Time-limited 3 months	Band 1	Band 1+
-Severe illness -Hospital discharge -Care/ residential care -Child experiencing abuse -Statutory overcrowding -Property condition (Enviro Health) -Witness Protection -Domestic Abuse/ MARAC		
Time limited for 3 months -Medical or welfare (high) -S21/ end of non-secure tenancy -Armed forces -Overcrowded by 2+ bedrooms -Adoption -Anti-social behaviour -Domestic Abuse -Leaving care -Leaving supported accommodation	Band 2	Band 1



Banding and Priority Status – Draft Proposal

Current criteria	Current band	Proposed band
-Homelessness relief duty -Medical need (eased) -Sharing facilities/ overcrowding -Property condition -Employment in borough -Flat above ground floor & child under 5	Band 3	Band 2
No local connection, but would meet priority need (band 1, 2 or 3)	Band 4	Band 3
Has local connection, but no priority need	Band 5	Band 4
No local connection & no priority need	Band 6	Band 5
