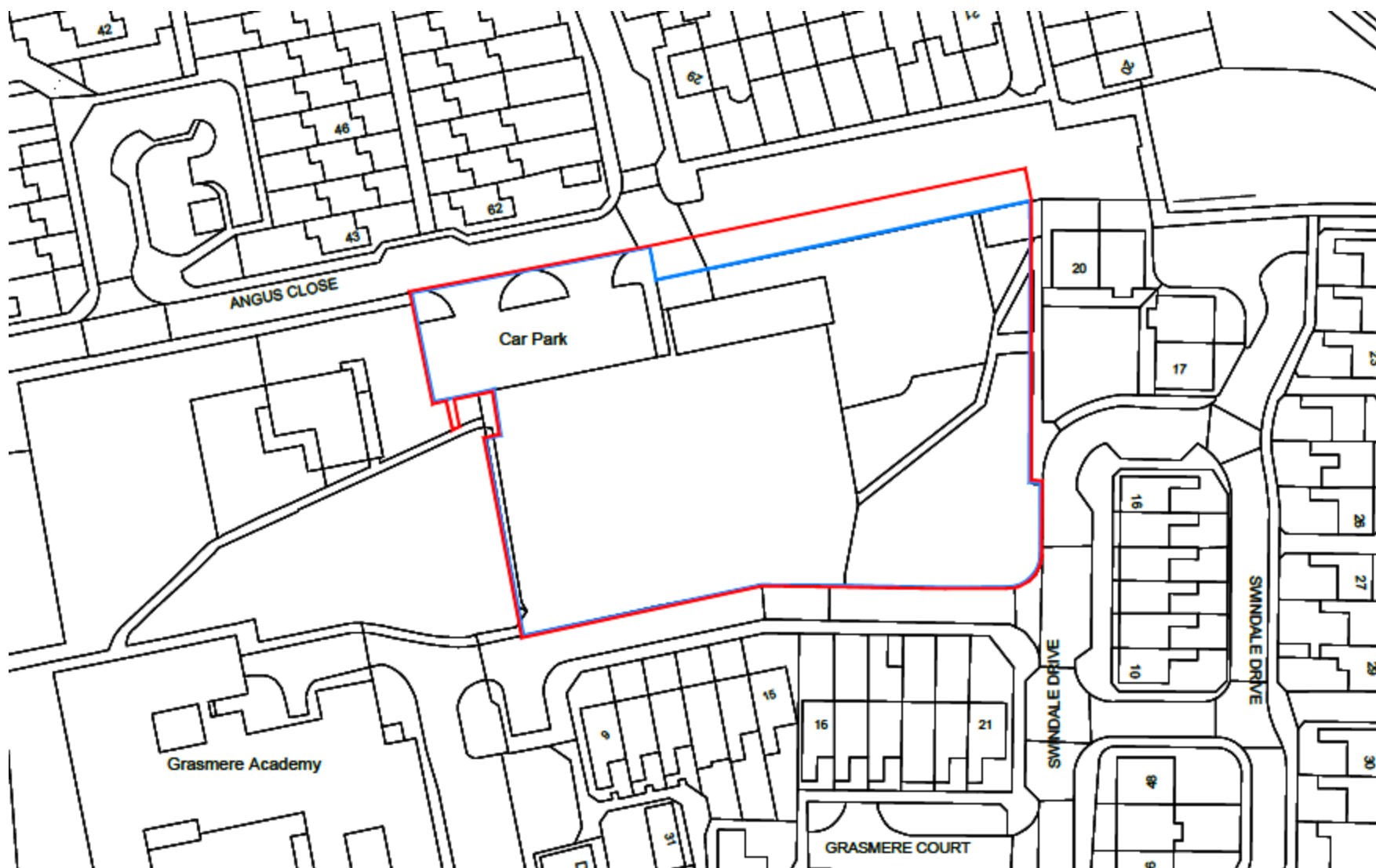

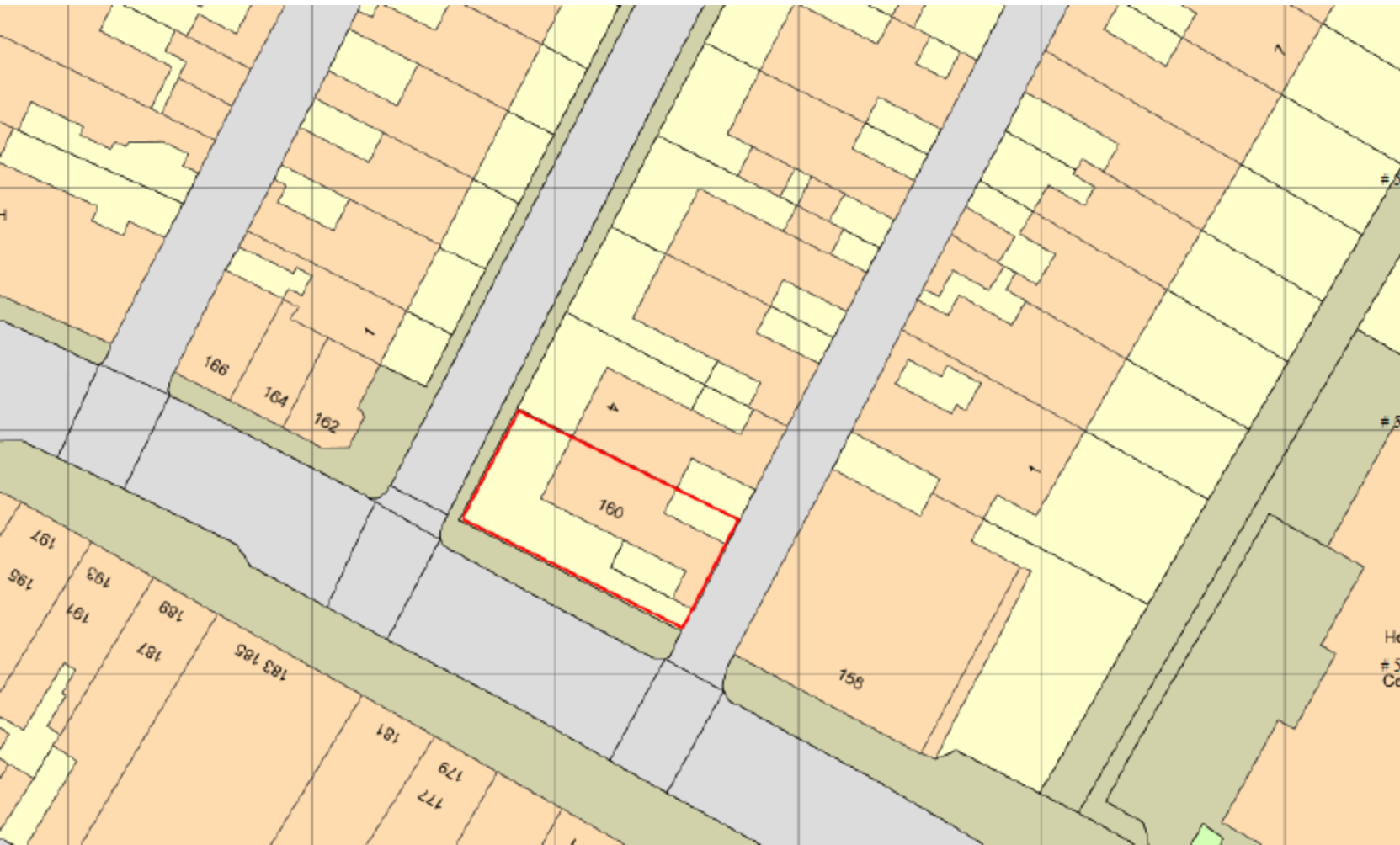

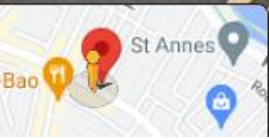

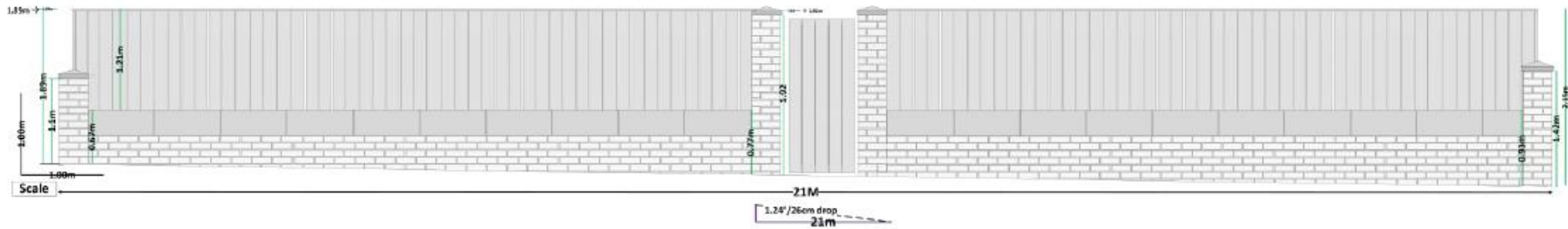

Aspect from Whitley Road. Percy Road on left



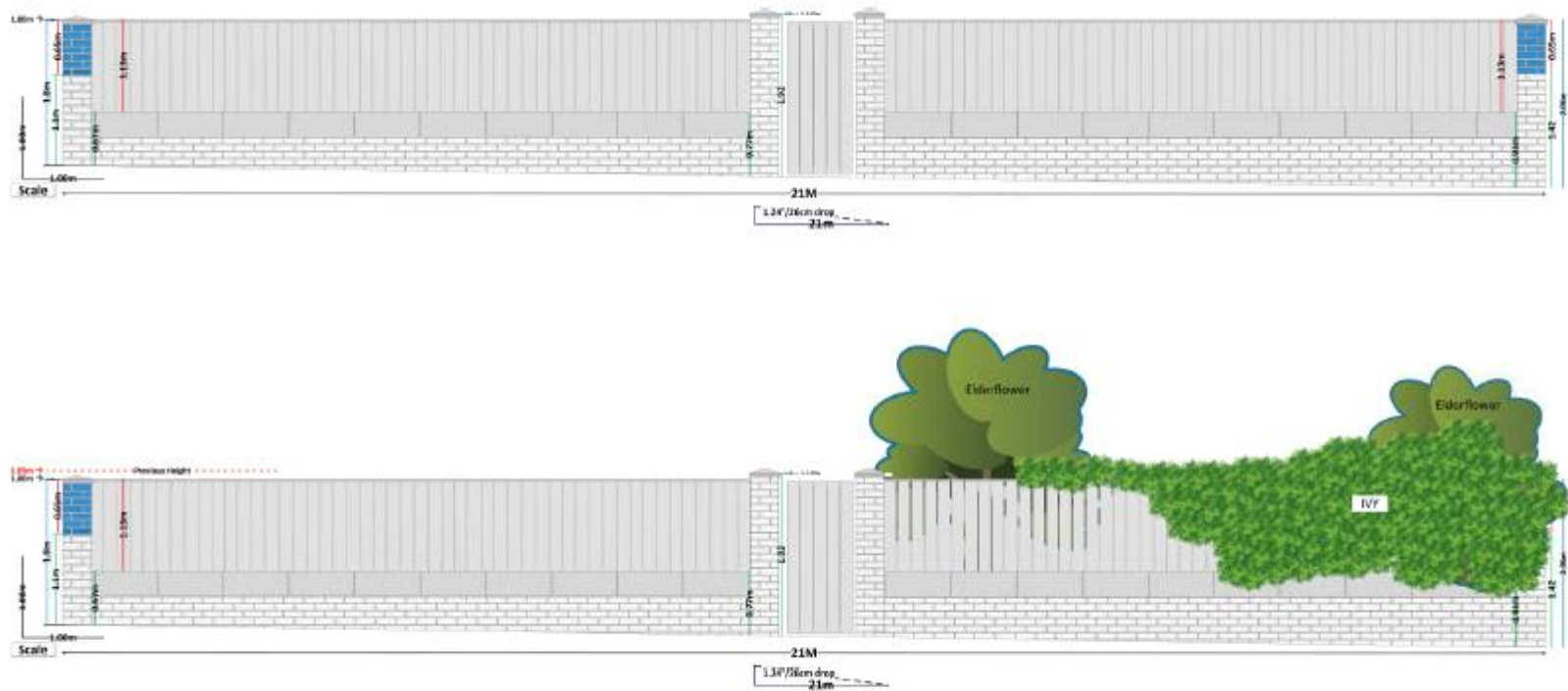

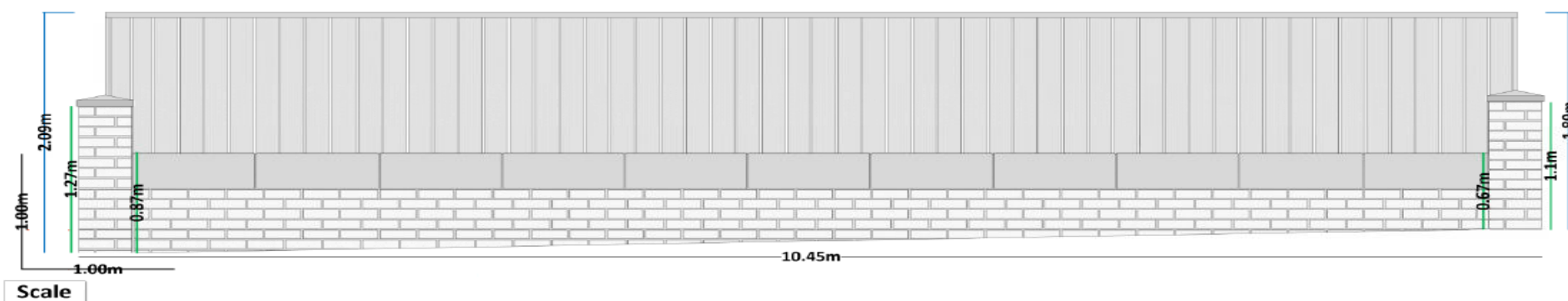
# Whitley Road Perimeter (Proposed)

Aspect from Whitley Road. Percy Road on left

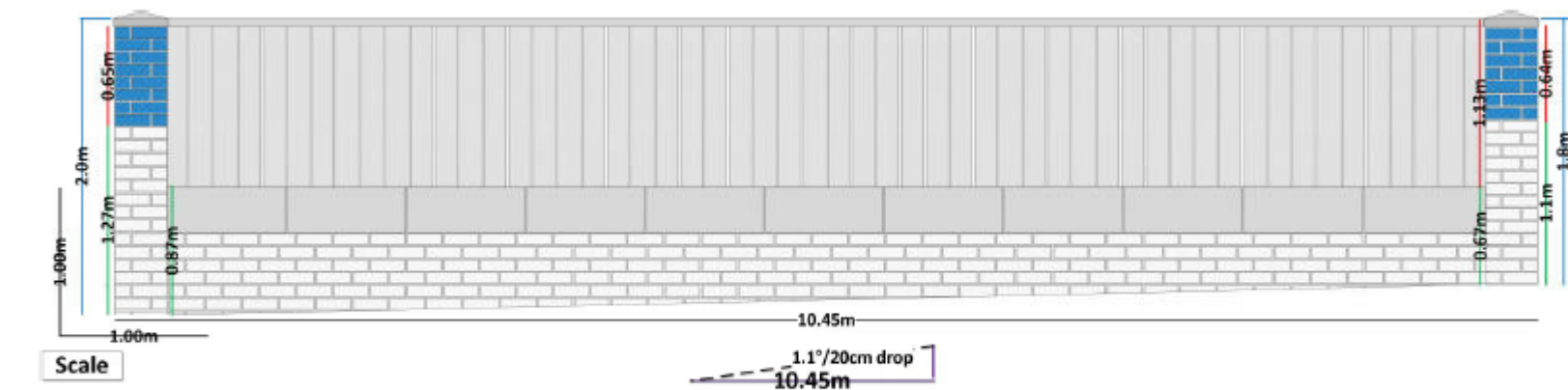

There is a 20cm drop in the ground height from right (Whitley Rd junction) to left

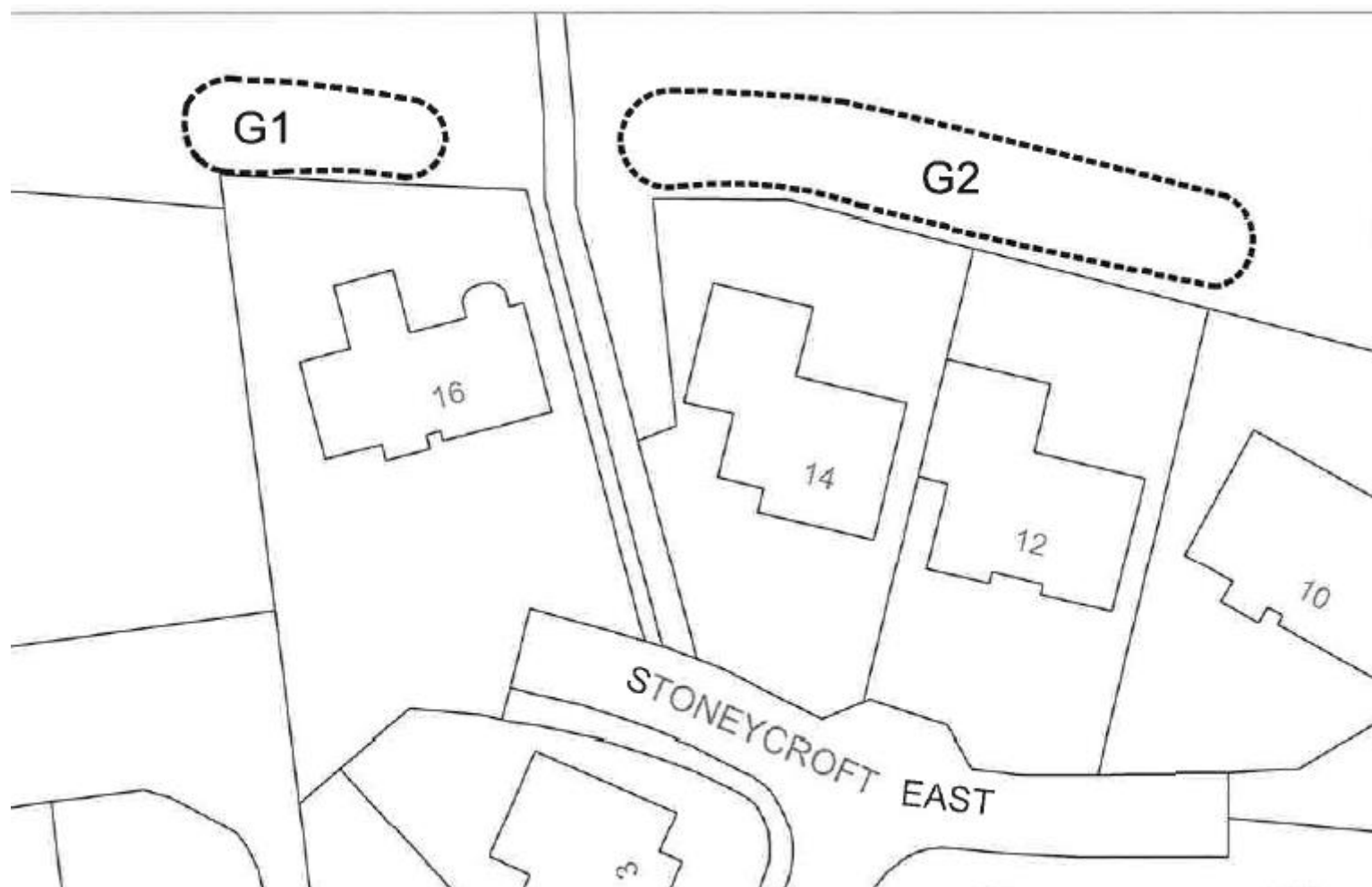
