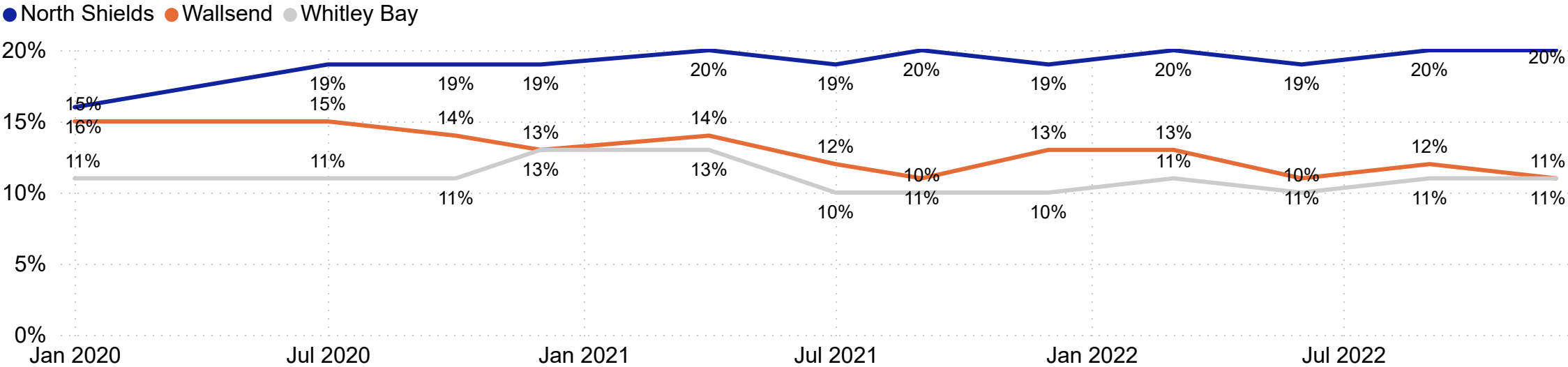

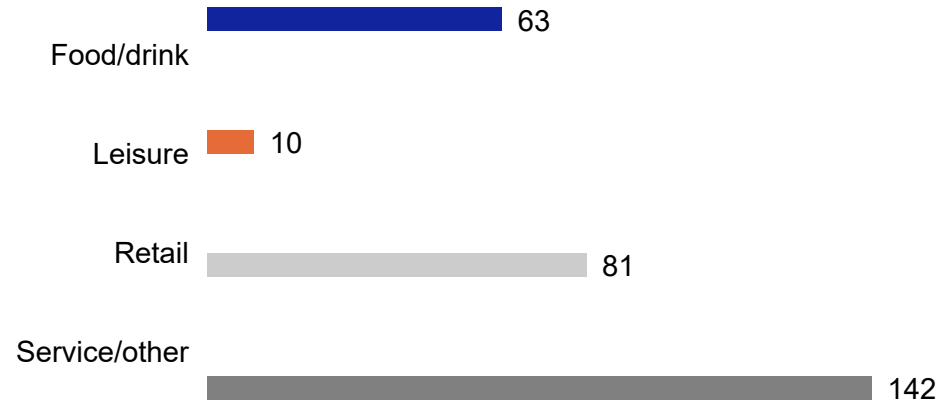

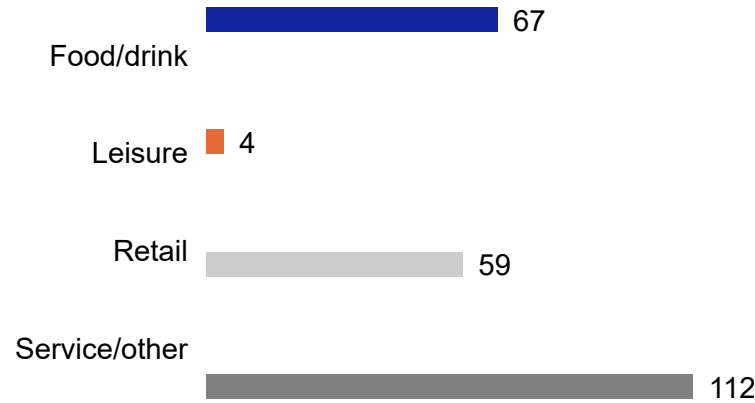

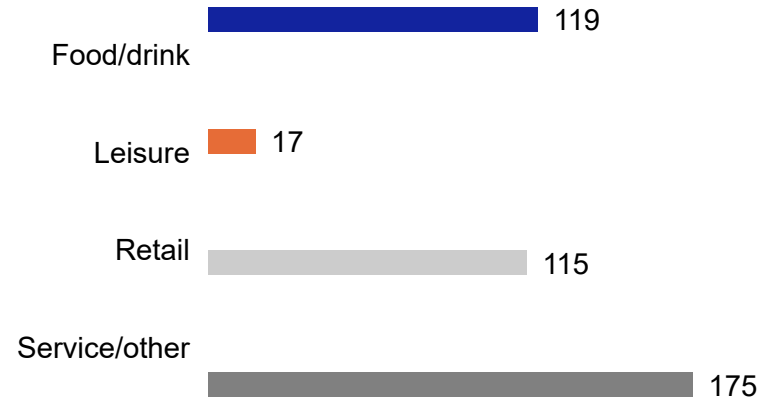

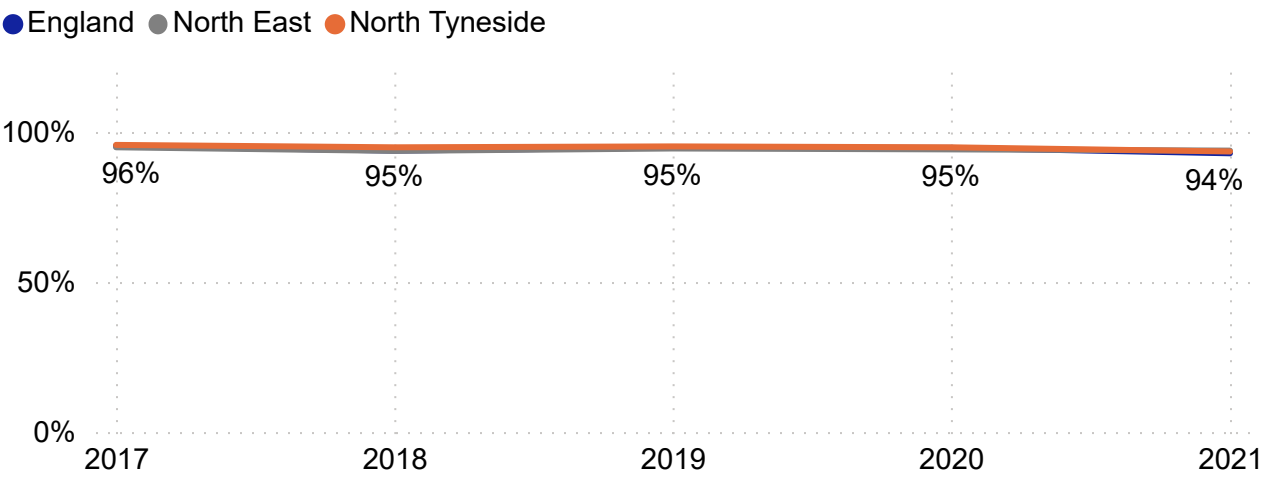

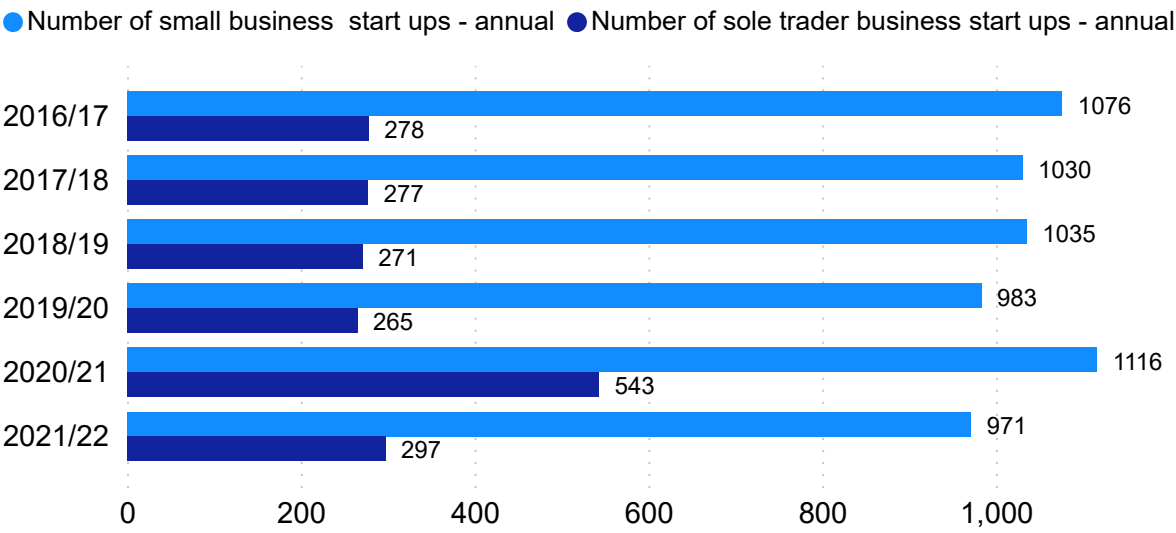

New businesses surviving for one year after being started



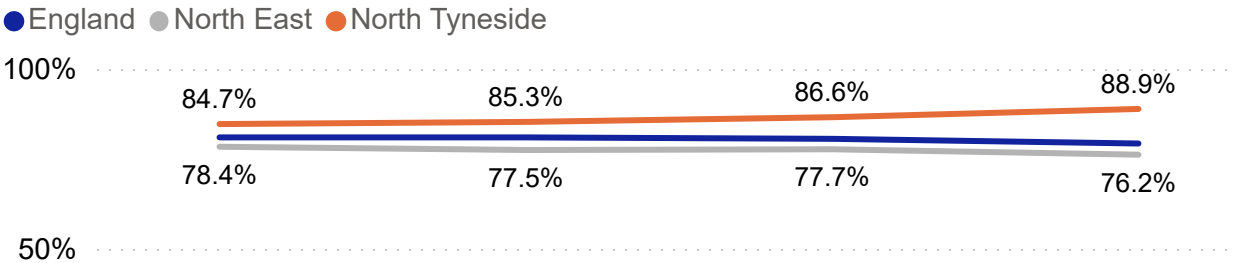

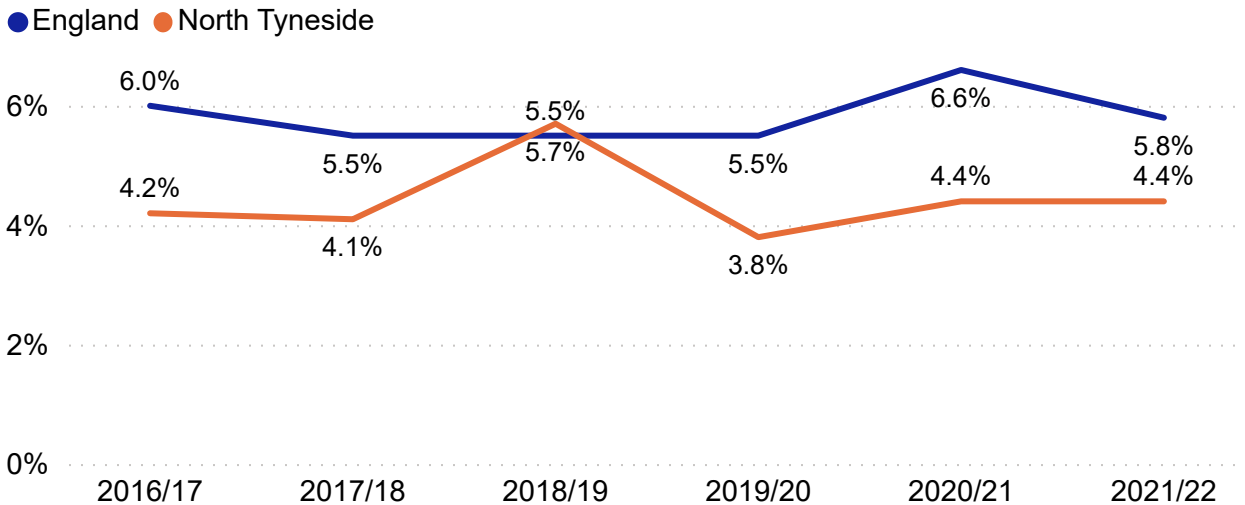

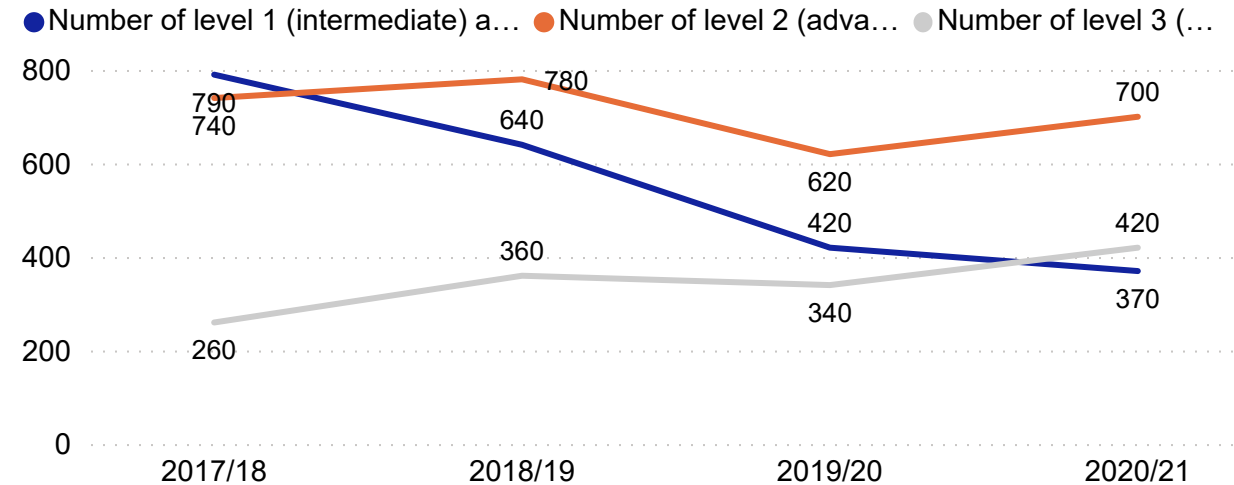
Positive destination, post Key Stage 5 (A level) - proportion in work, education or training



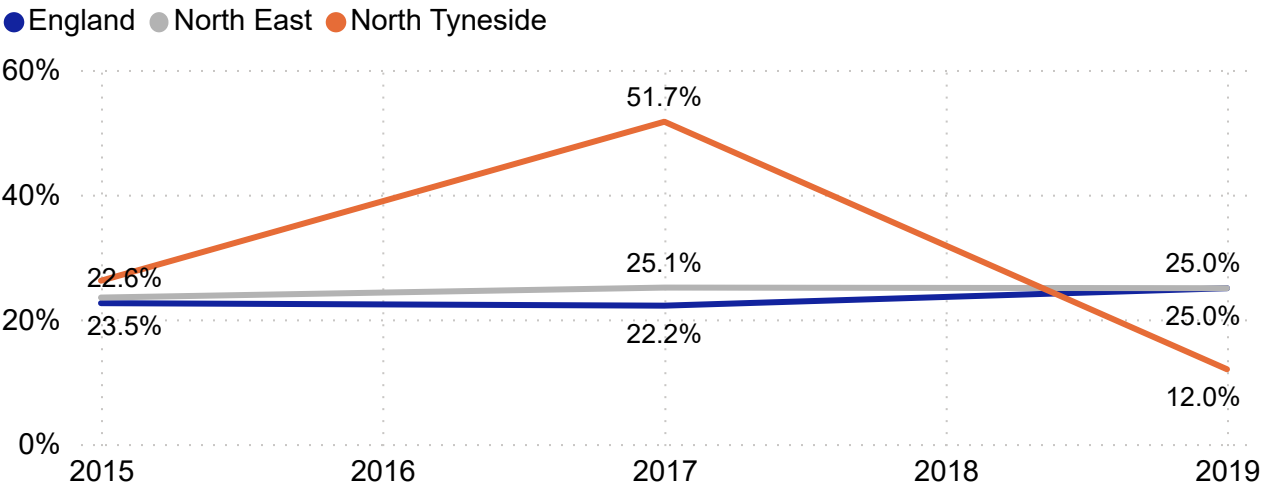
Proportion of 16-17 year olds Not in Education, Employment or Training (NEET)



Number of apprenticeship starts in North Tyneside



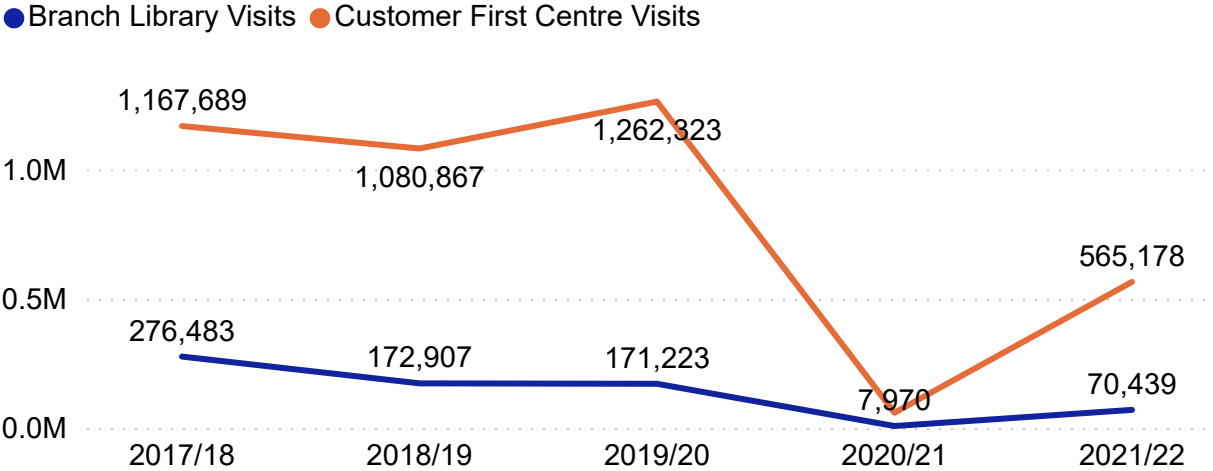

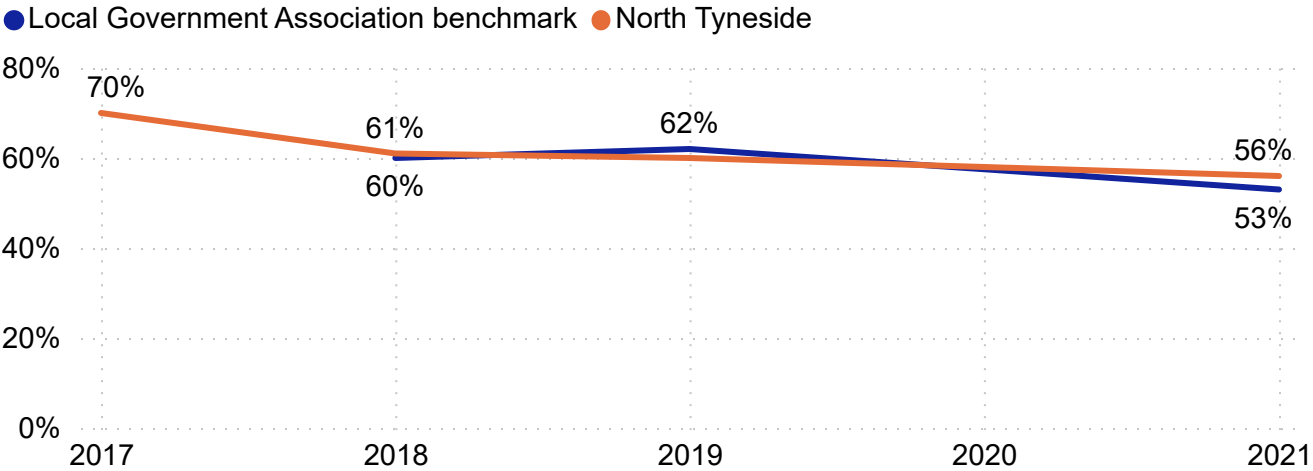

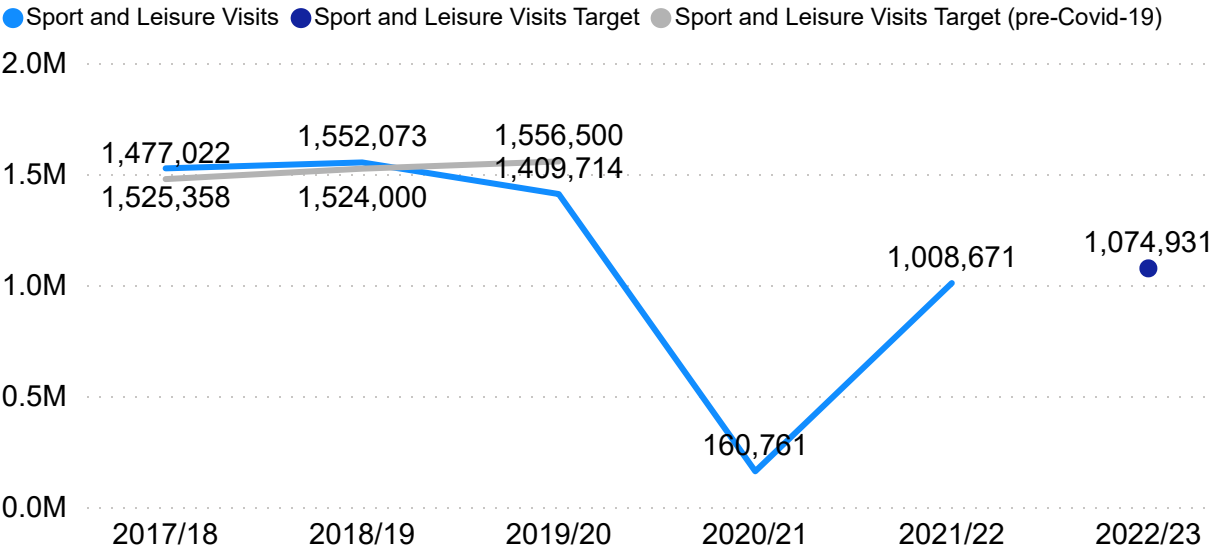

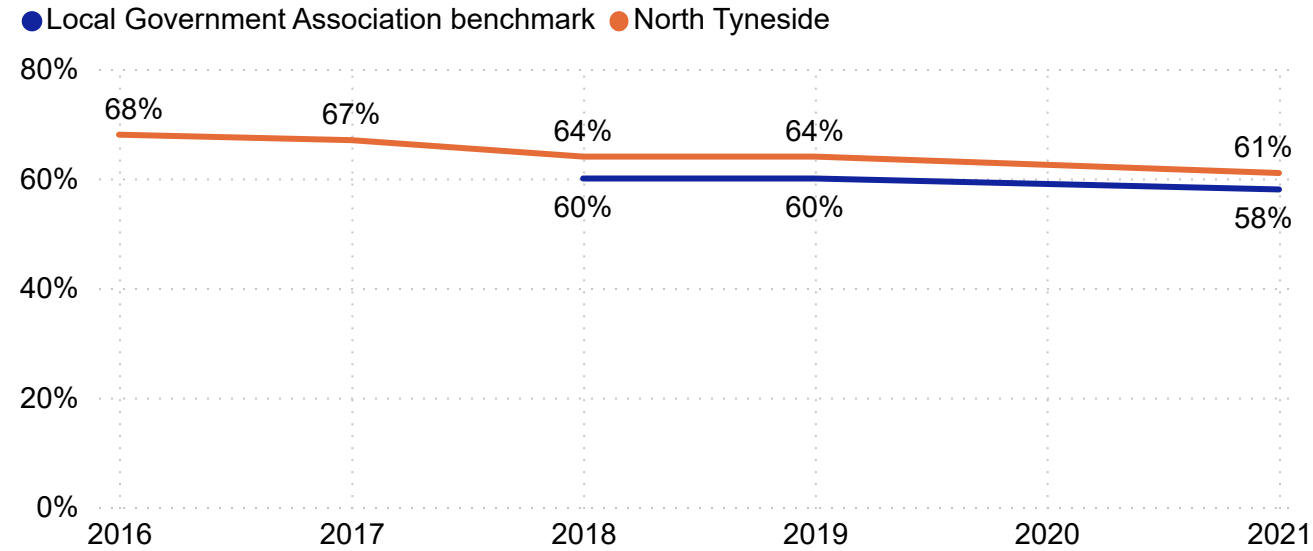
Satisfaction with library facilities



Sports and leisure facility visits in North Tyneside



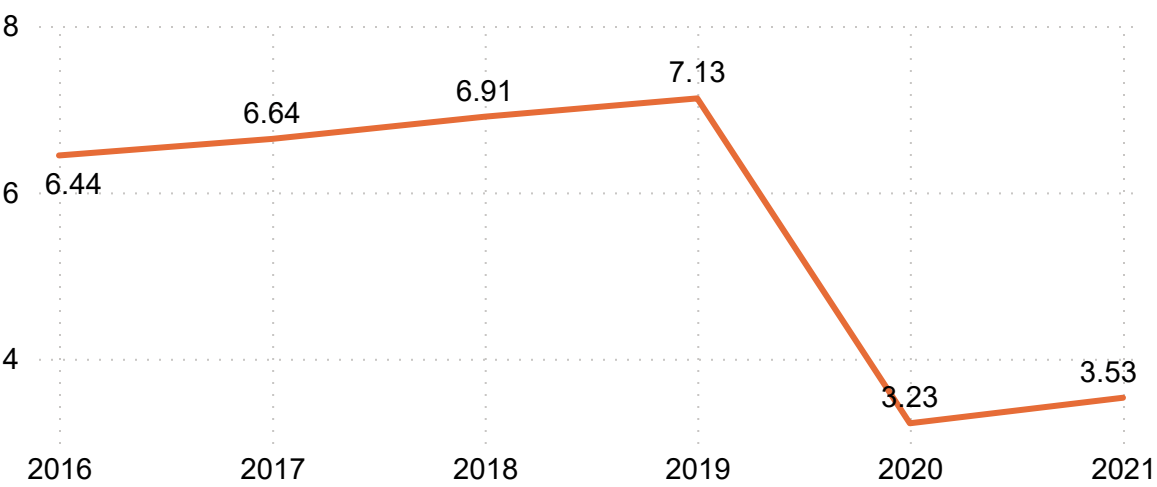

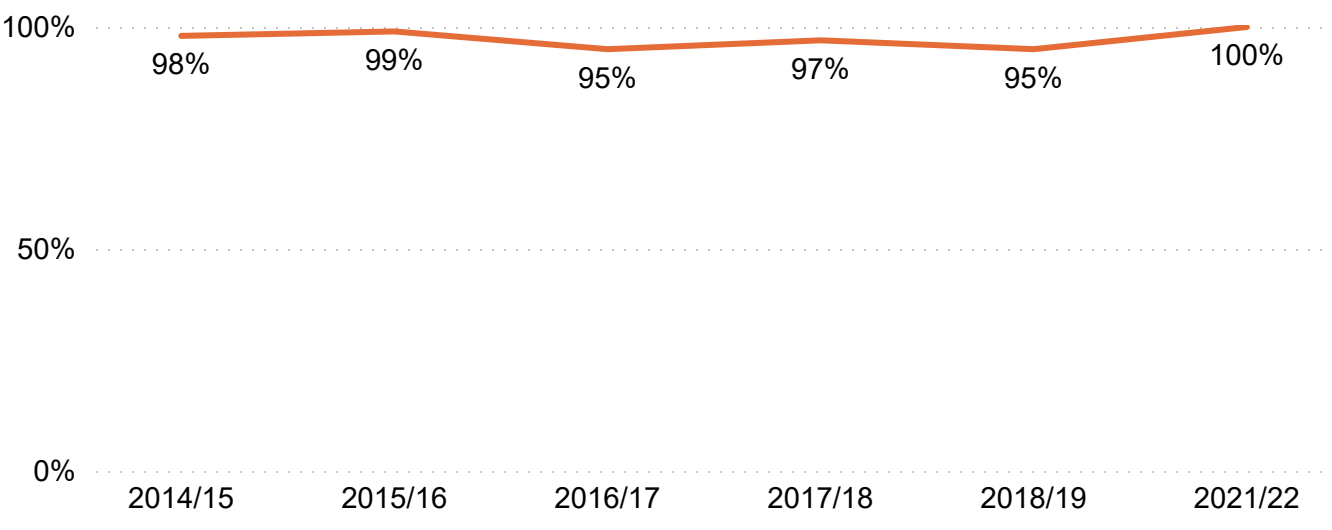

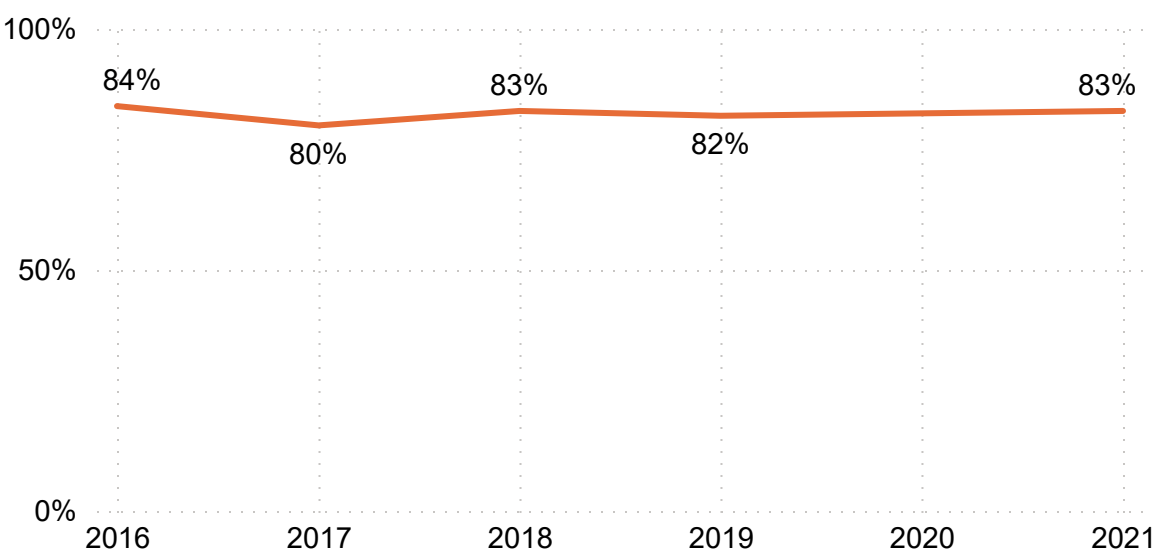
Number of day visits and overnight stays to North Tyneside (millions)



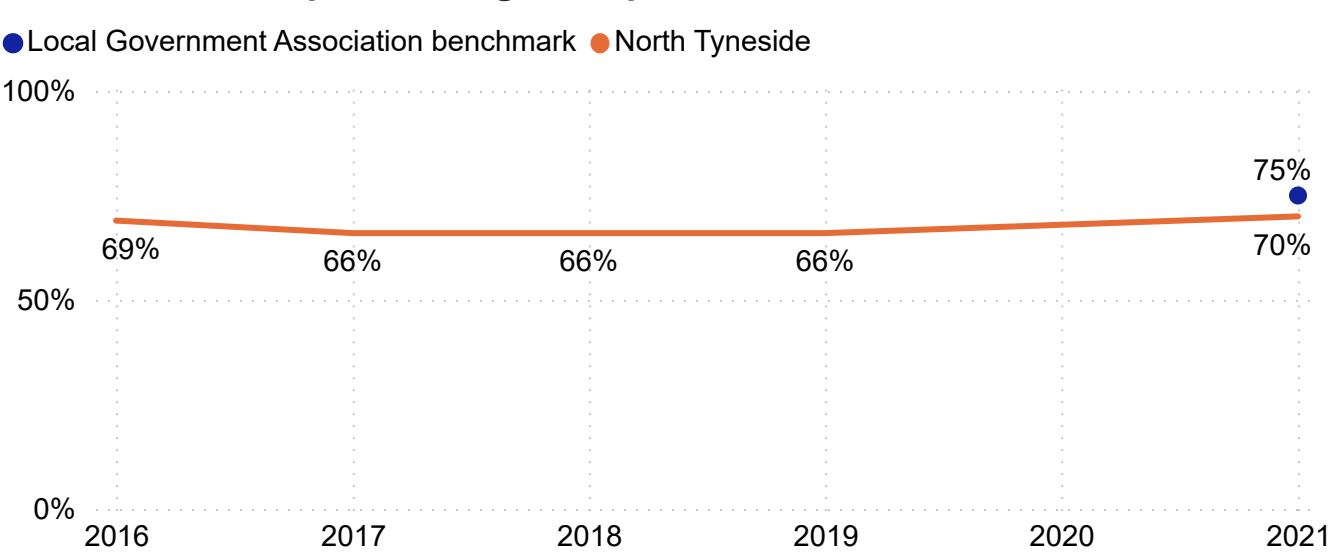
Proportion of visitors to North Tyneside who were satisfied

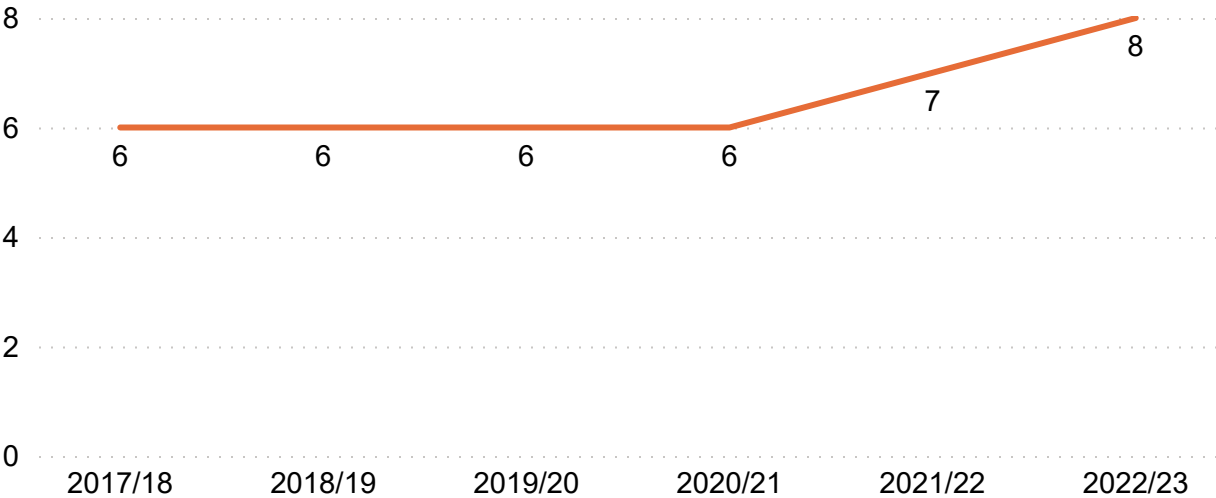

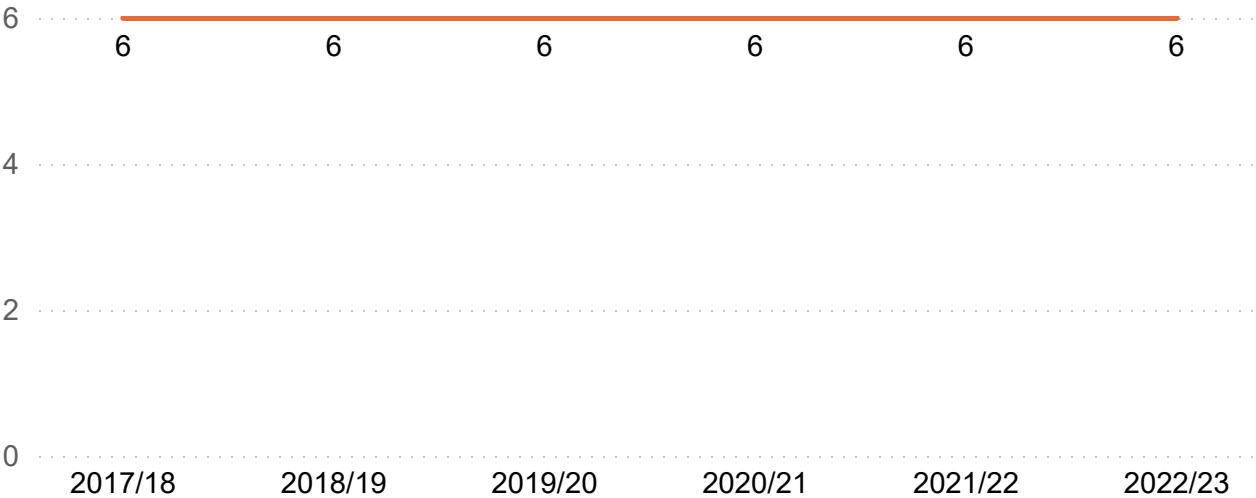

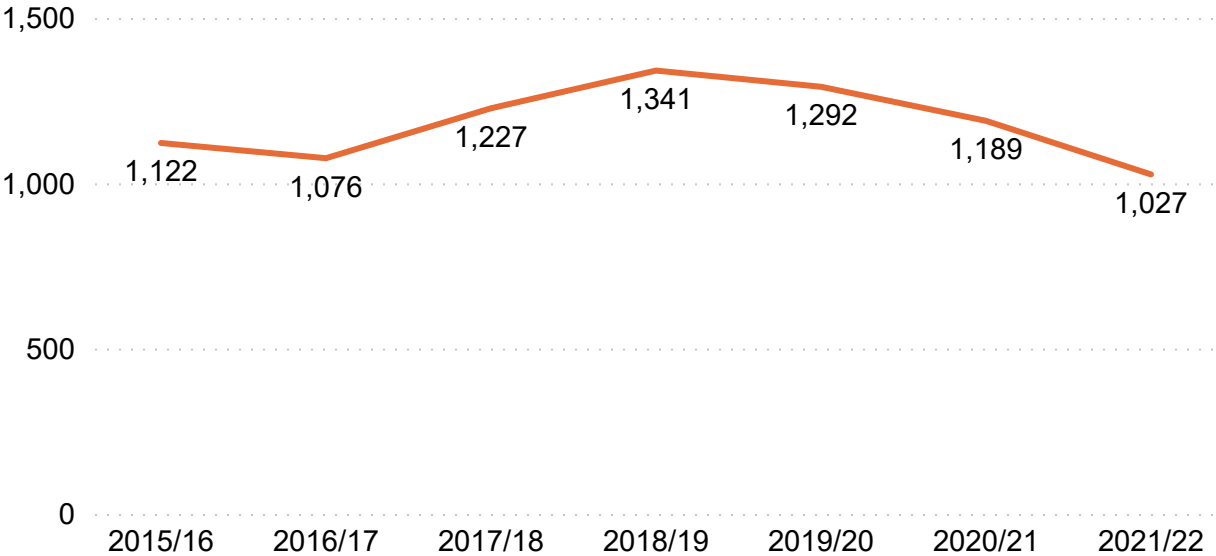

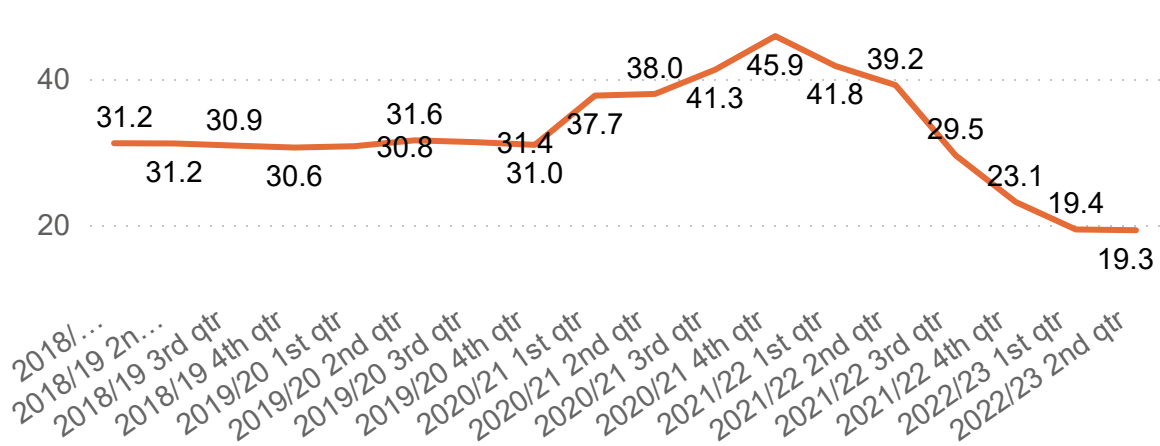

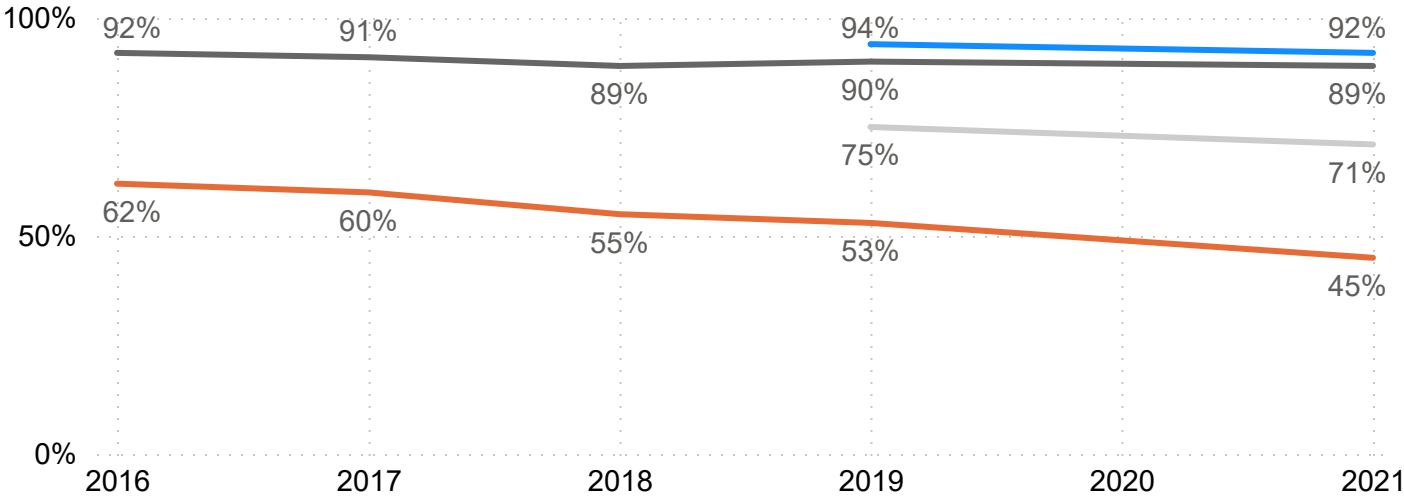

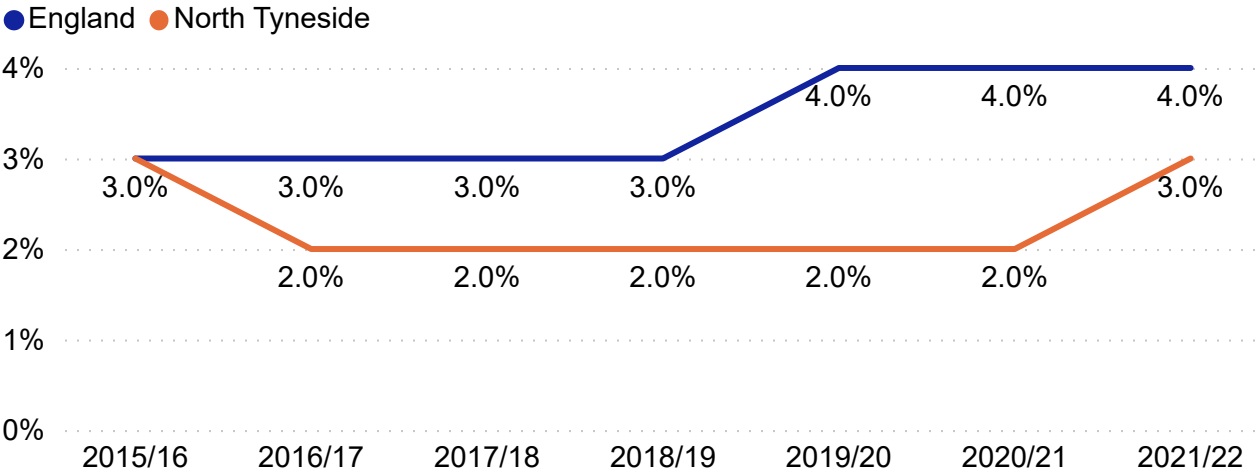

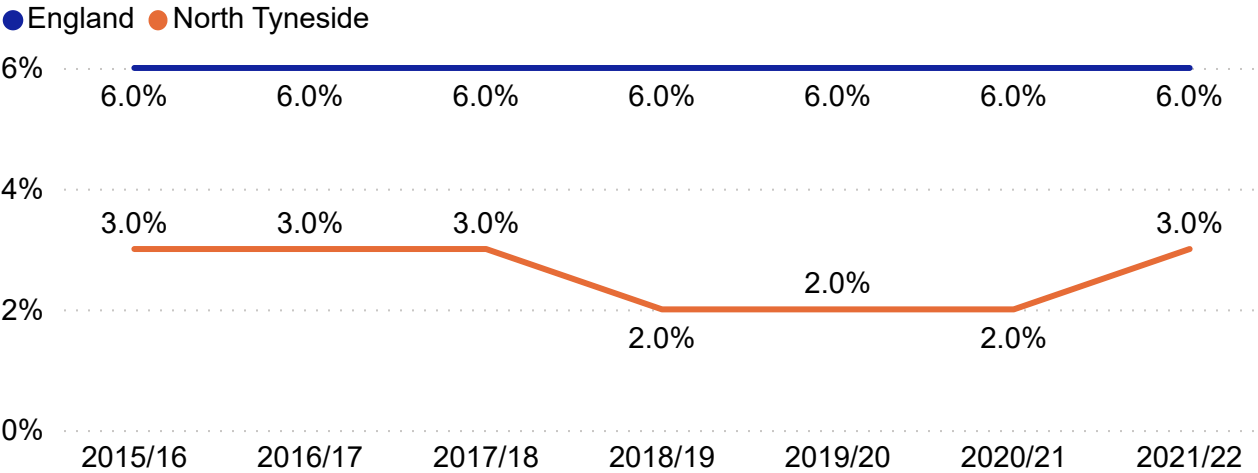

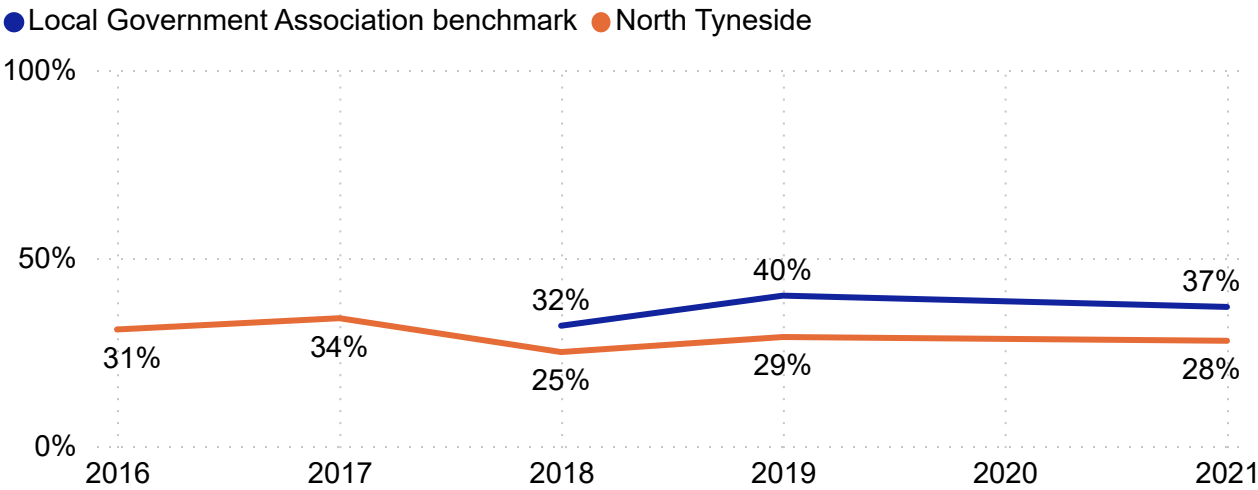

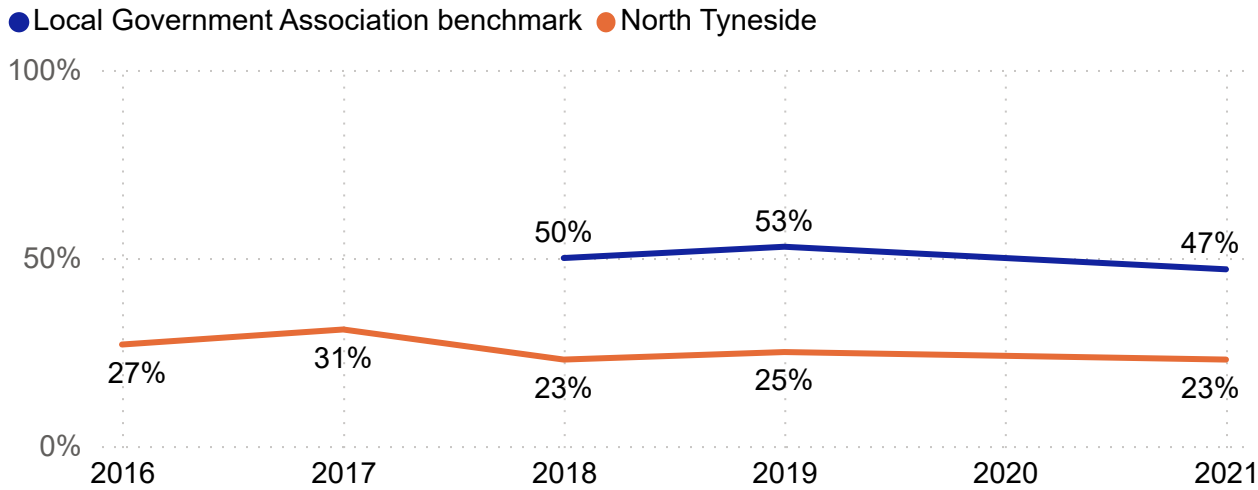
Local authority managed roads where maintenance should be considered - non-principal

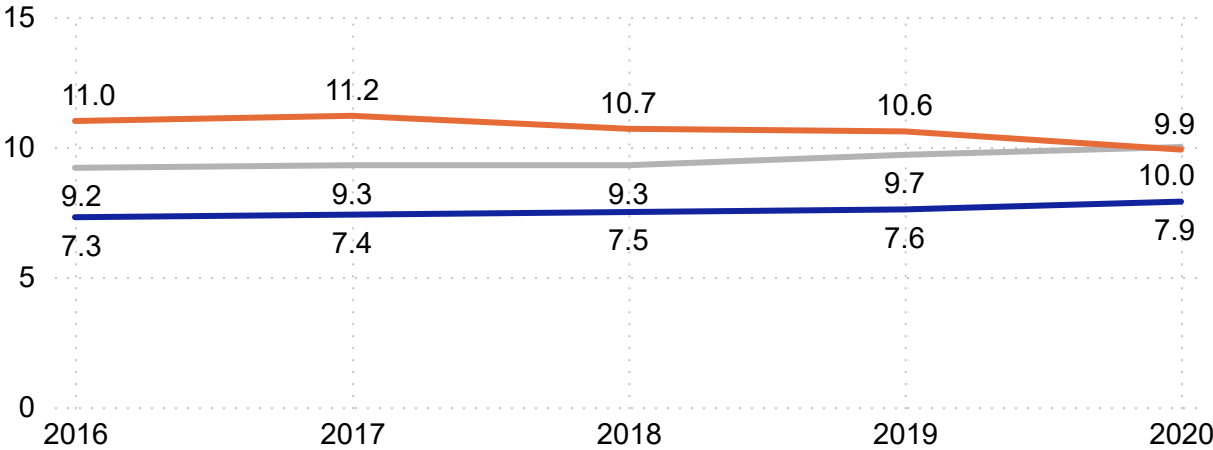

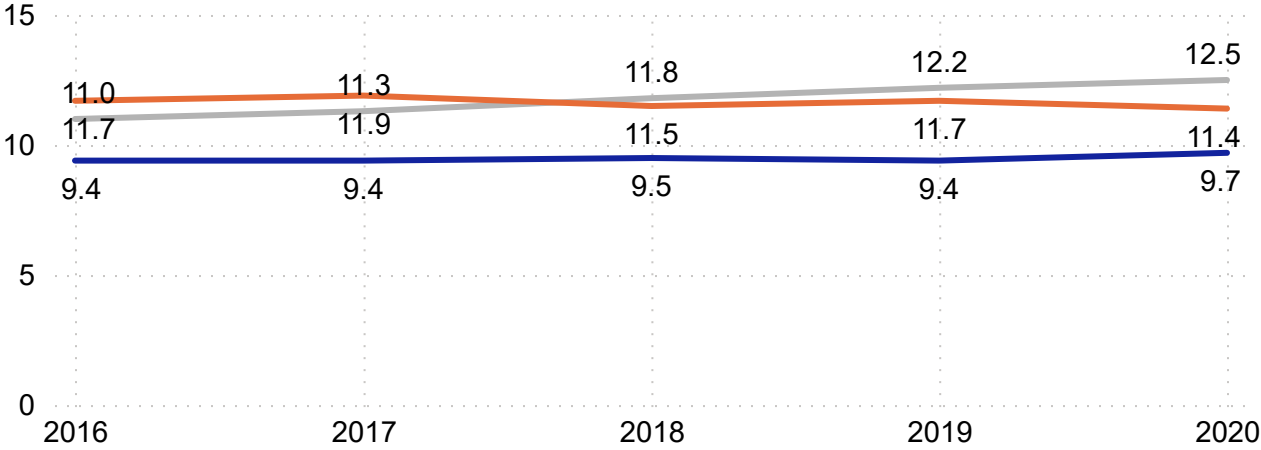


Inequality in male life expectancy at birth (years)

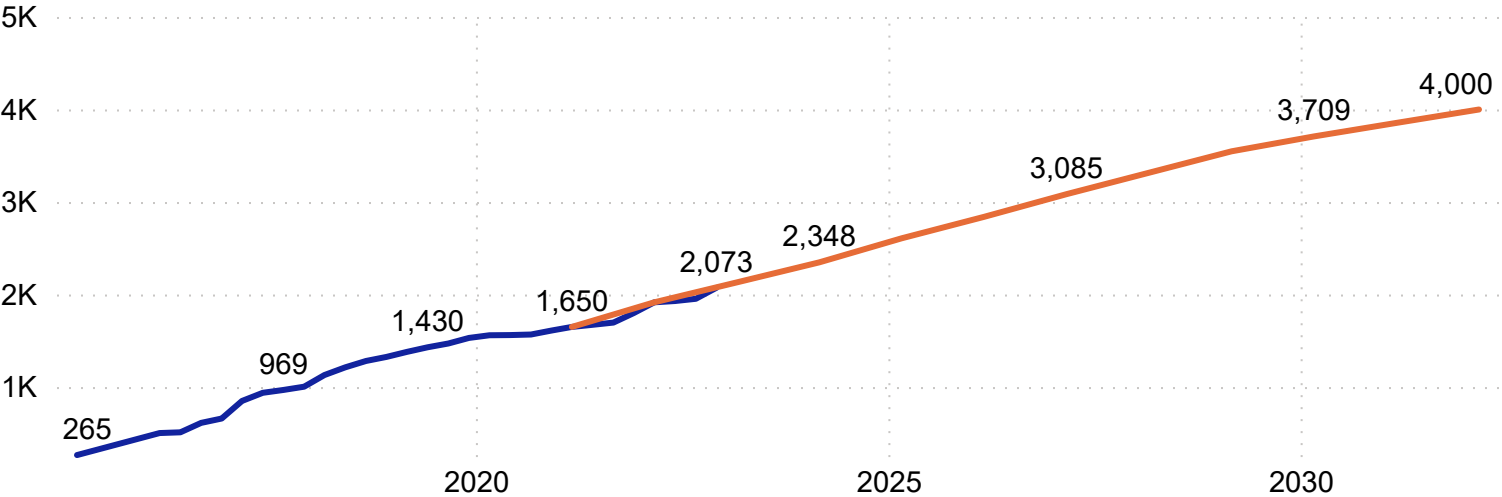

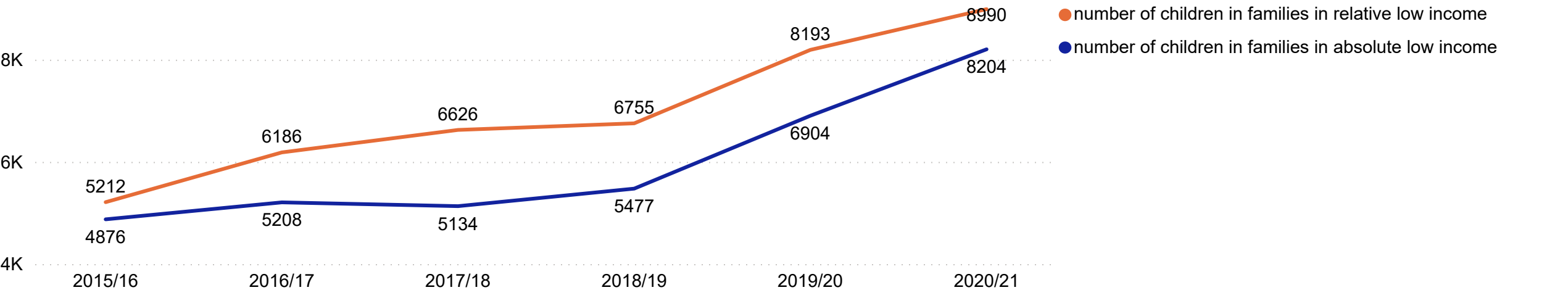

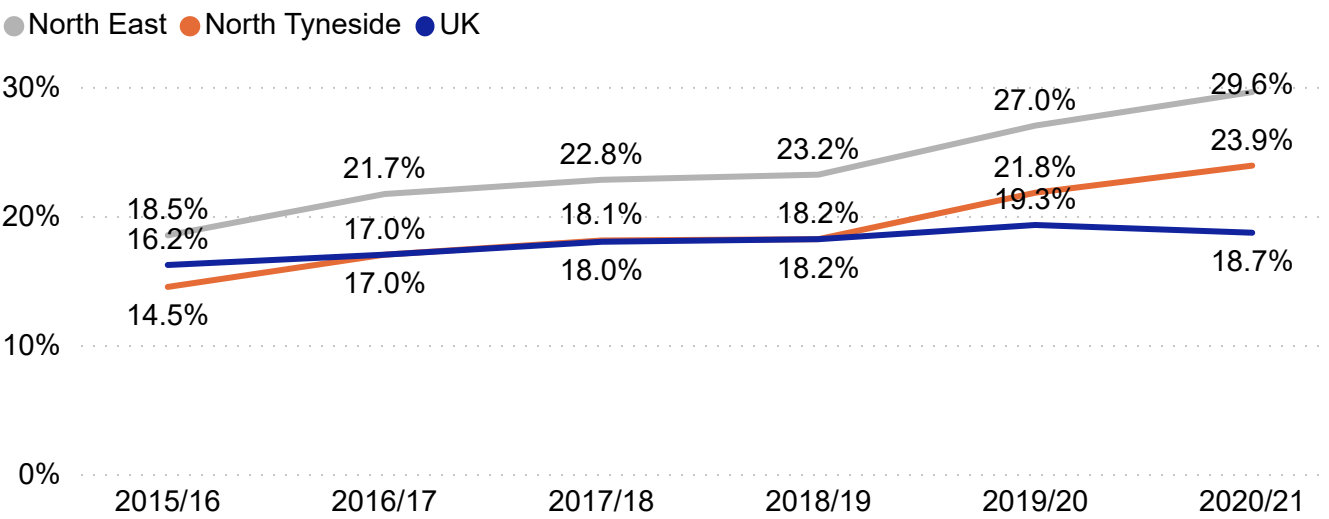

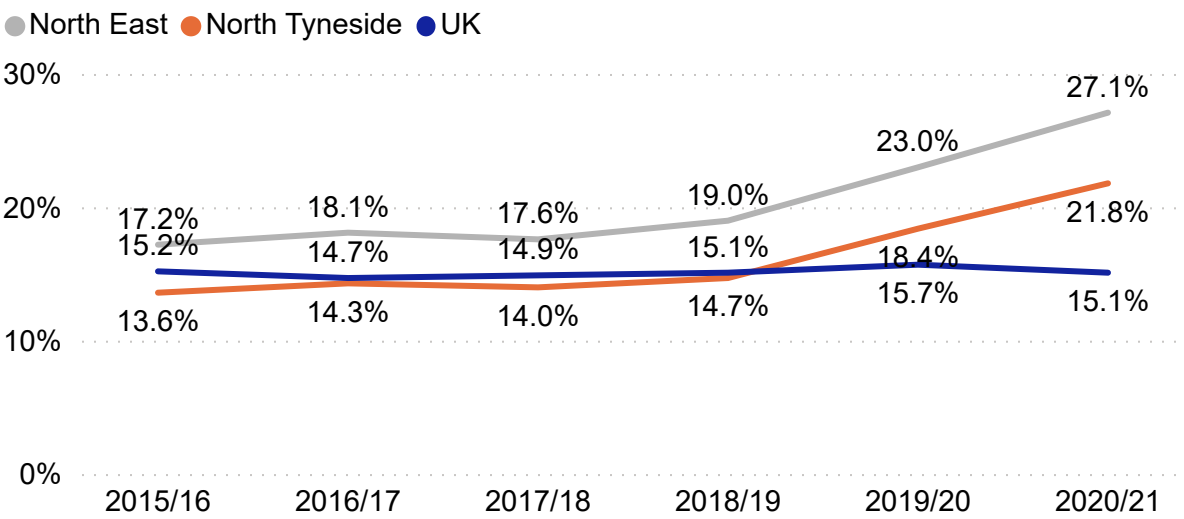

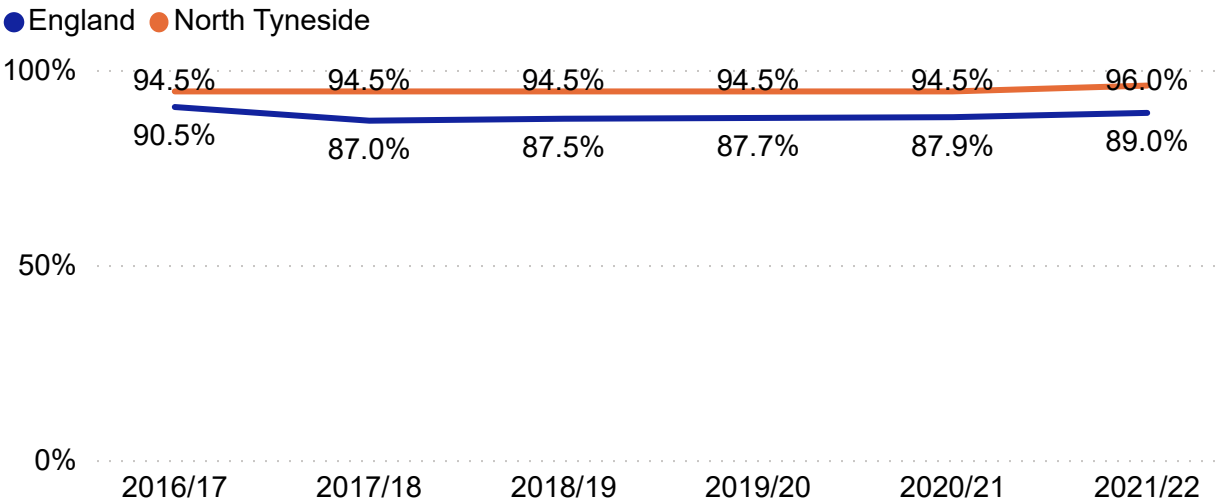

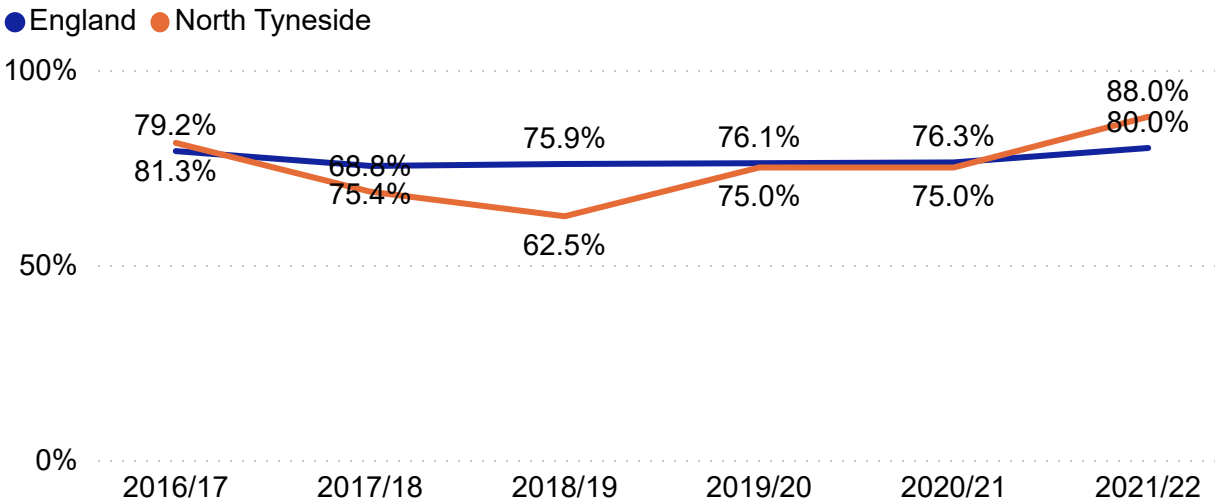

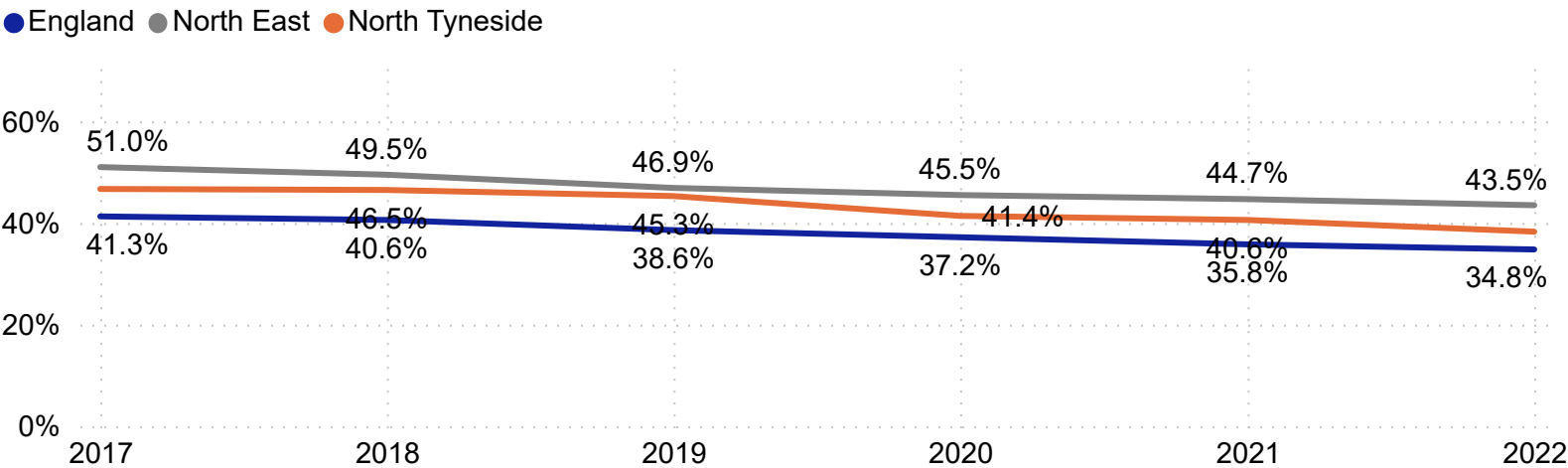

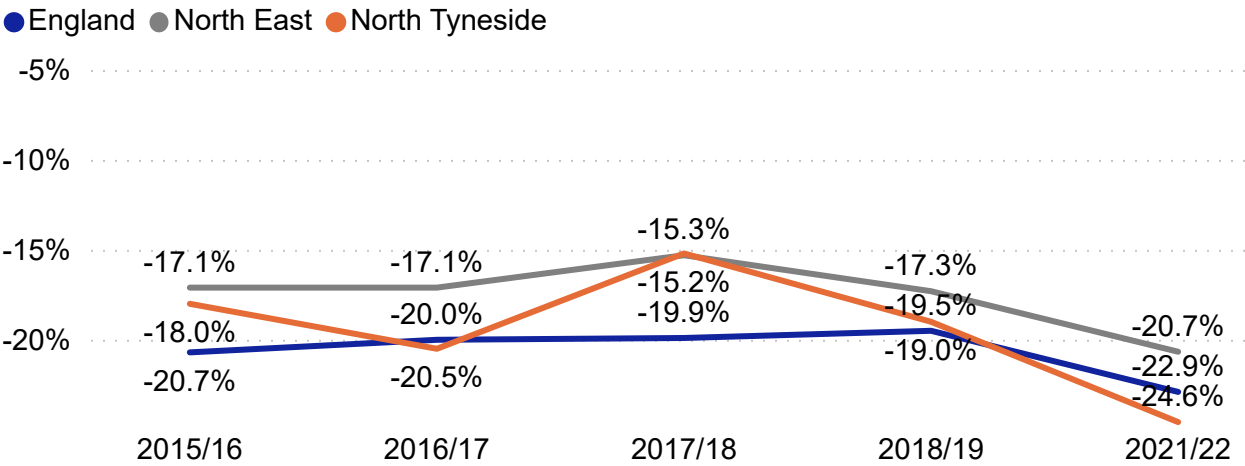

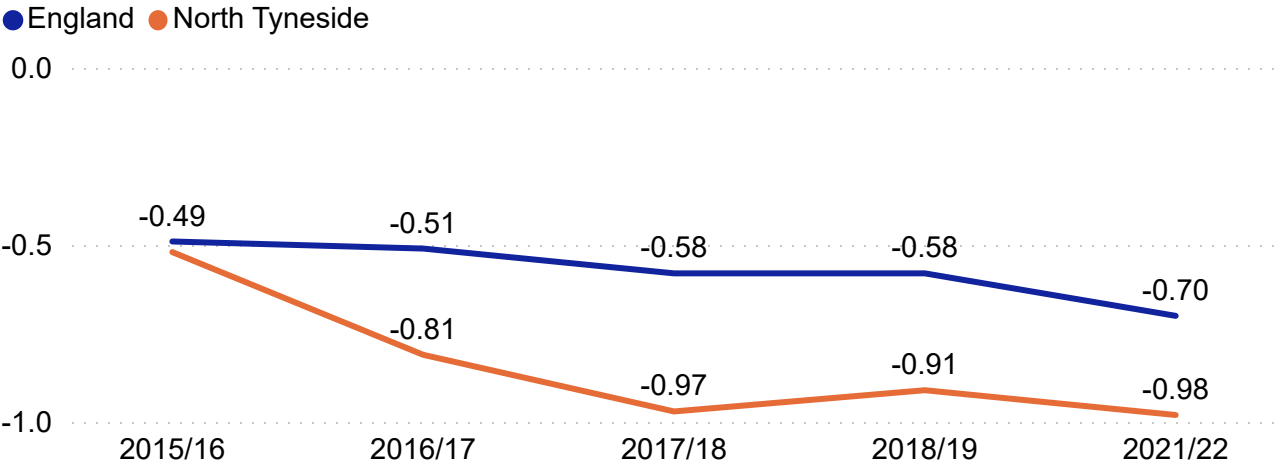

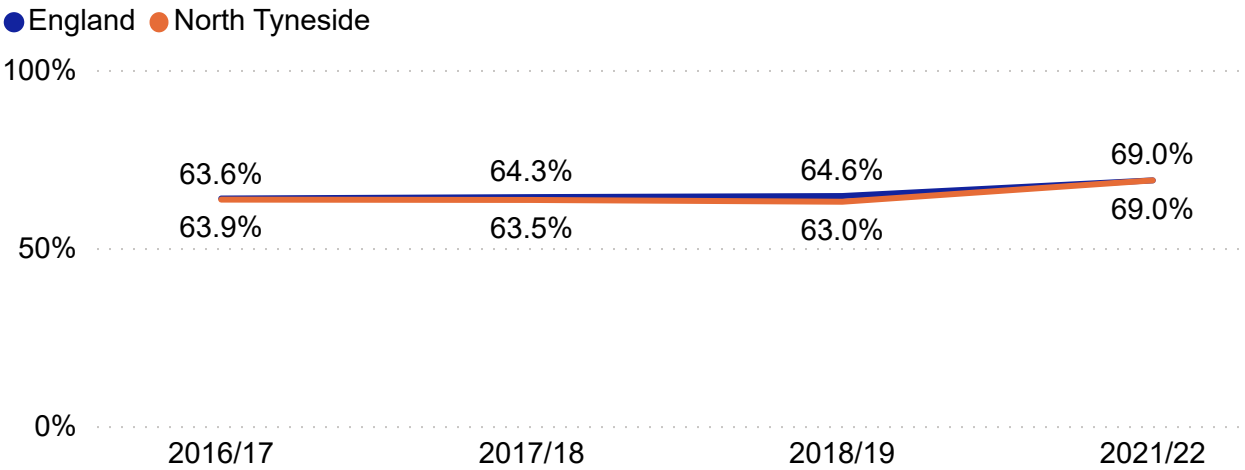
Gap between disadvantaged pupils and non-disadvantaged pupils reaching the Expected Level in Reading, Writing and Maths at Key Stage 2

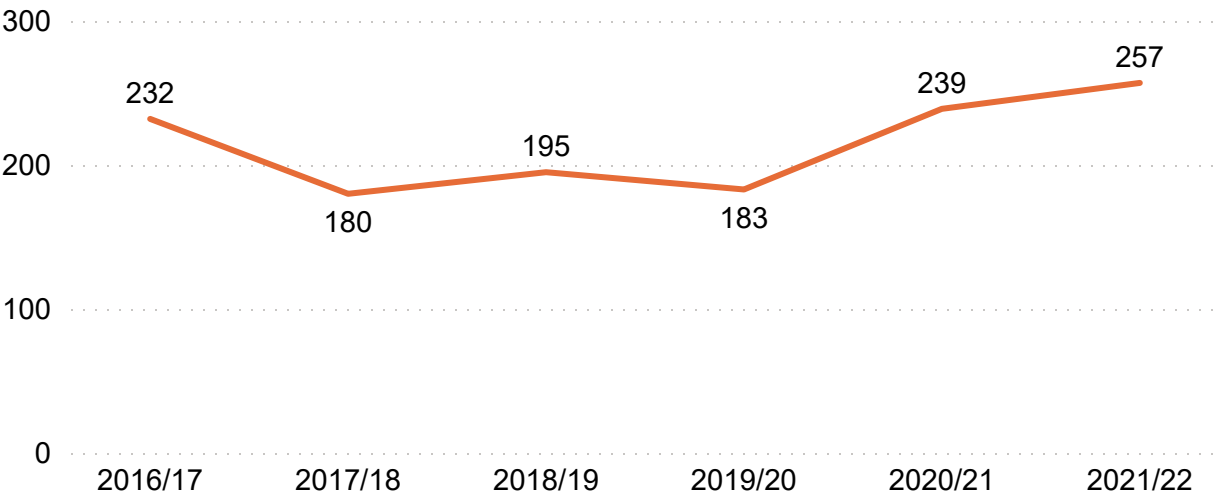

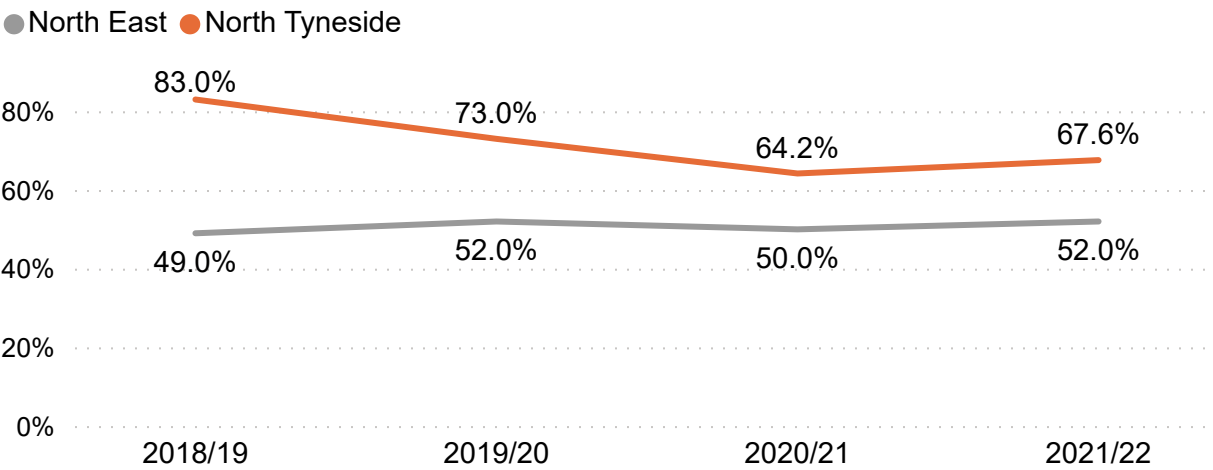

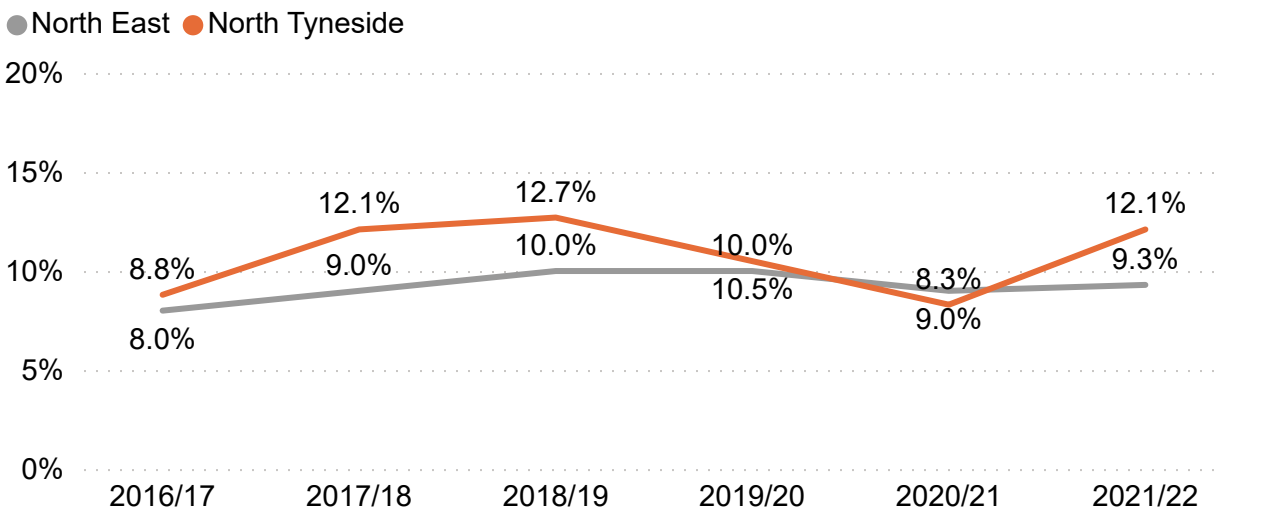

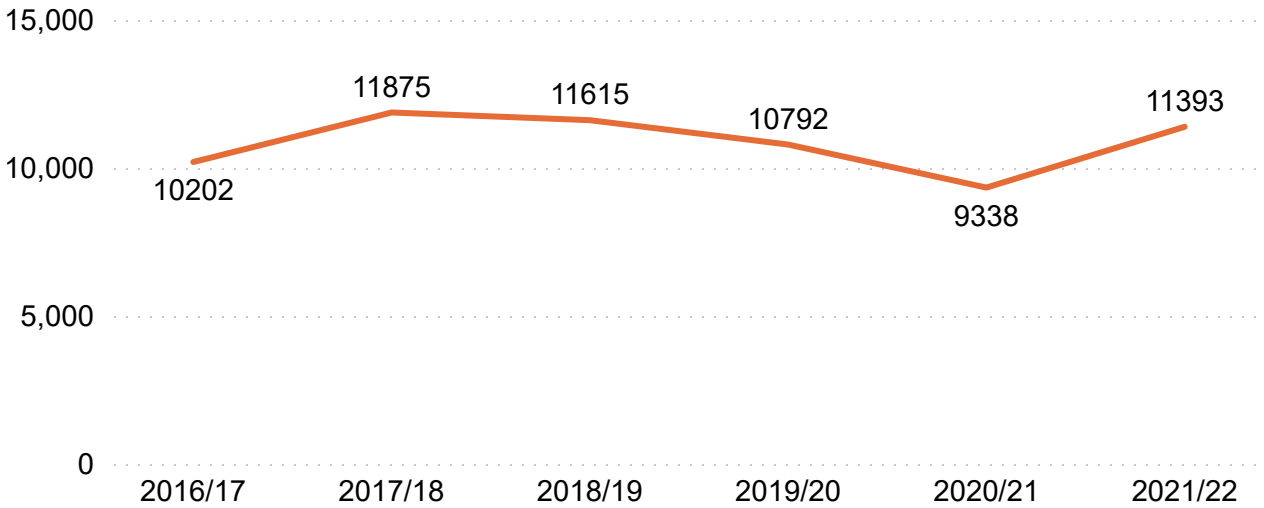

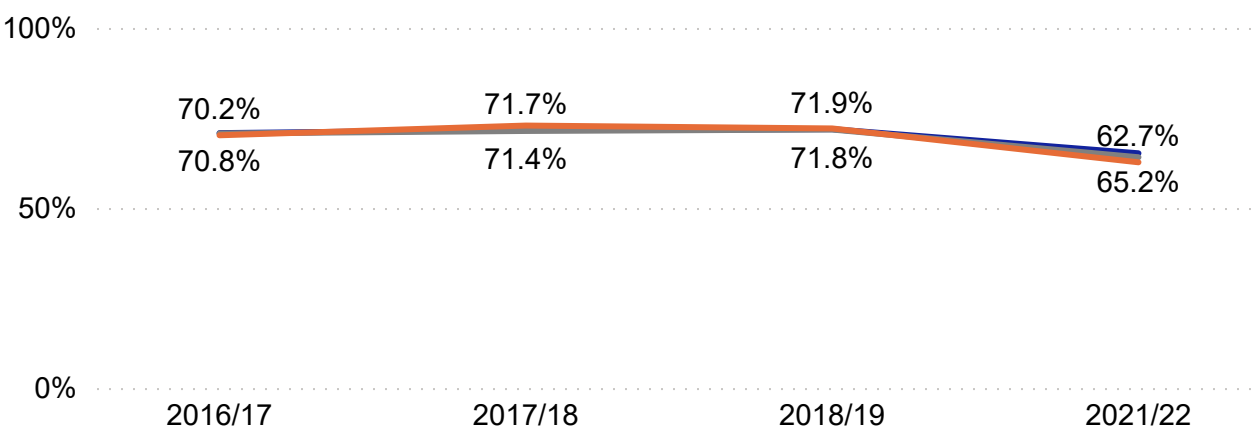

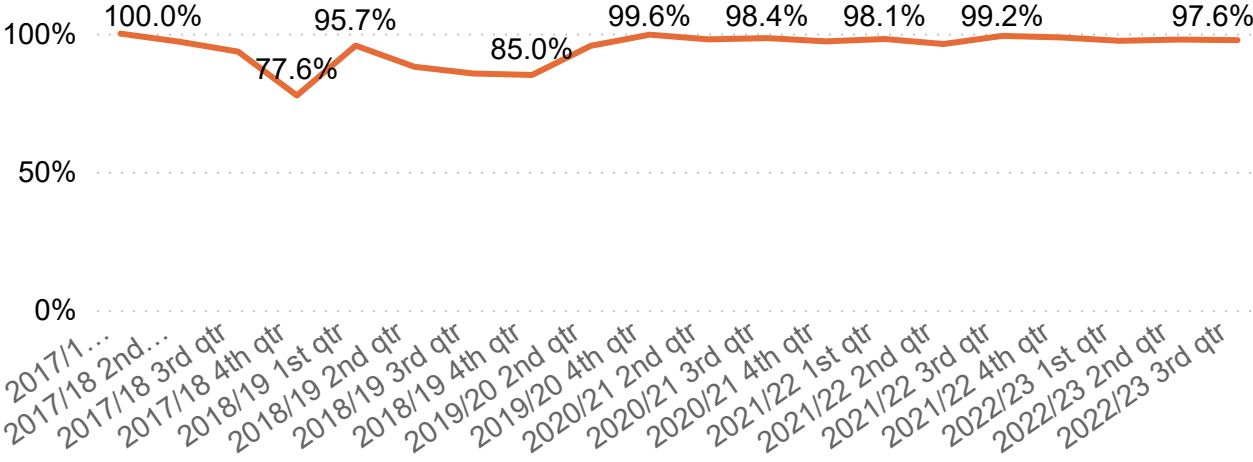

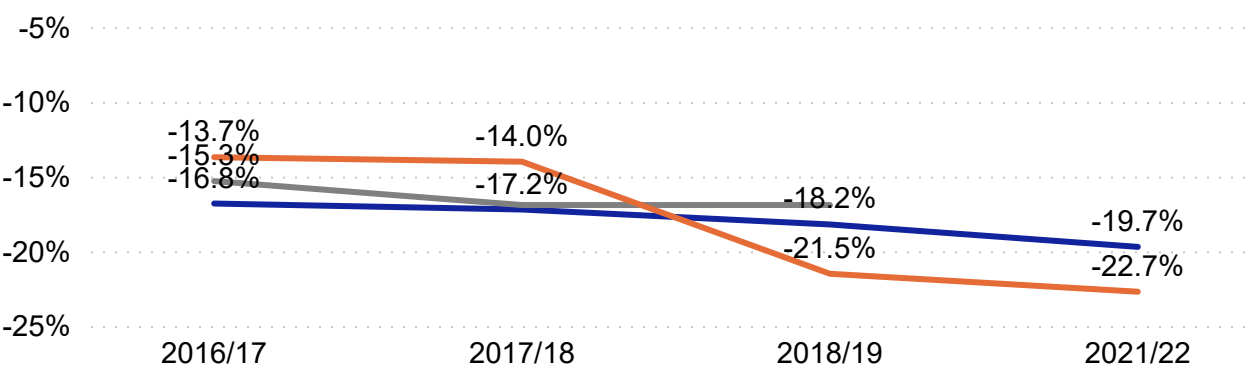

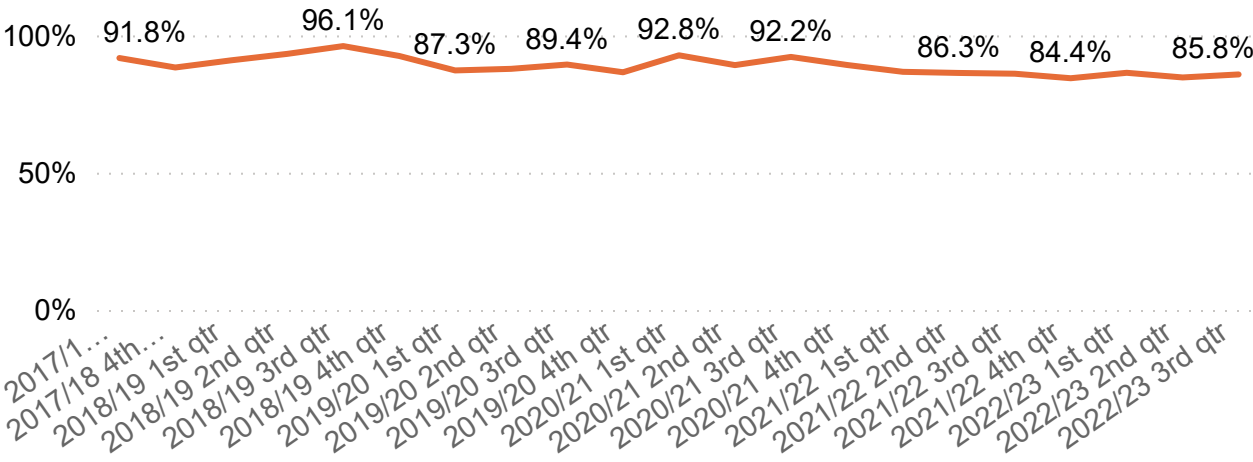

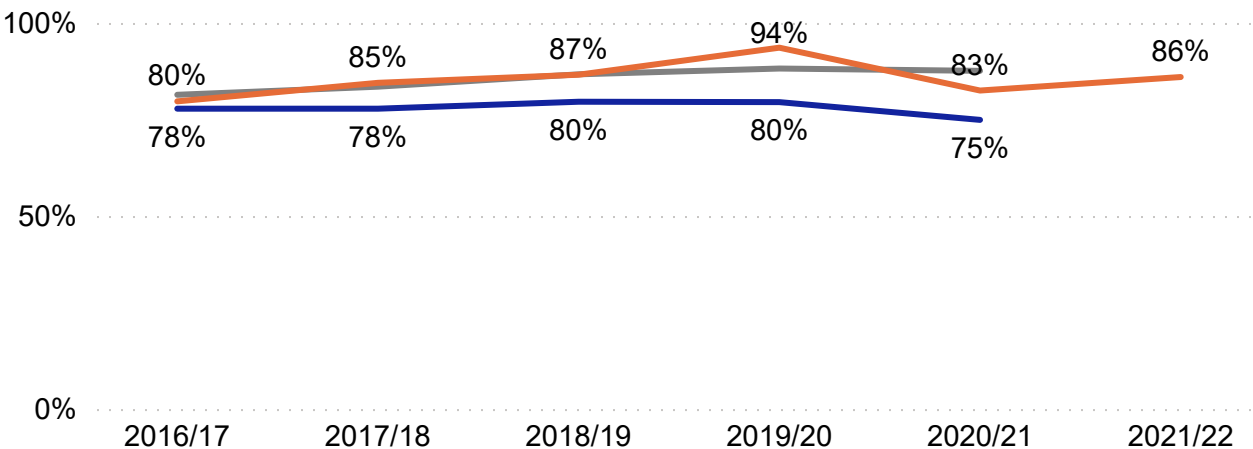

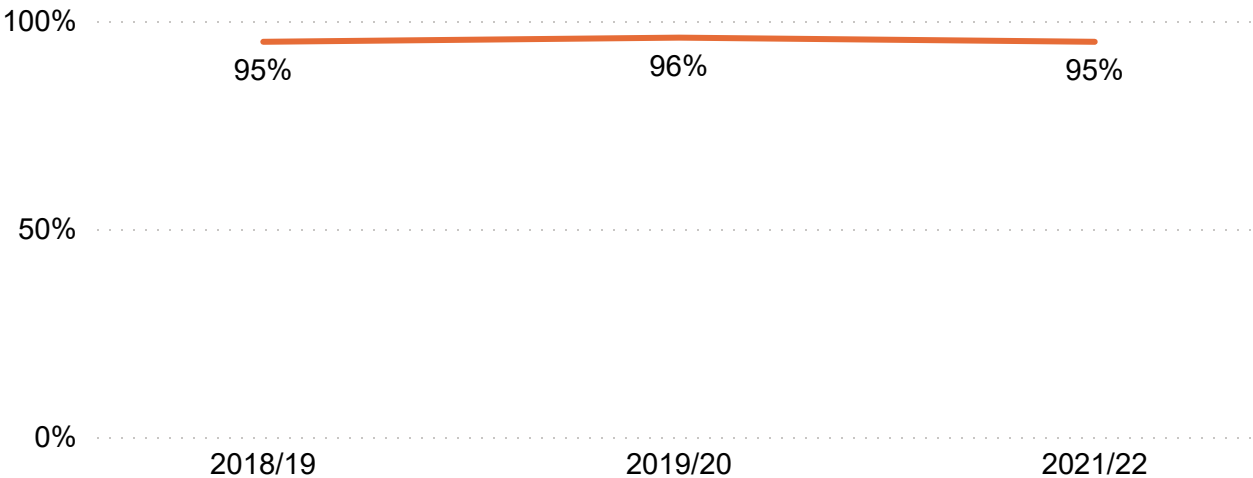

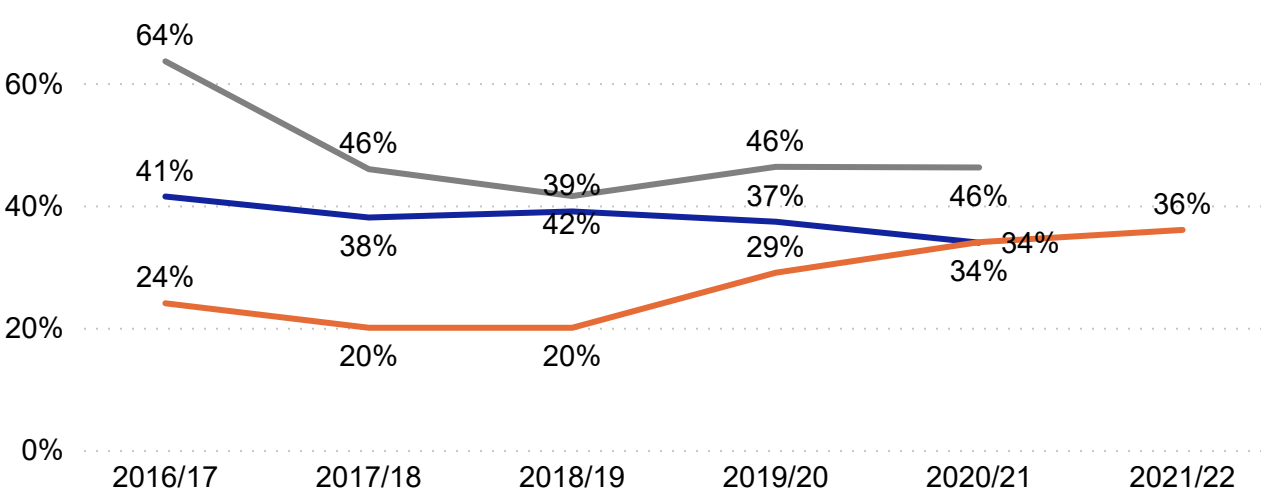

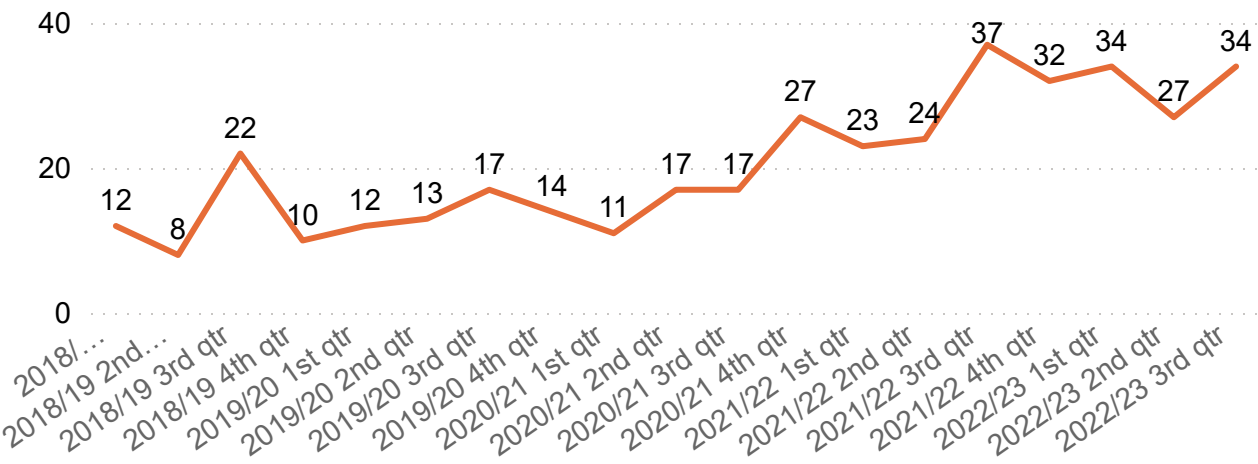

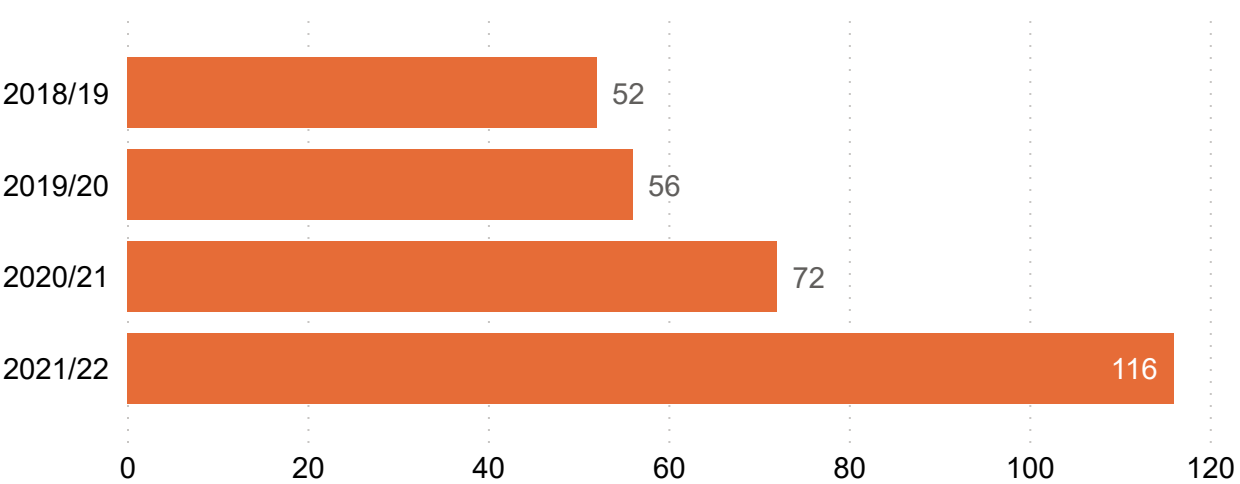
Homeless presentations accepted as priority homeless



Emergency hospital admissions due to falls in people aged 65+ - rate per 100k

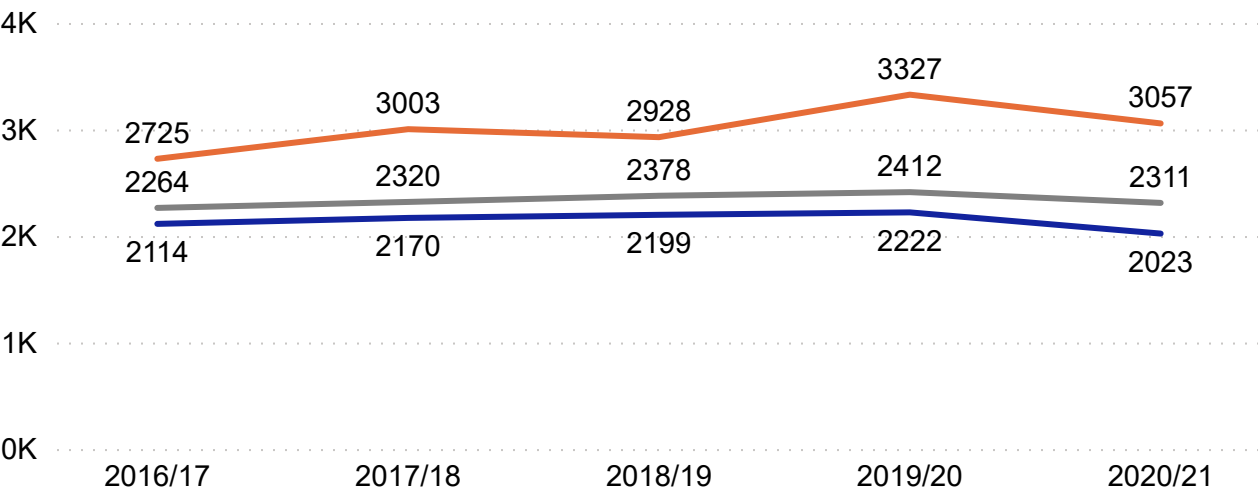

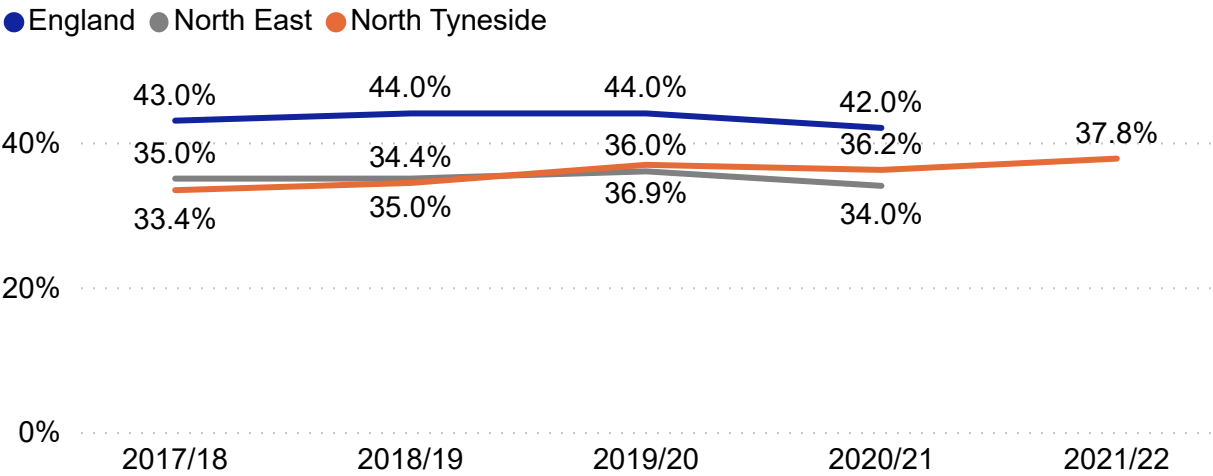

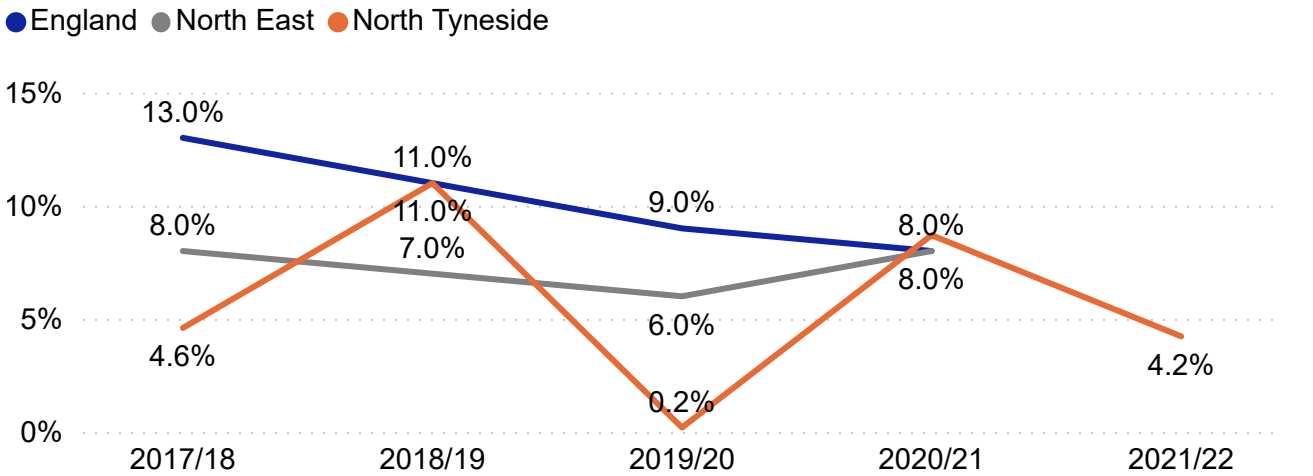

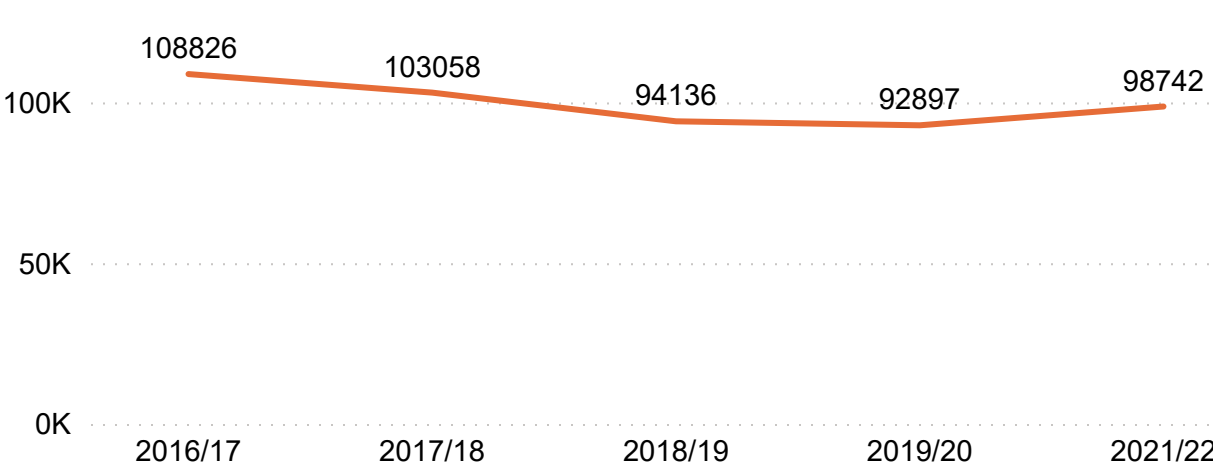

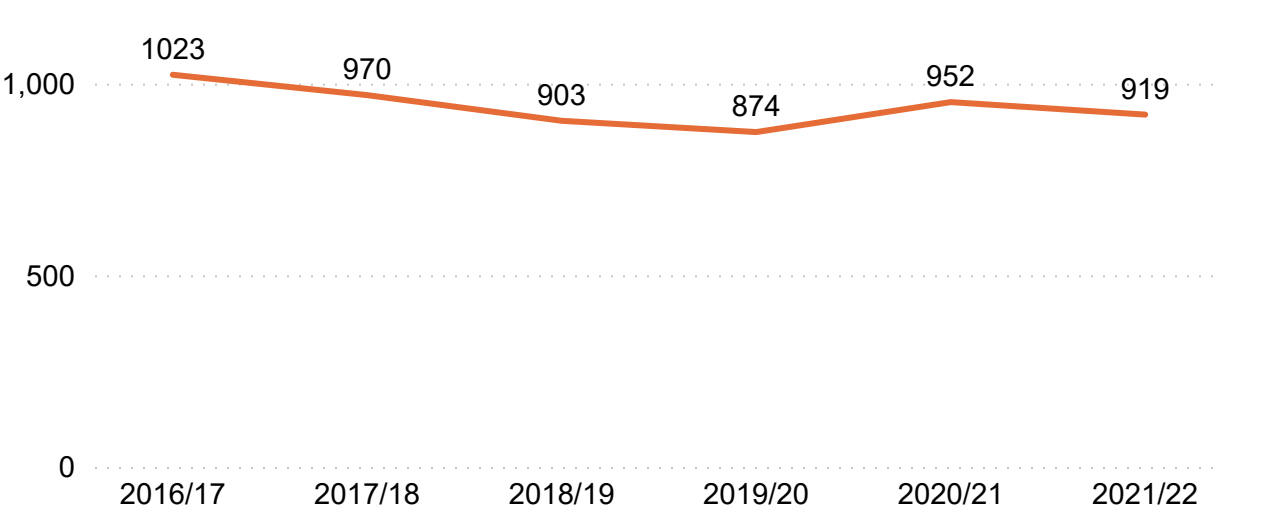

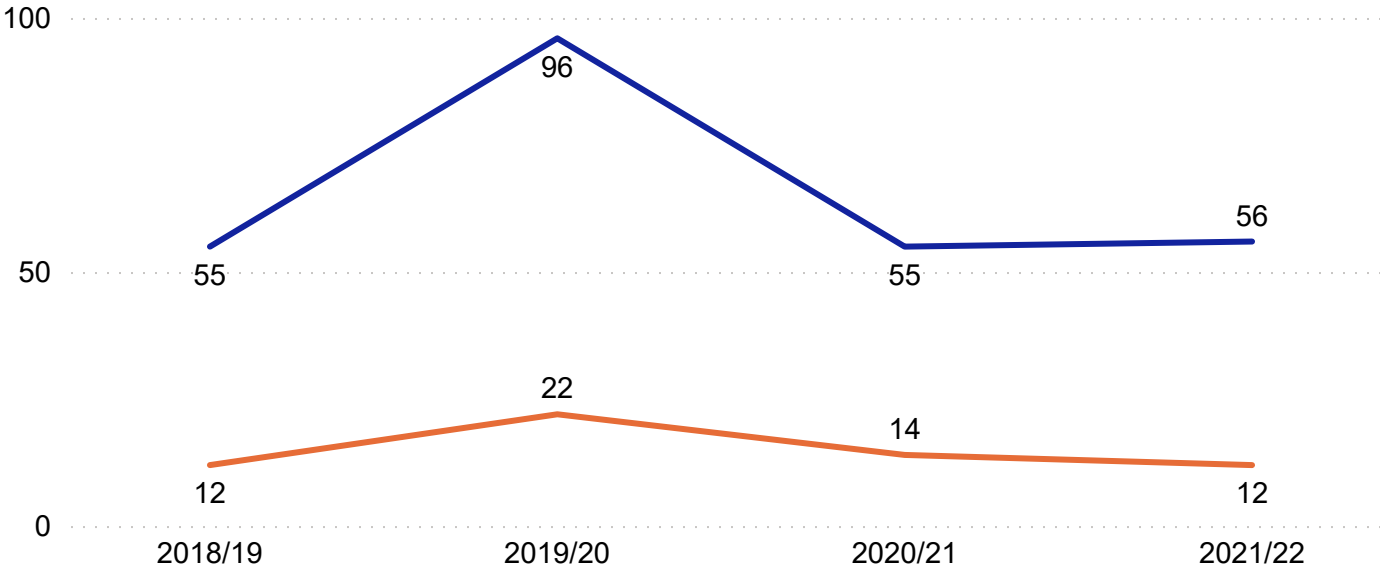

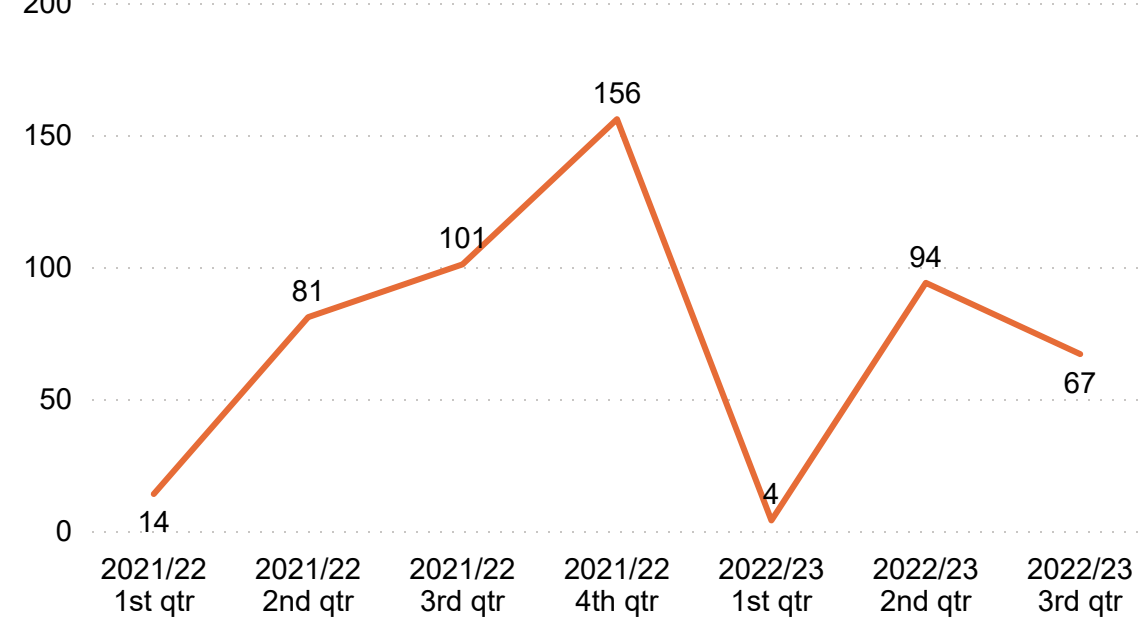

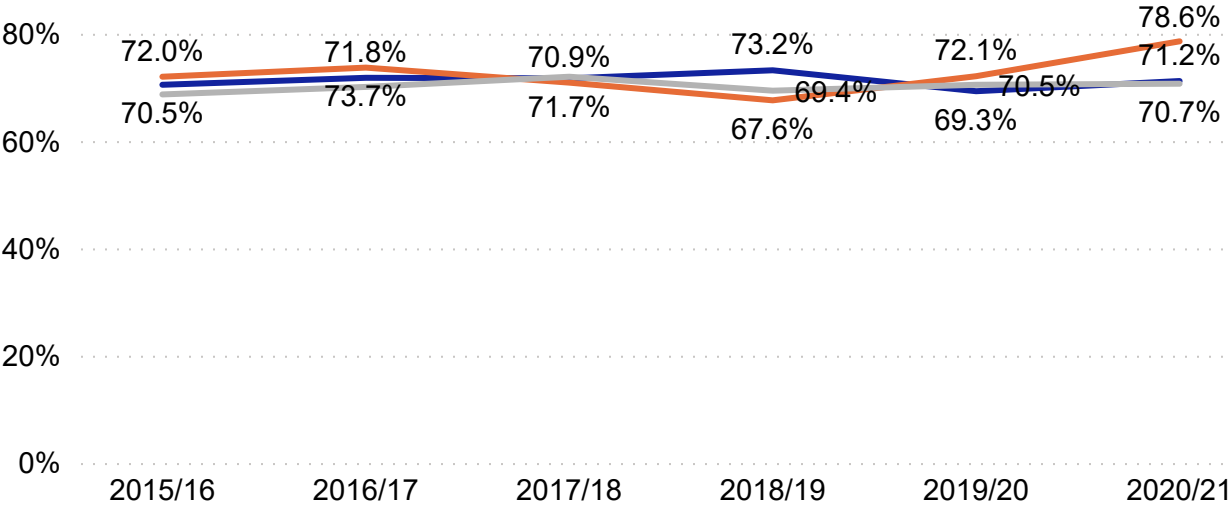

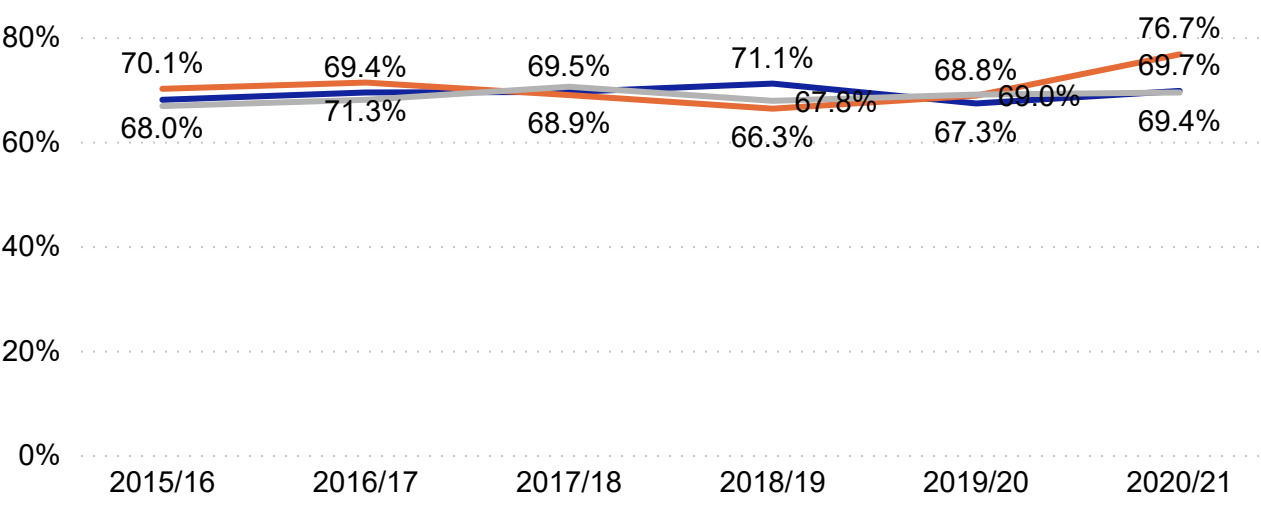

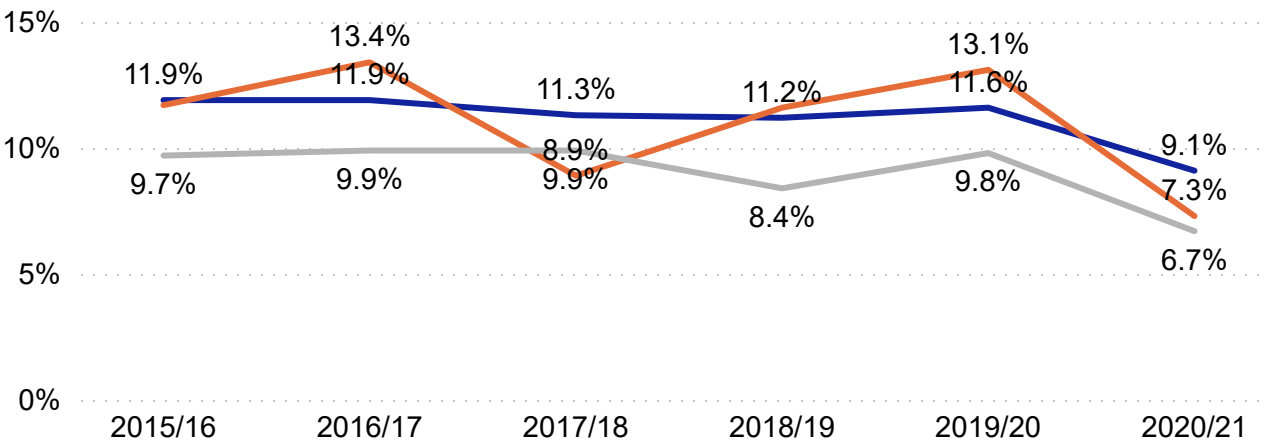

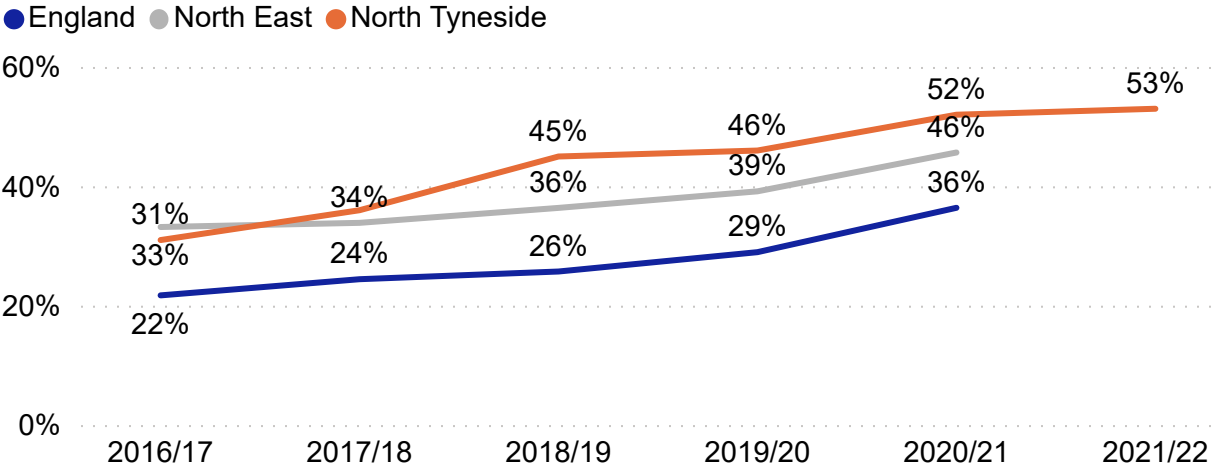

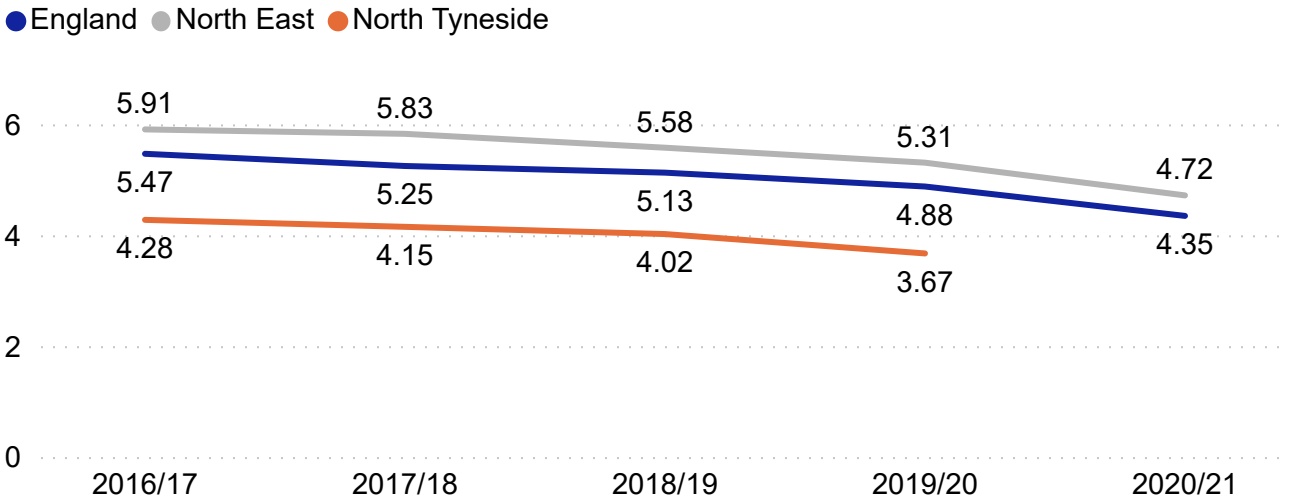
CO₂ emissions for North Tyneside (kilotons CO₂)
