- NHS response to pressure on the system
- And the need to work differently
- Largely about collaboration to a large footprint
- For us; "North East and North Cumbria"
- Opportunity for commissioners and providers to work together
- Mechanism to handle pressure across the health system
- Context for higher level plan

- Four Police Forces
- Two Ambulance Service
- So

 - Work through political engagement
 - Conversations with Health and Wellbeing Boards, Leaders and Mayors

- Currently Chief Executives
- What makes practical sense
- Clinical work
- Prevention
- Climate Change and sustainability
- Employment and skills



Clinical work

- Helping each other out under pressure (ED, elective care, diagnostics and money)
- Number of joint appointments to recruit and retain the best (GI surgery, Spine surgery, potential in Cardiology and Gastro)
- Developing new services together (mechanical thrombectomy for stroke patients)
- Support services collaboration Pathology for example, supply chain, clinical record/tech sharing, financial systems
- Formation and development of the Tyne Provider Alliance







Prevention

Place based through the Better Care Fund:

- Smoking cessation
- Cardio Vascular Disease

Primary Care

- Part of all pathways and first contacts
- Smoking advice, alcohol brief interventions
- Early detection of atrial fibrillation in all GP surgeries
- Falls risk identification
- Social prescribing

Secondary prevention

- Falls
- Obesity/ diabetes
- Long term condition pathways, Respiratory, CVD
- Mental Health & wellbeing
- Social Prescribing


- Children and Young People Board delivering the strategy
