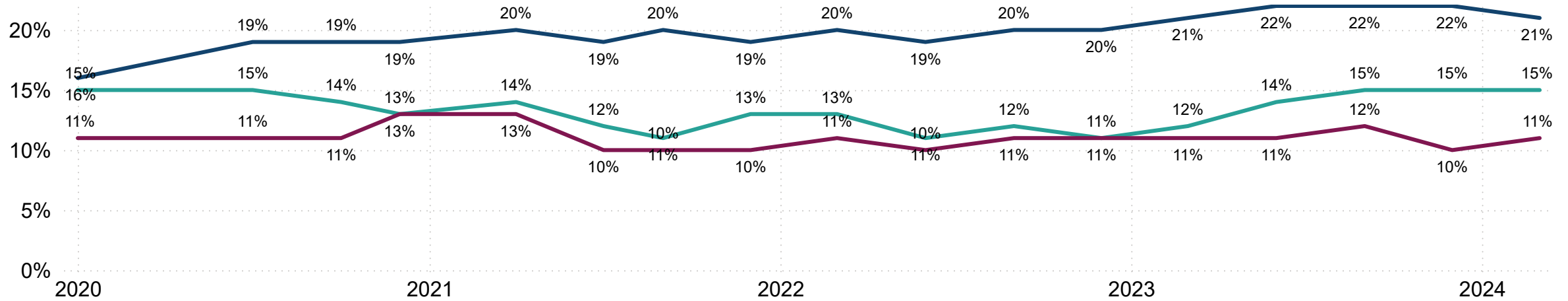

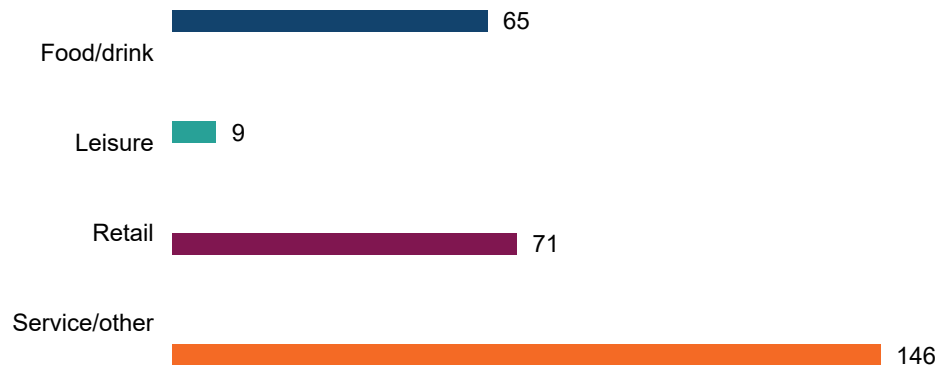

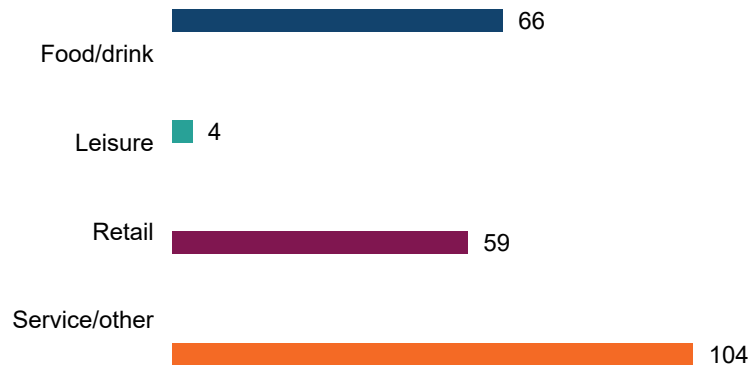

Businesses by type of business March 2024



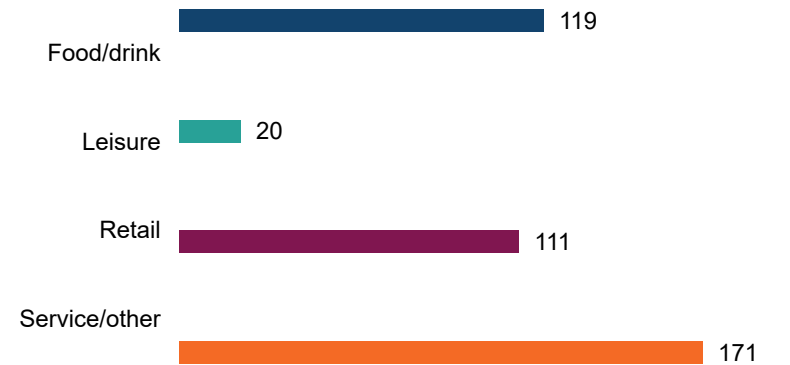

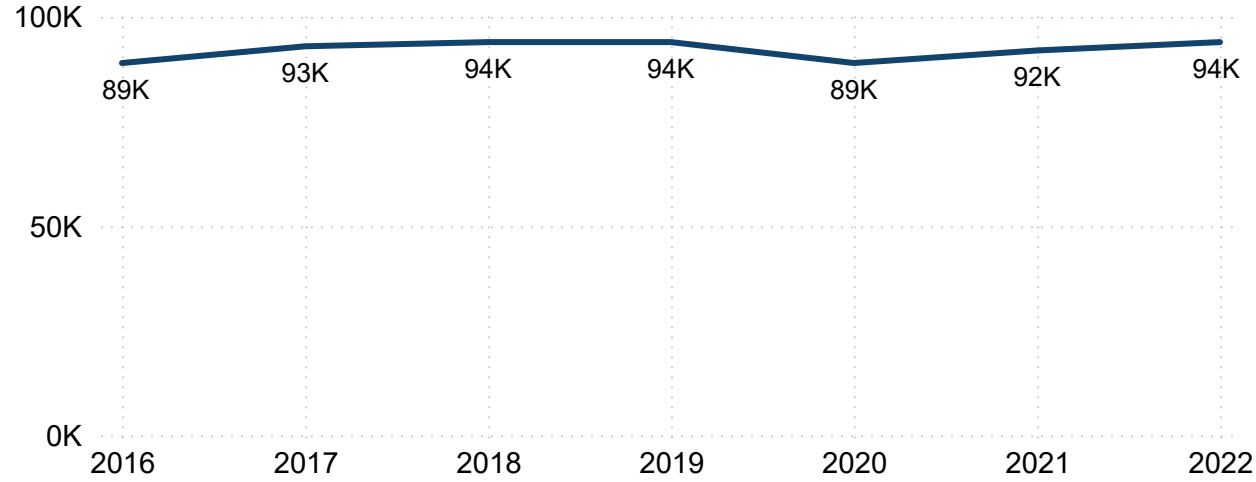

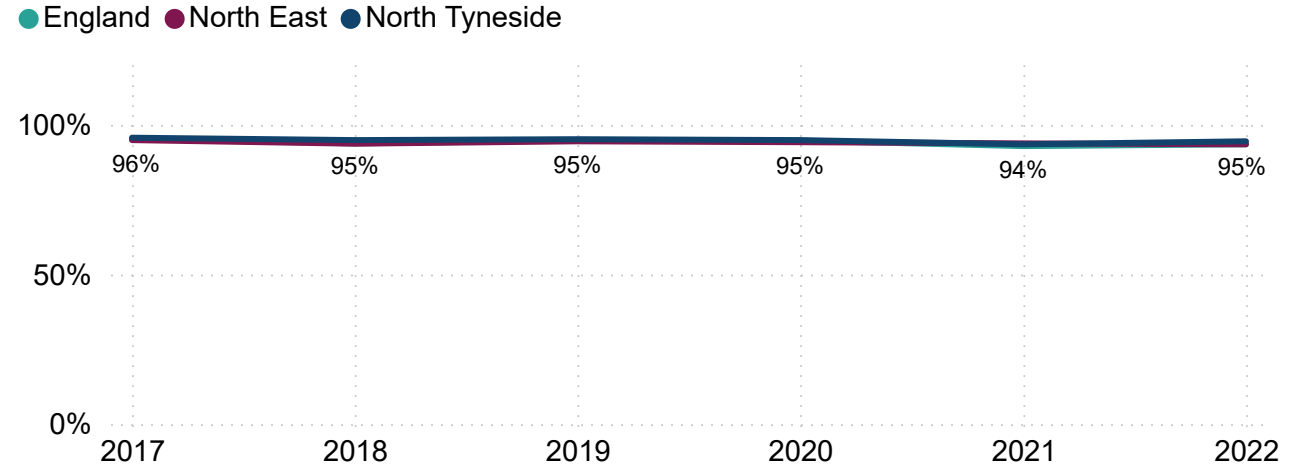

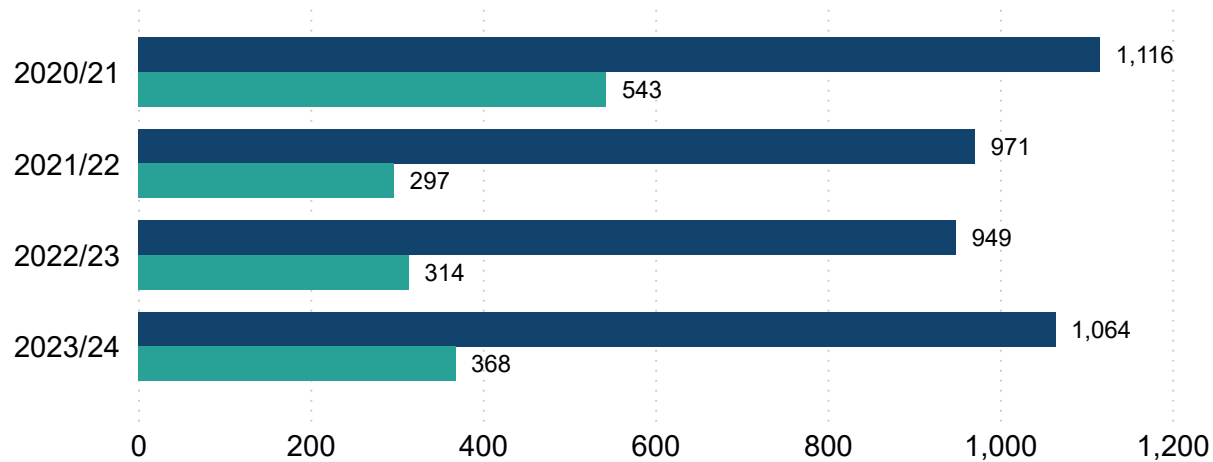


New businesses surviving for one year after being started

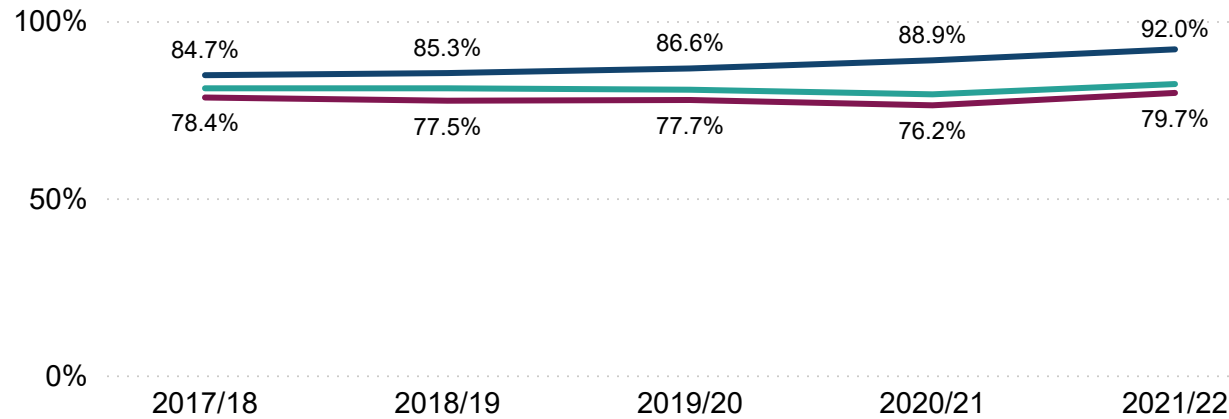

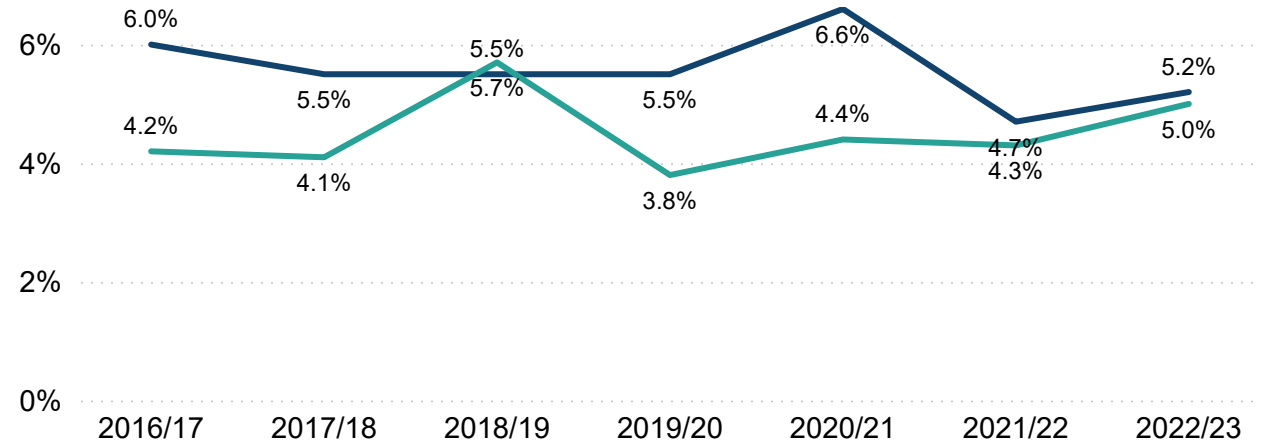
Positive destination, post Key Stage 5 (A level) - proportion in work, education or training

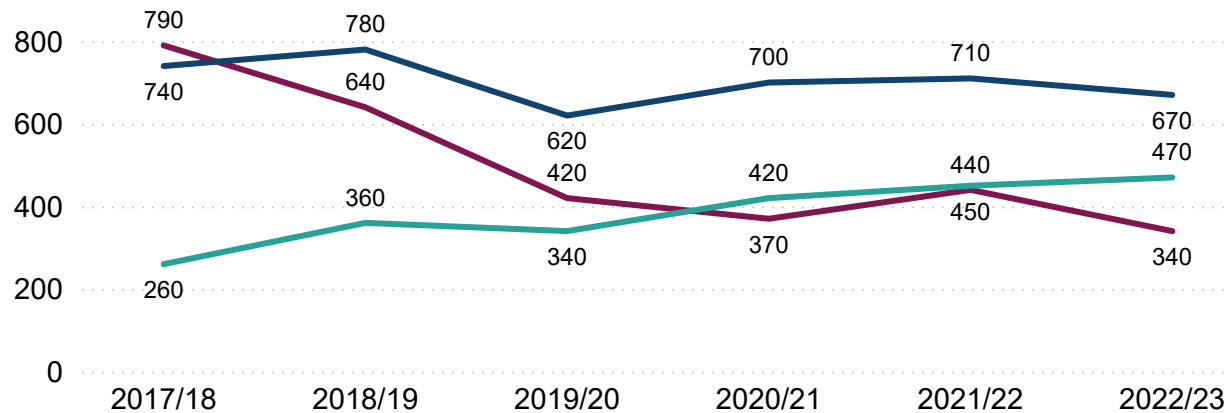
Proportion of 16-17 year olds Not in Education, Employment or Training (NEET)

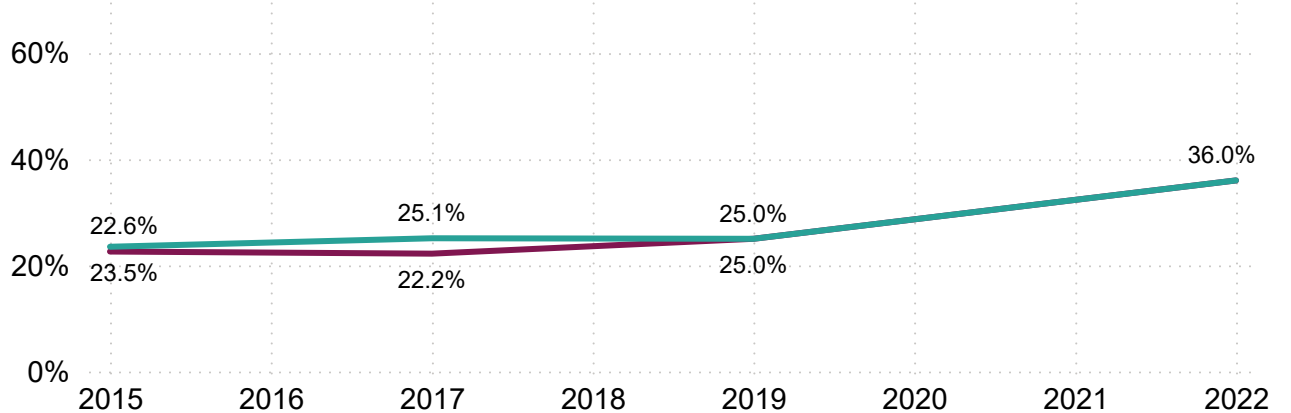
Number of apprenticeship starts in North Tyneside

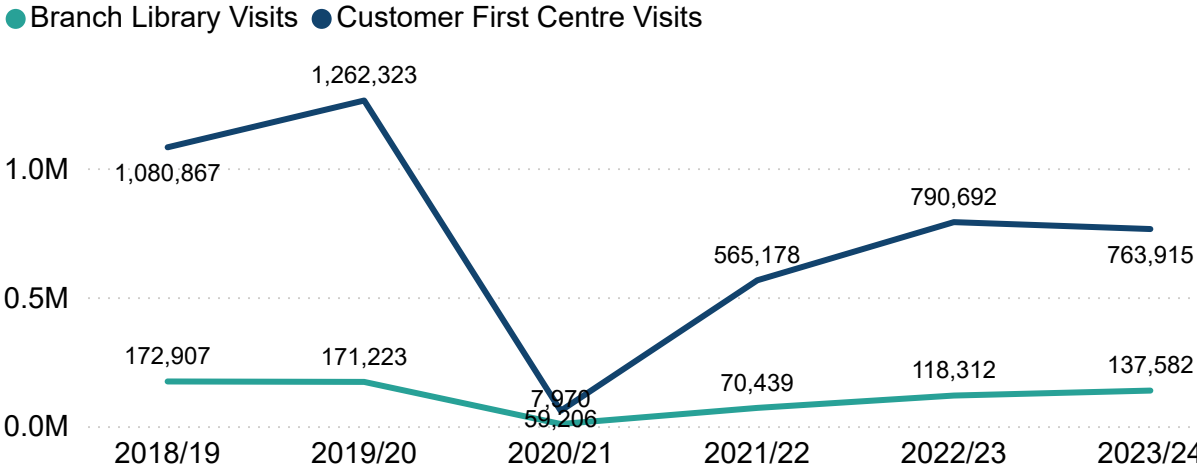

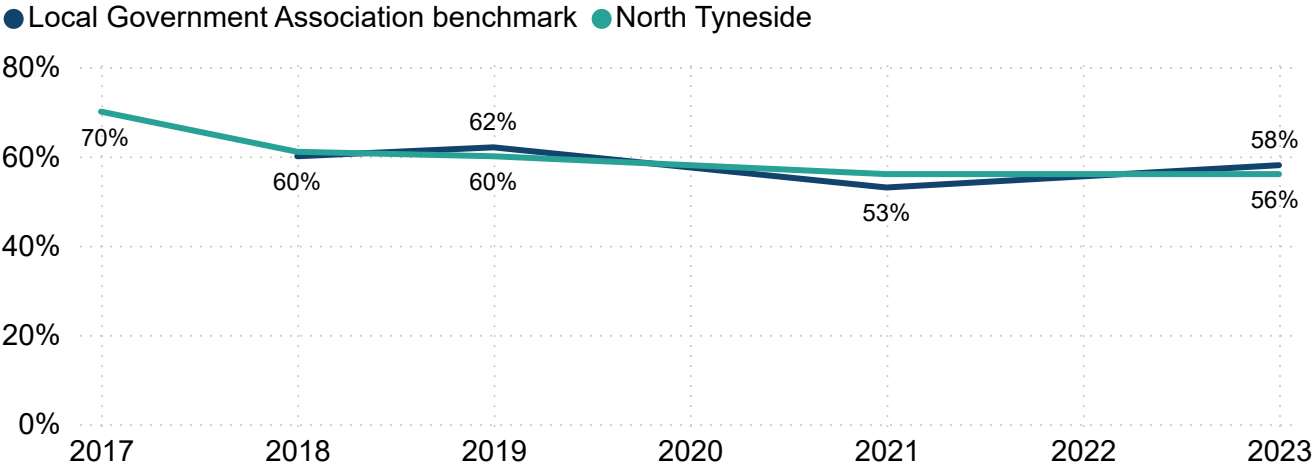

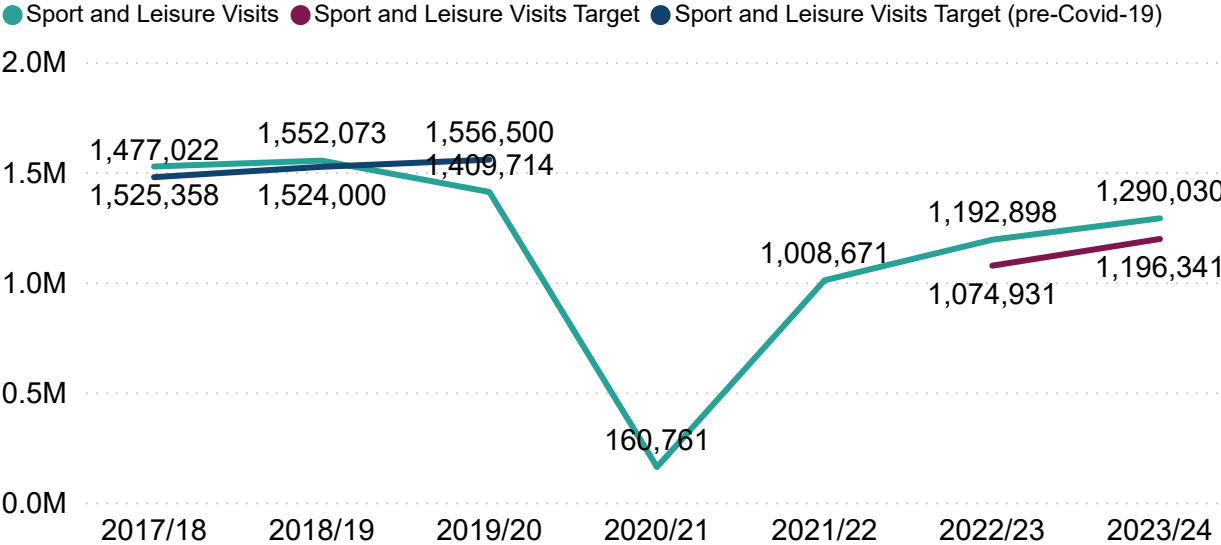

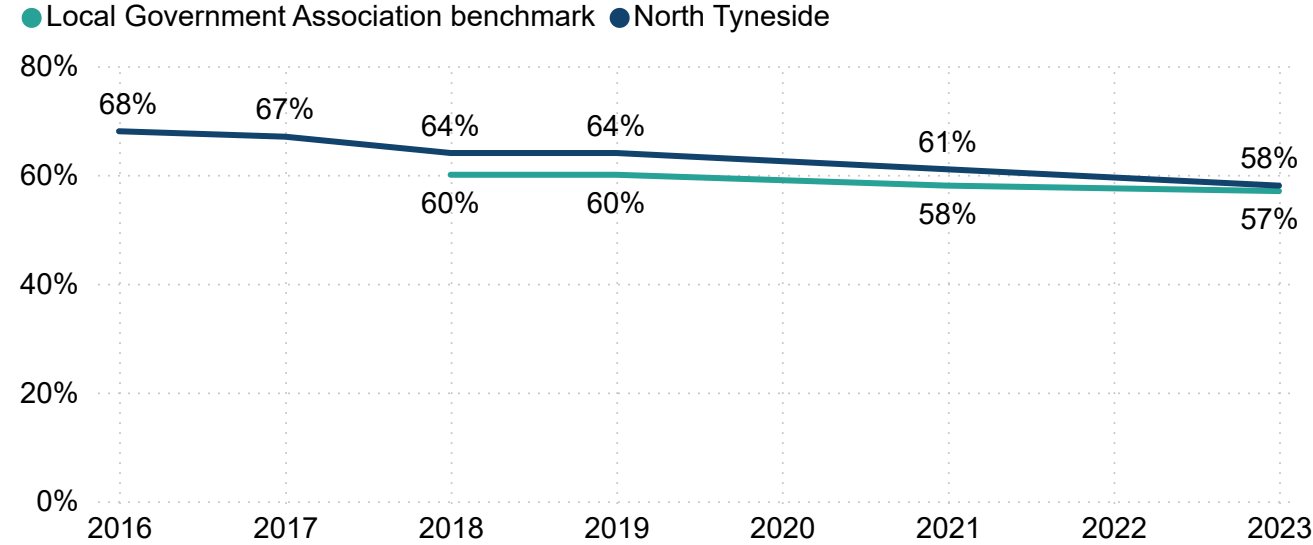

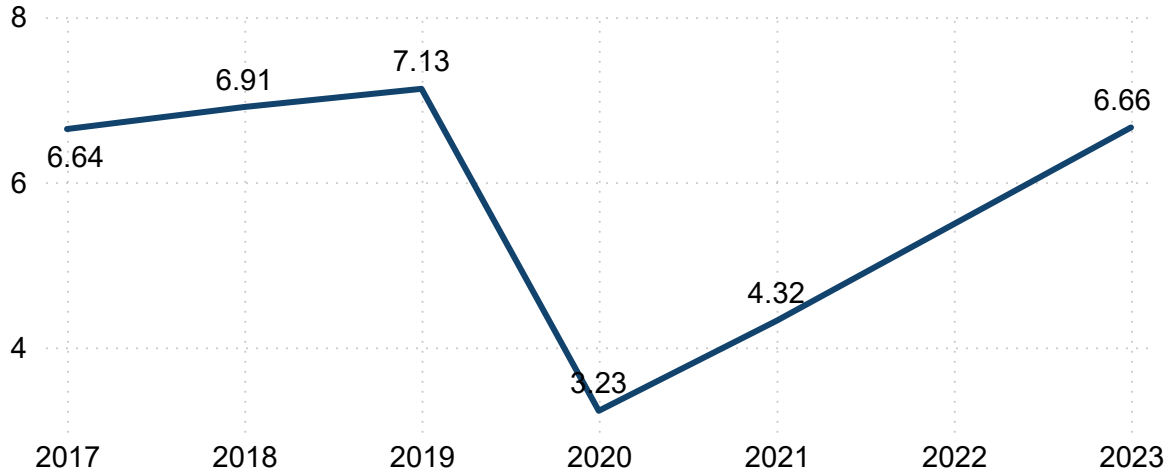

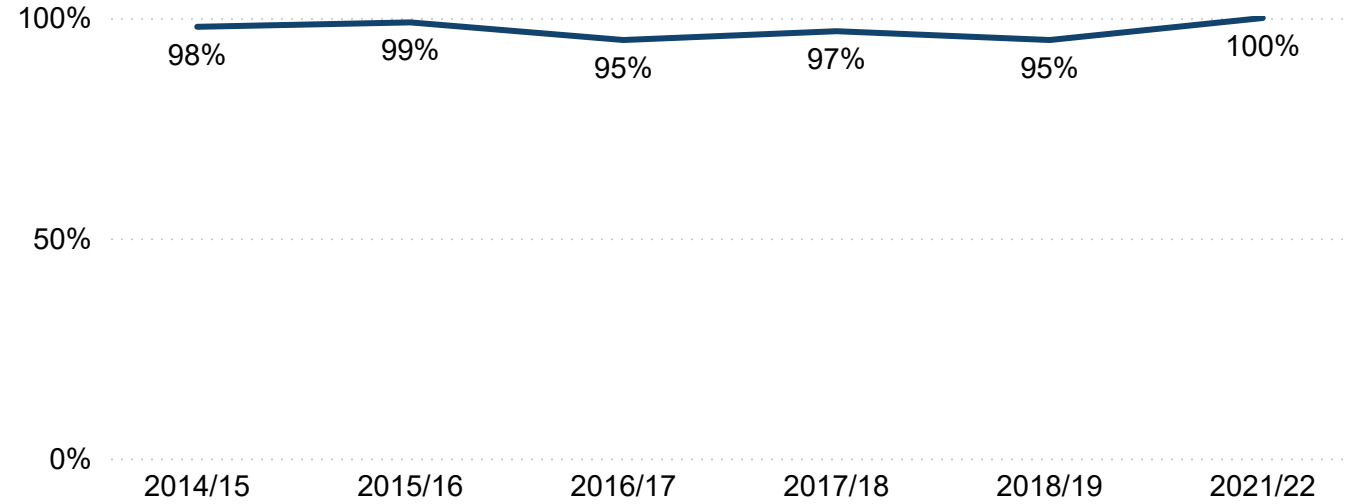

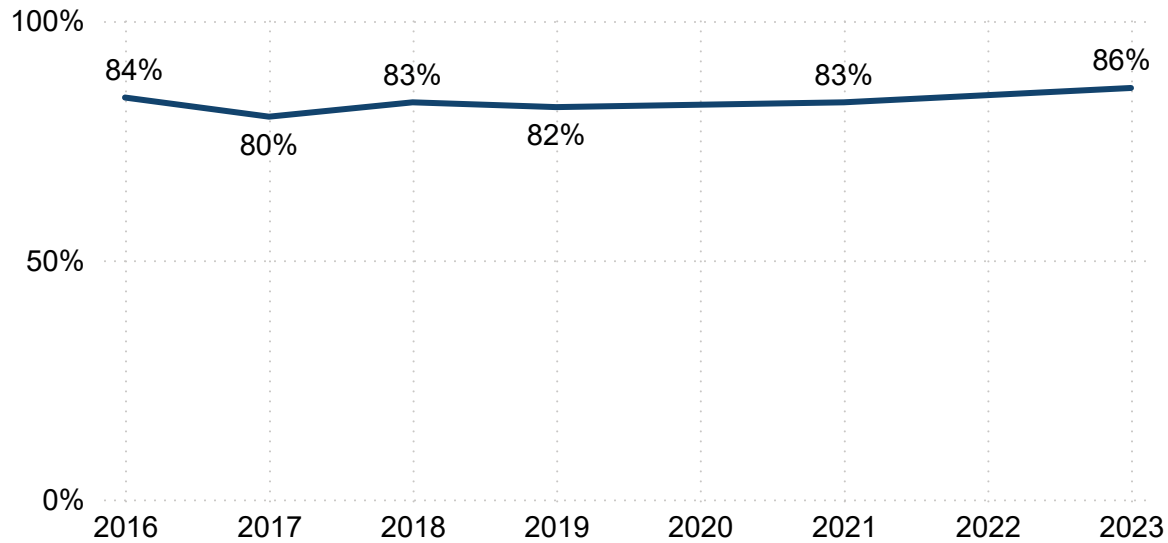
Number of day visits and overnight stays to North Tyneside (millions)



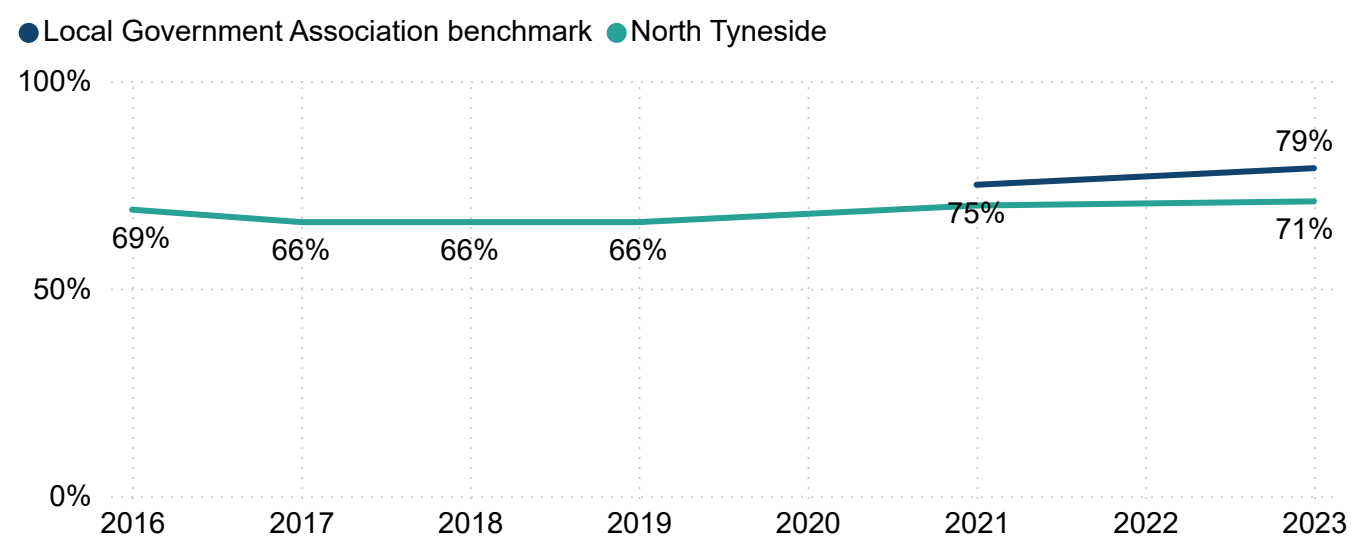
Proportion of visitors to North Tyneside who were satisfied

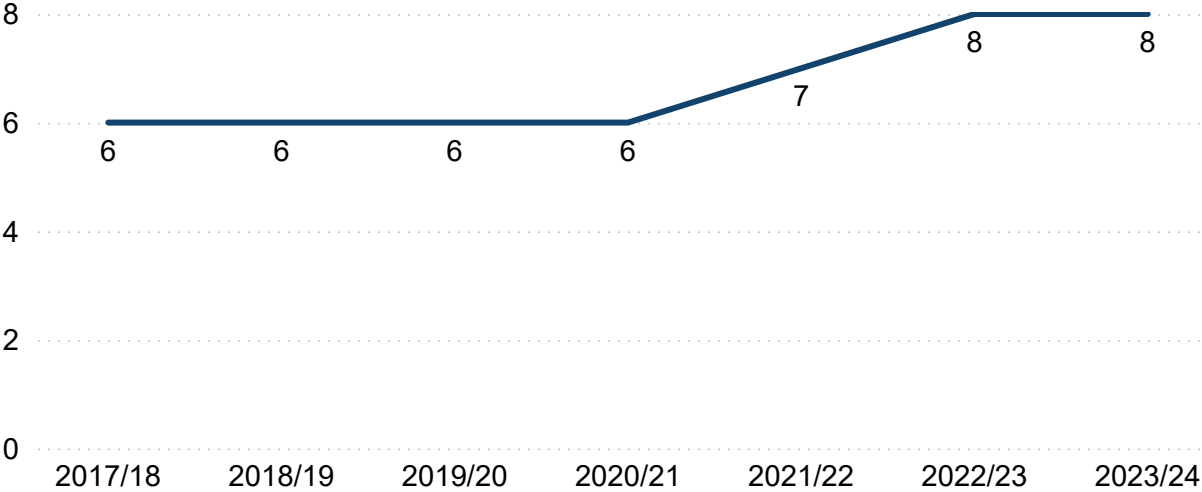

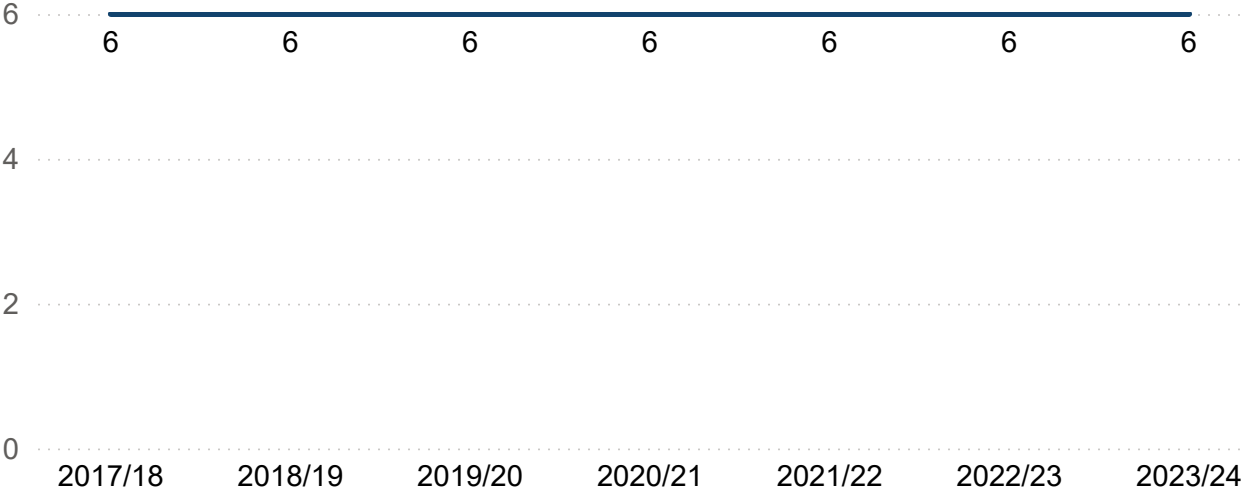

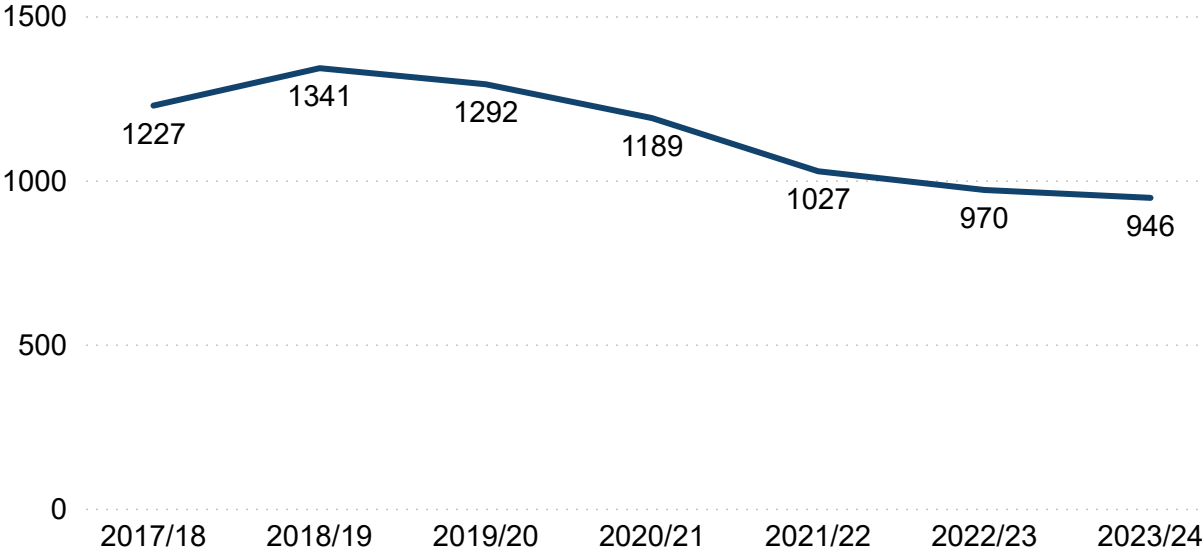

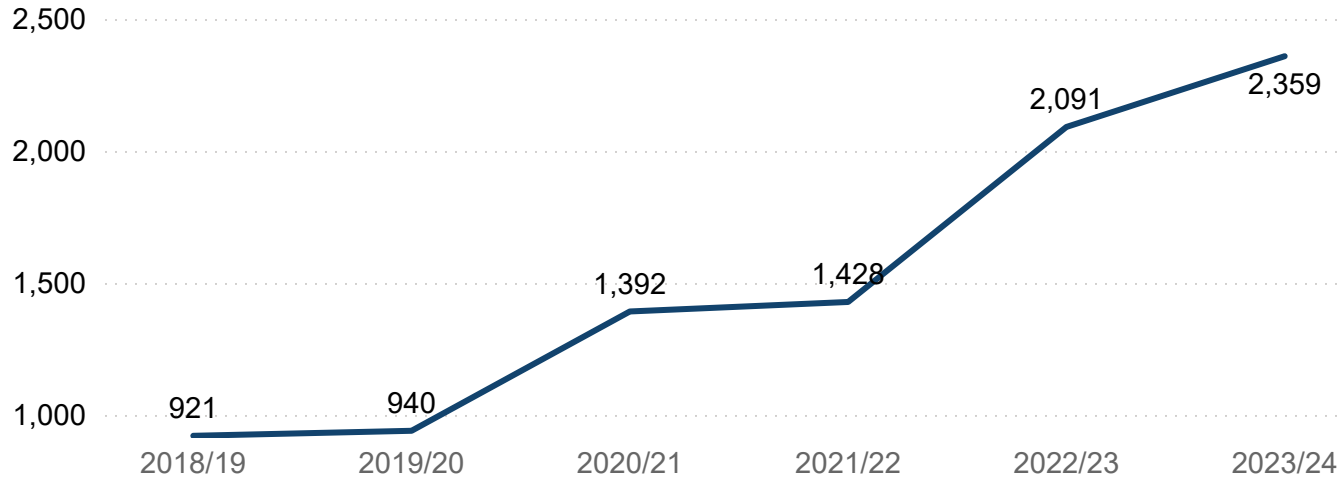

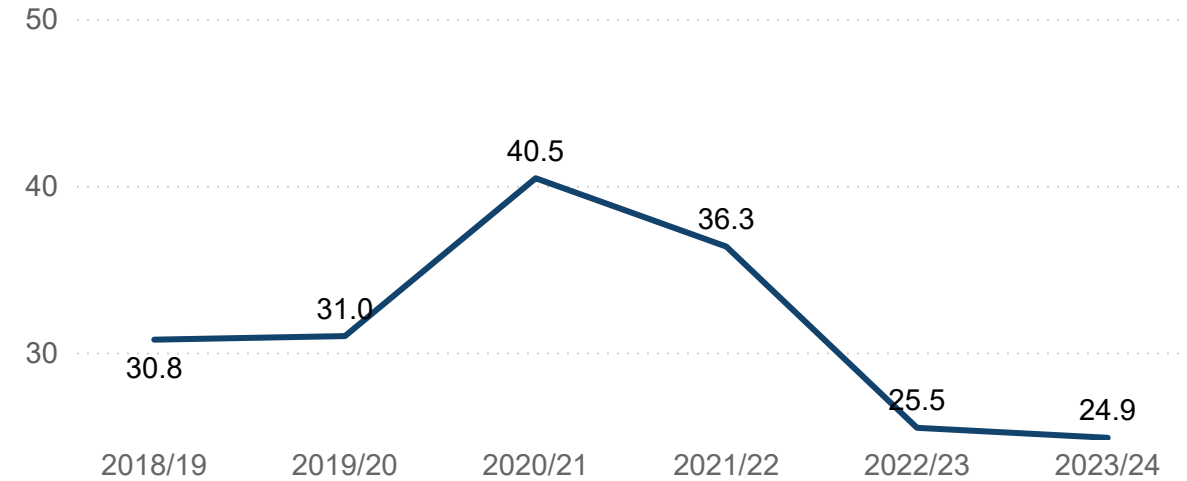

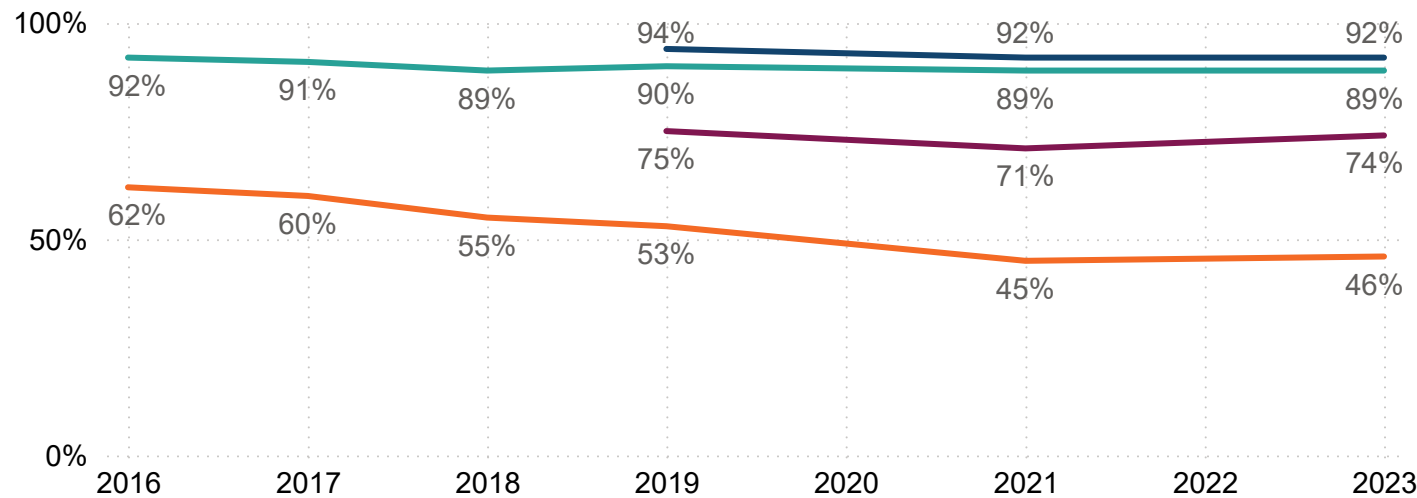

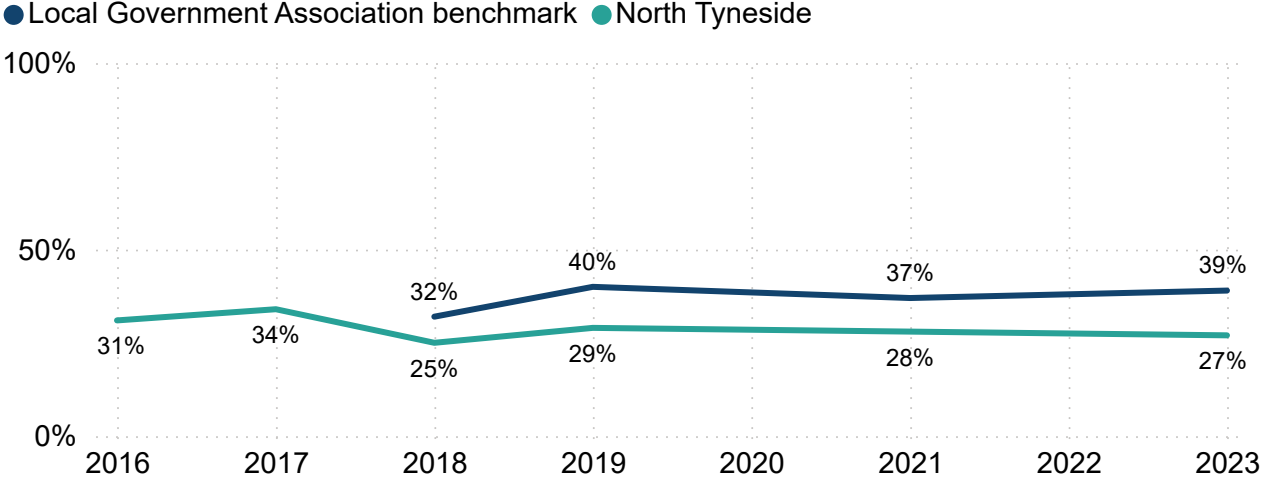

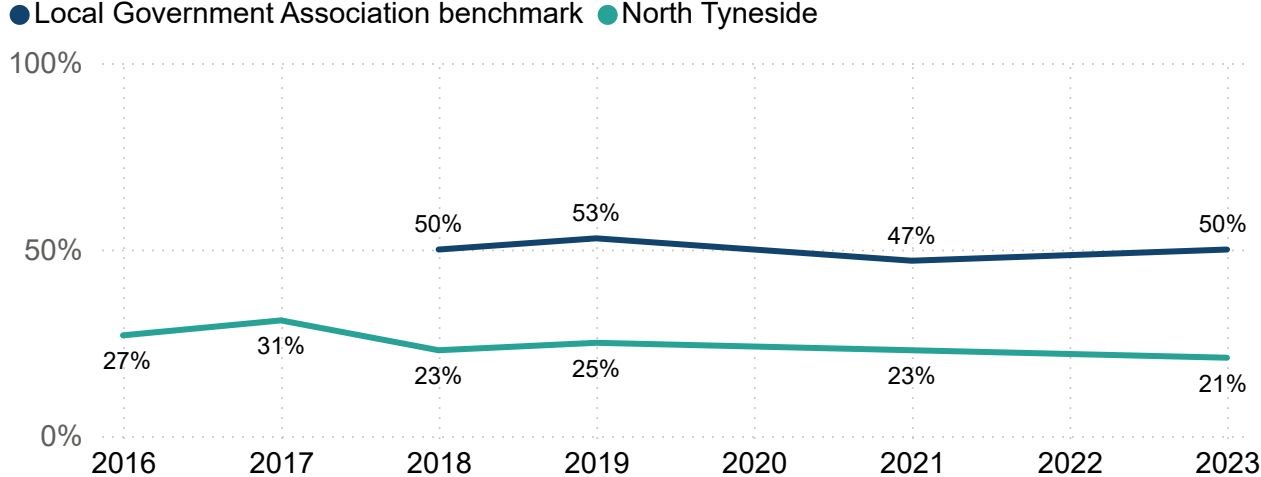
Proportion of residents satisfied with road maintenance

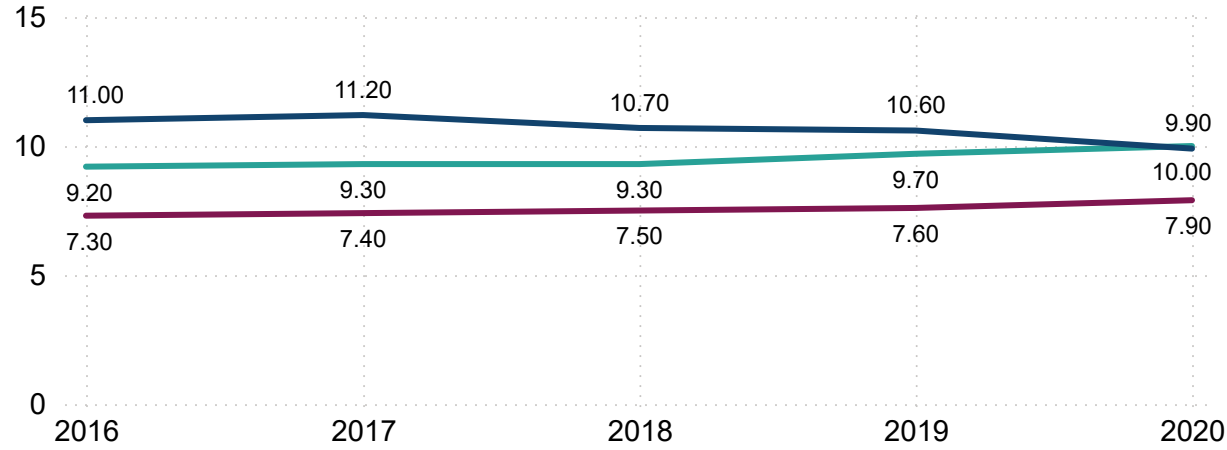

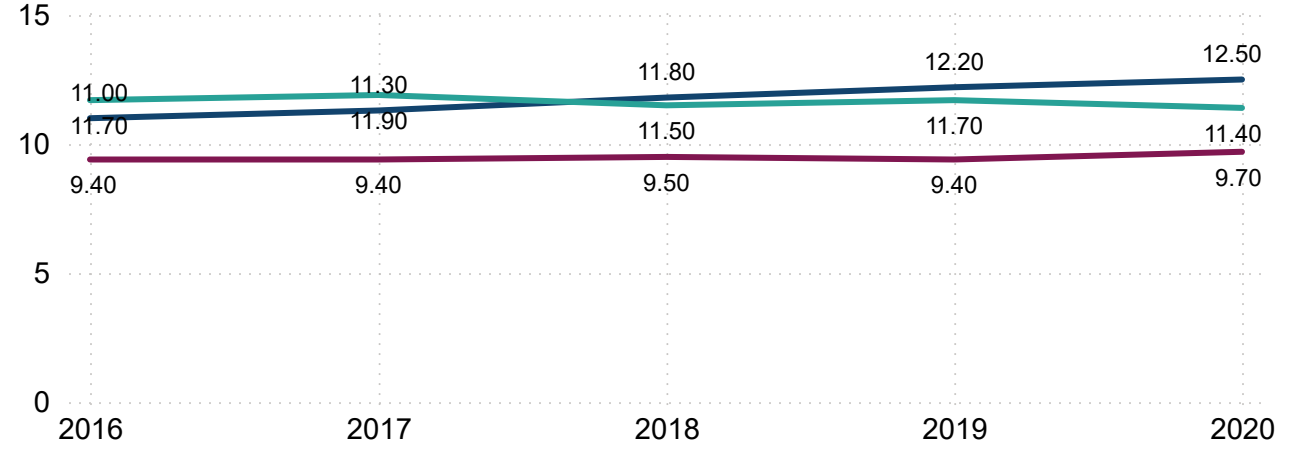


Inequality in male life expectancy at birth (years)

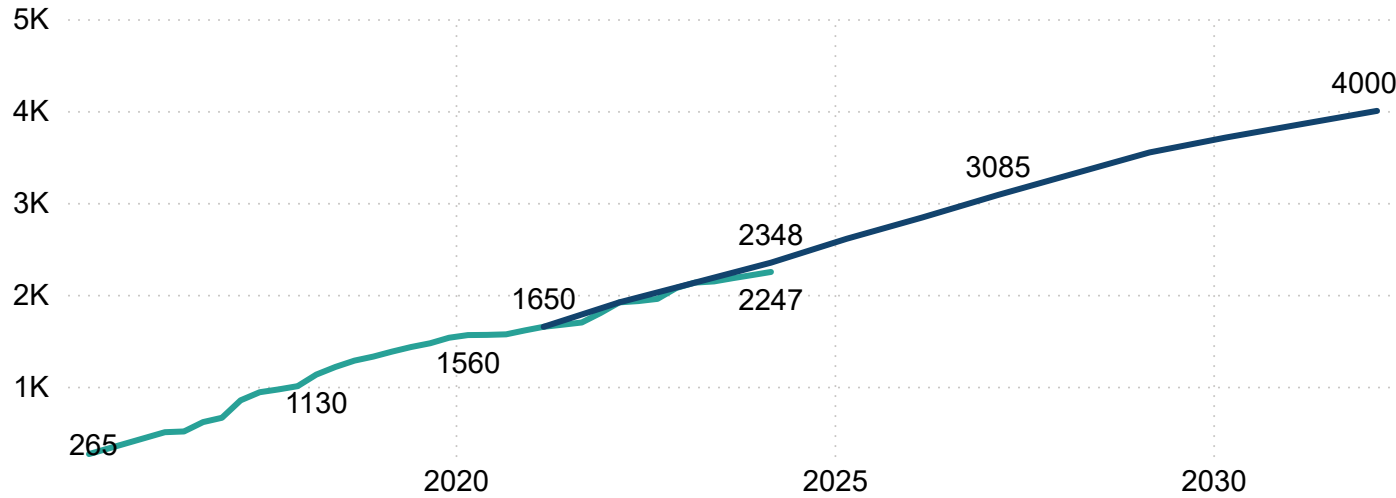

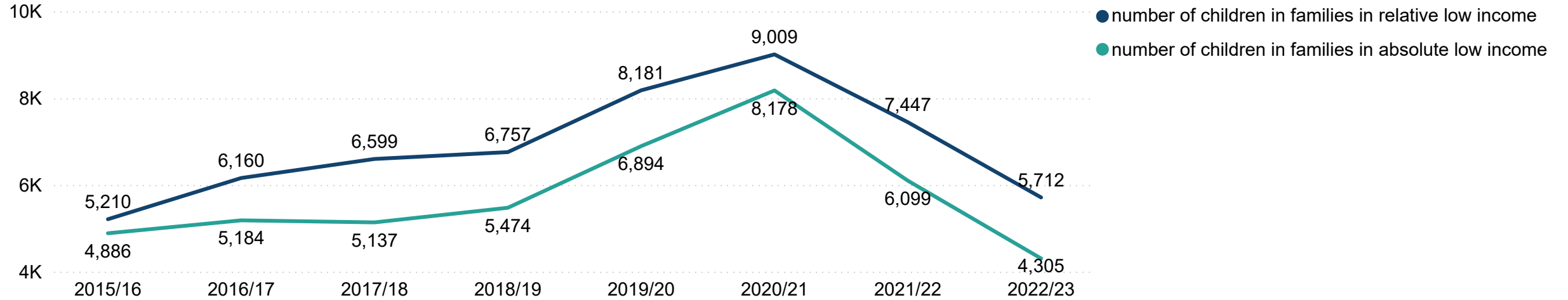

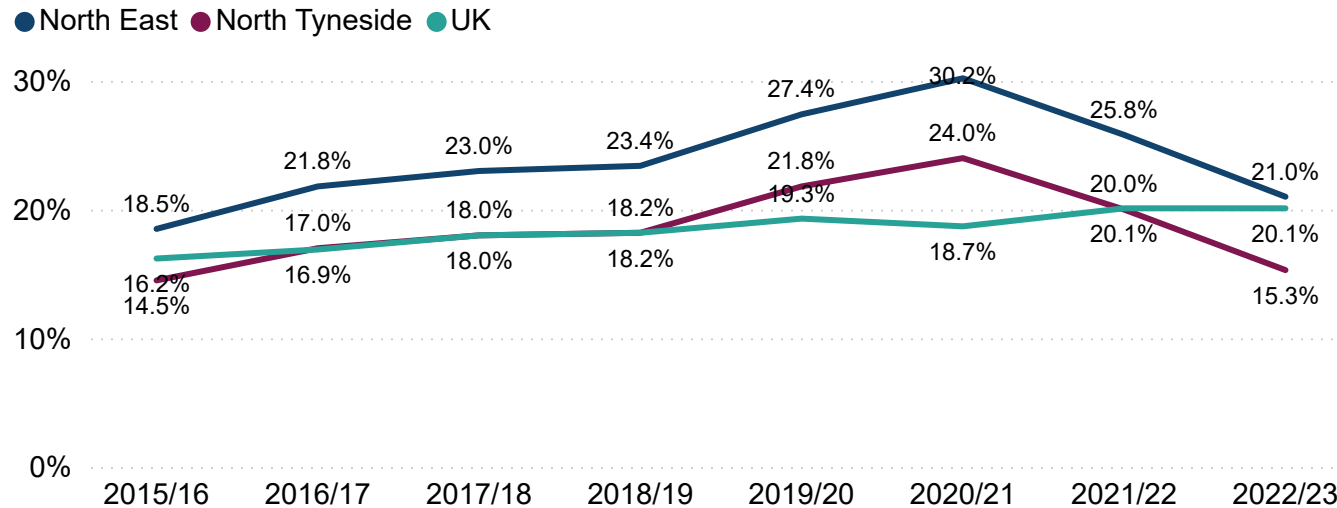

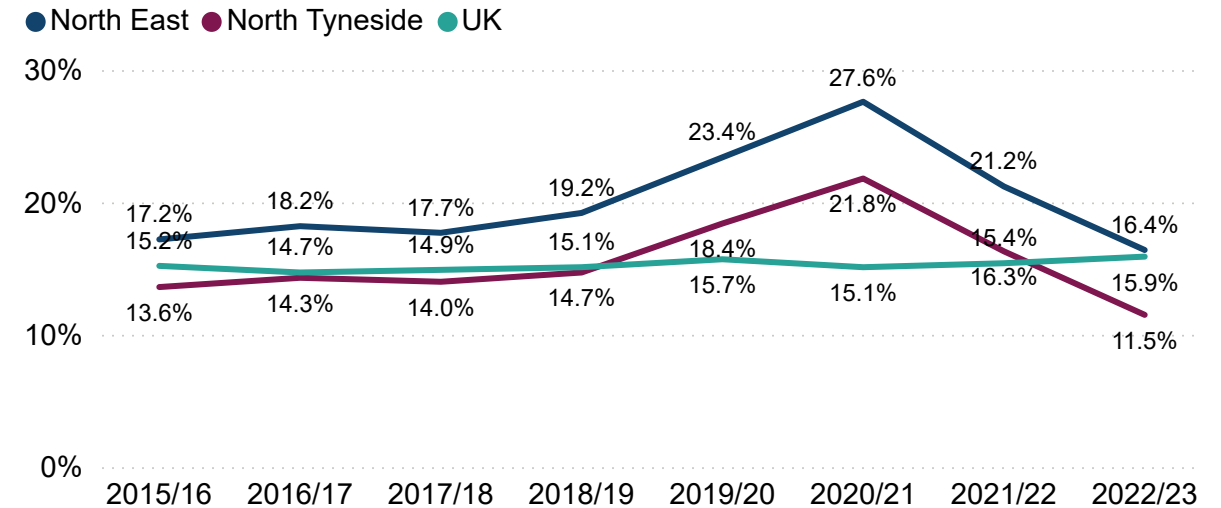

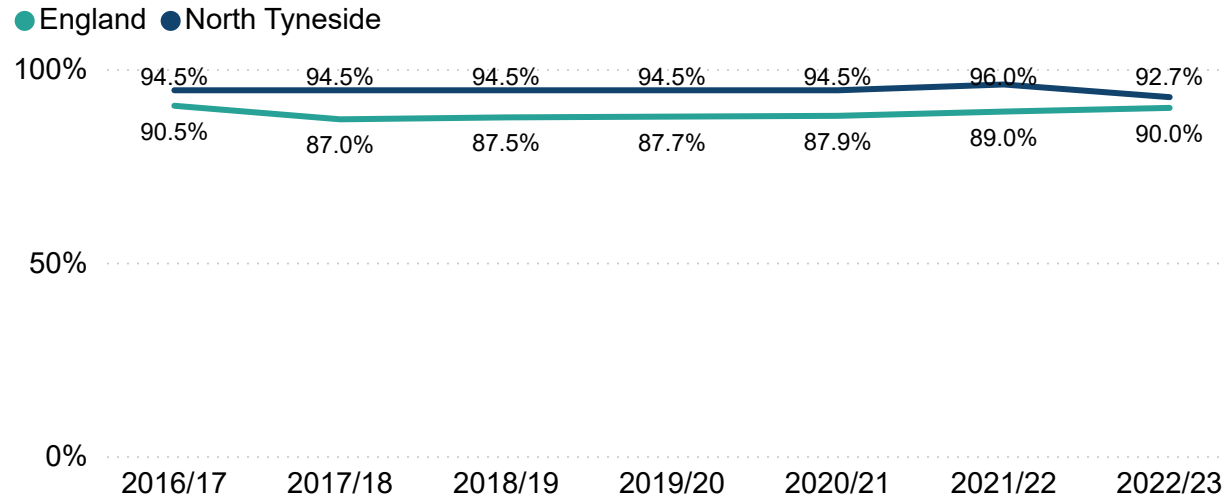

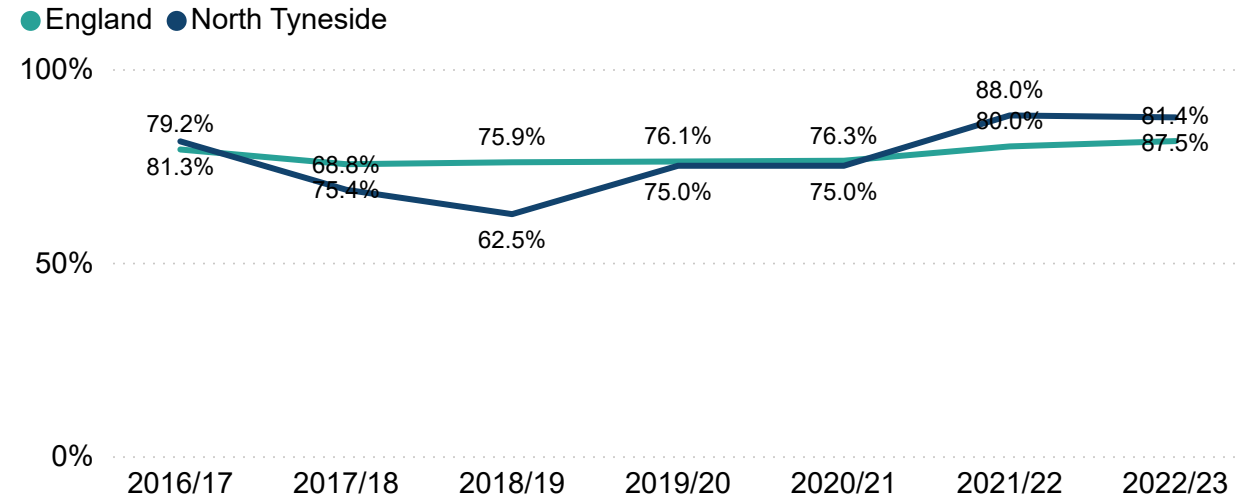

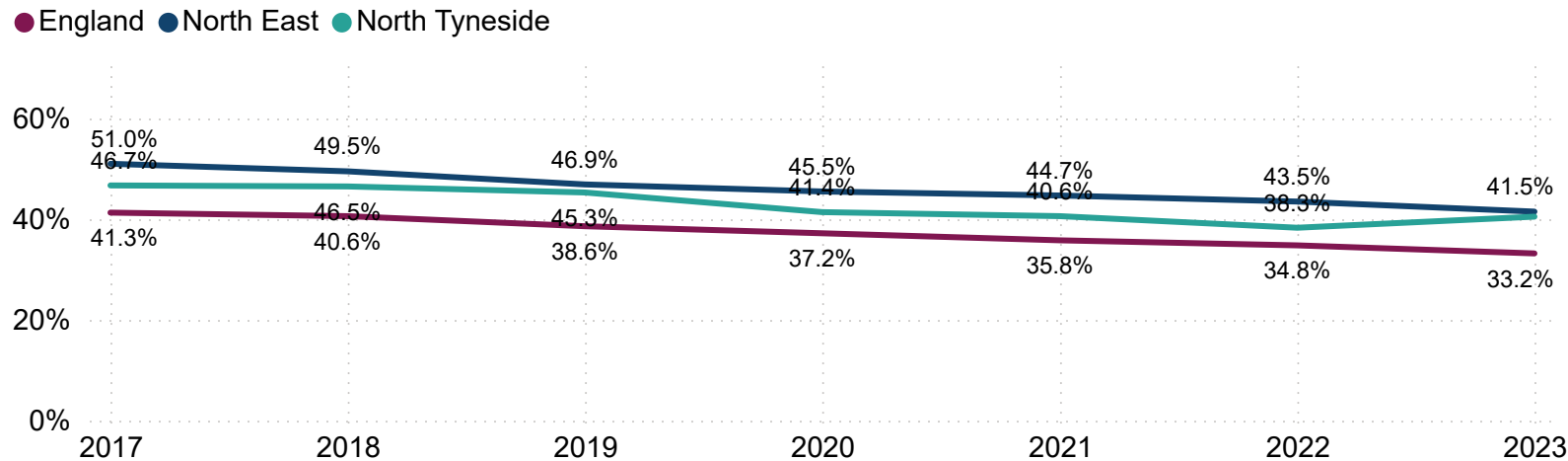

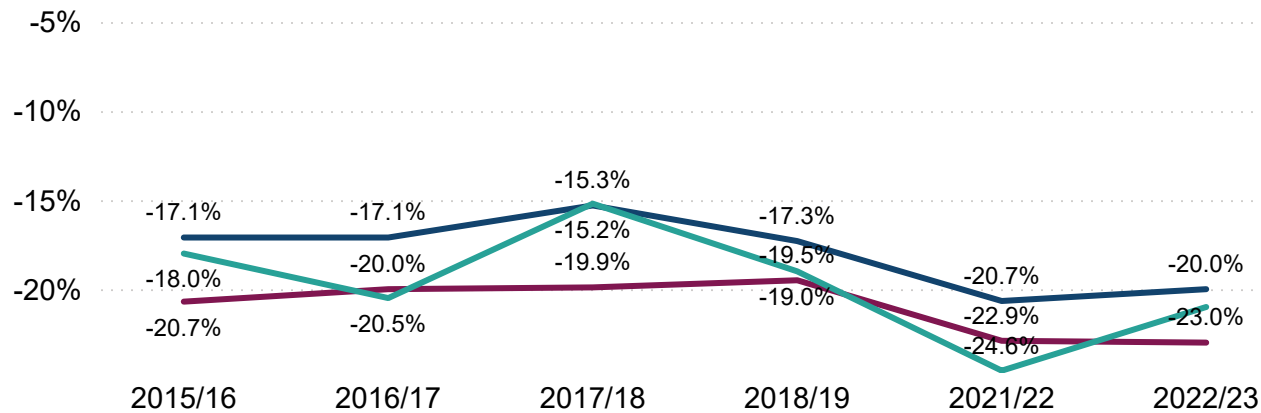

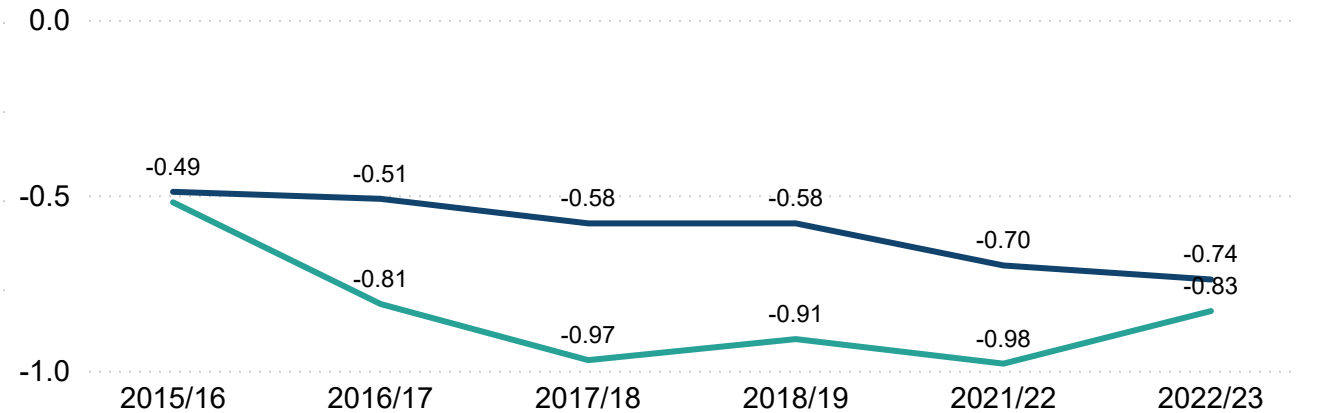
Gap between disadvantaged pupils and non-disadvantaged pupils reaching the Expected Level in Reading, Writing and Maths at Key Stage 2

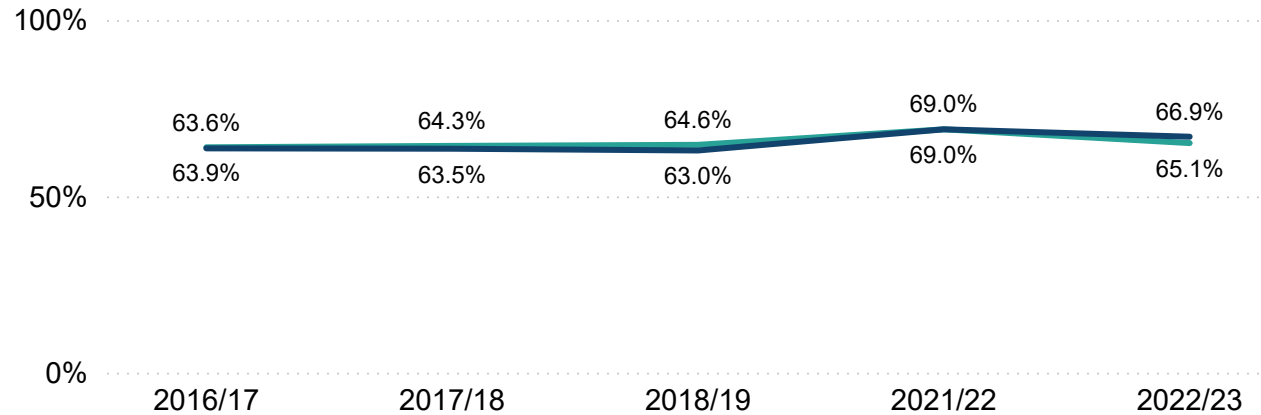
Progress 8 gap between disadvantaged pupils and their peers (mean average gap)

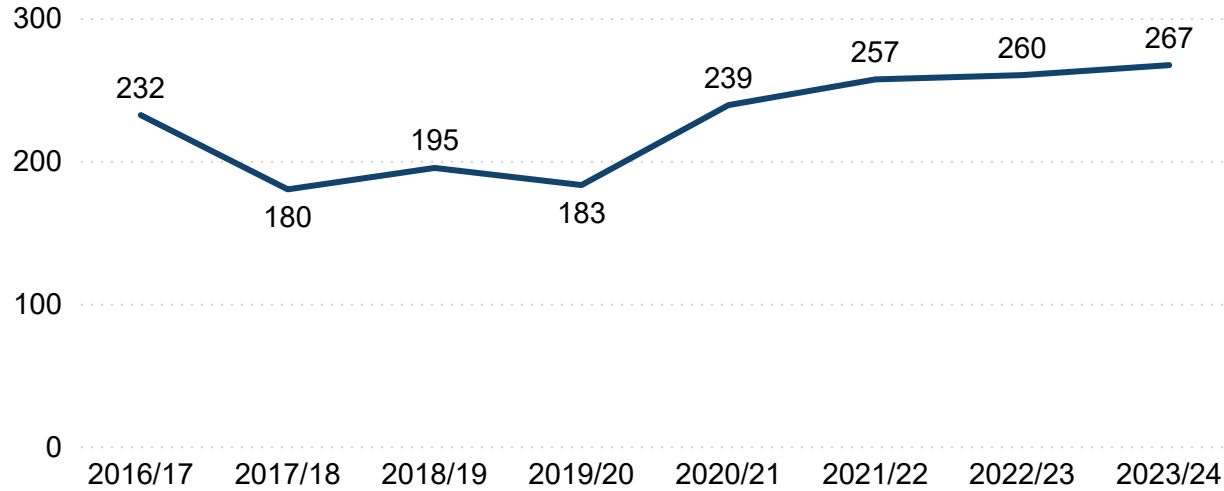

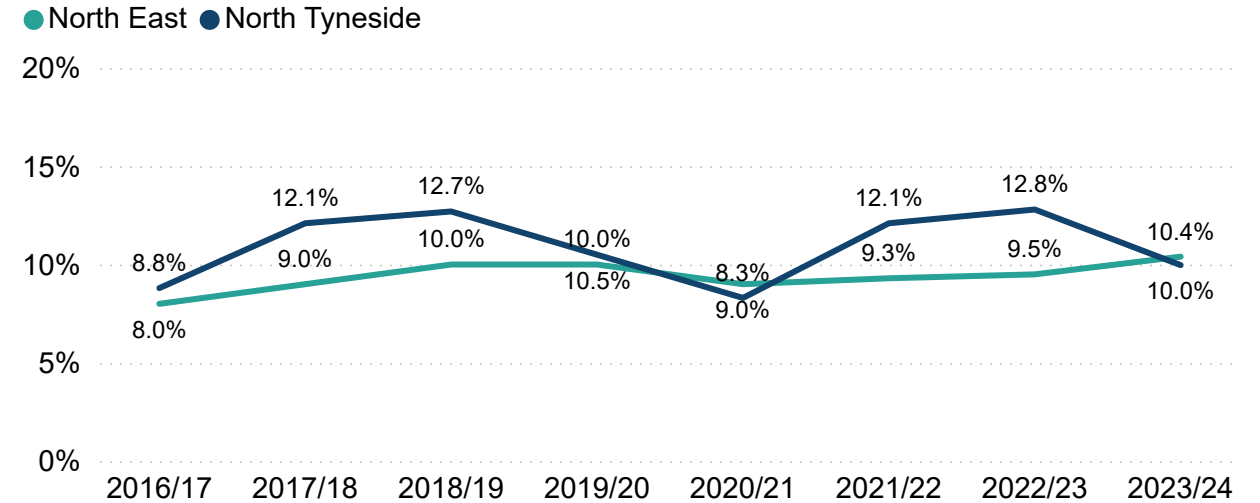

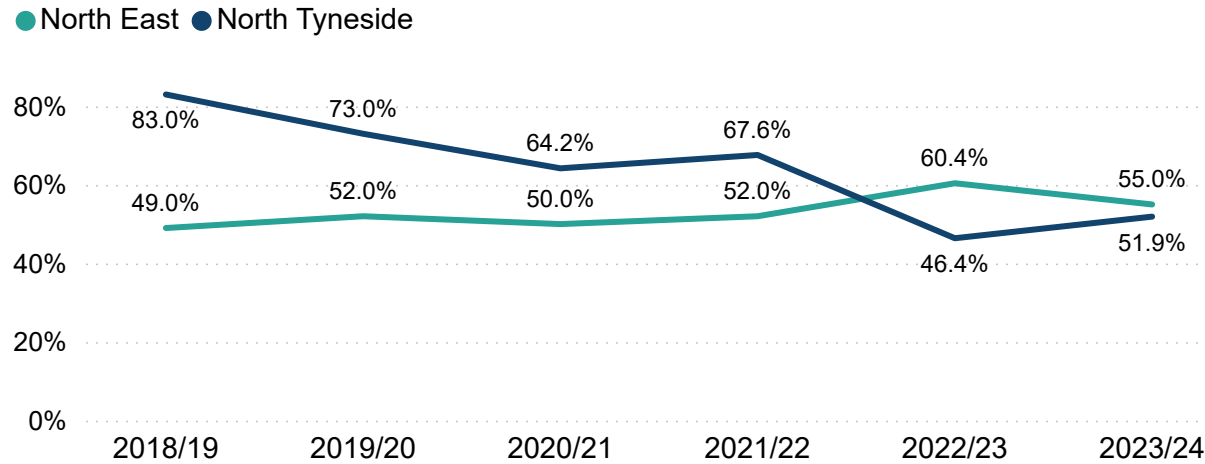

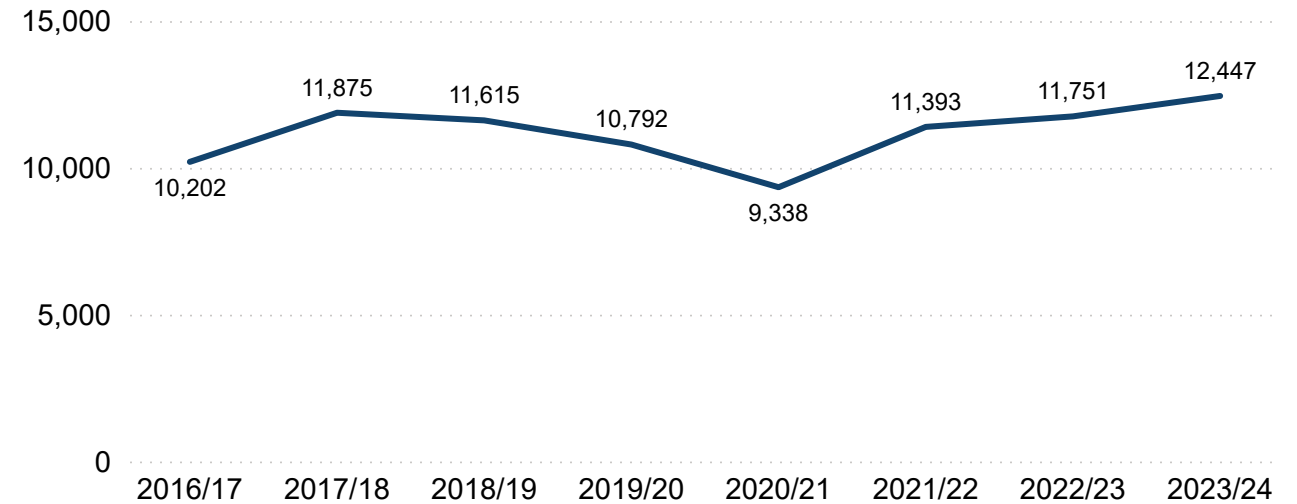

Number of contacts to safeguarding services - children



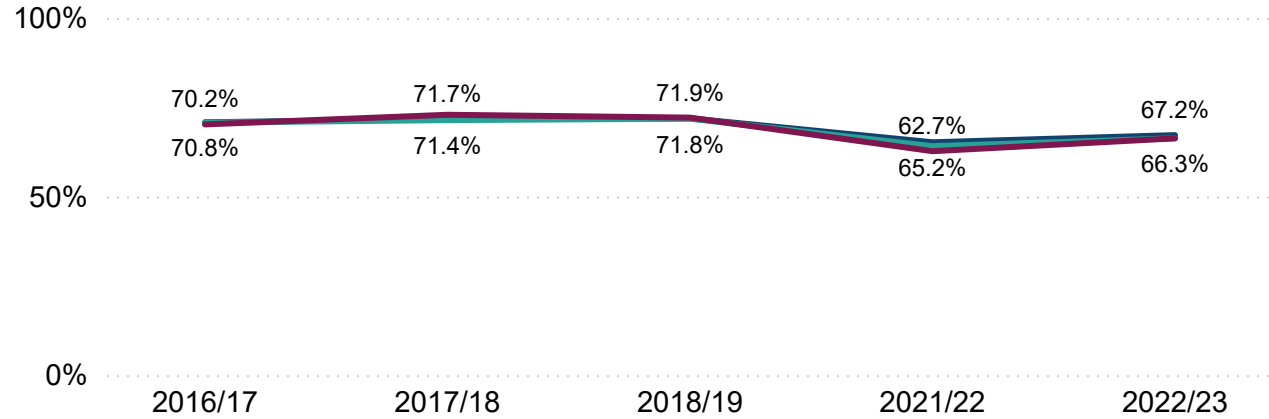

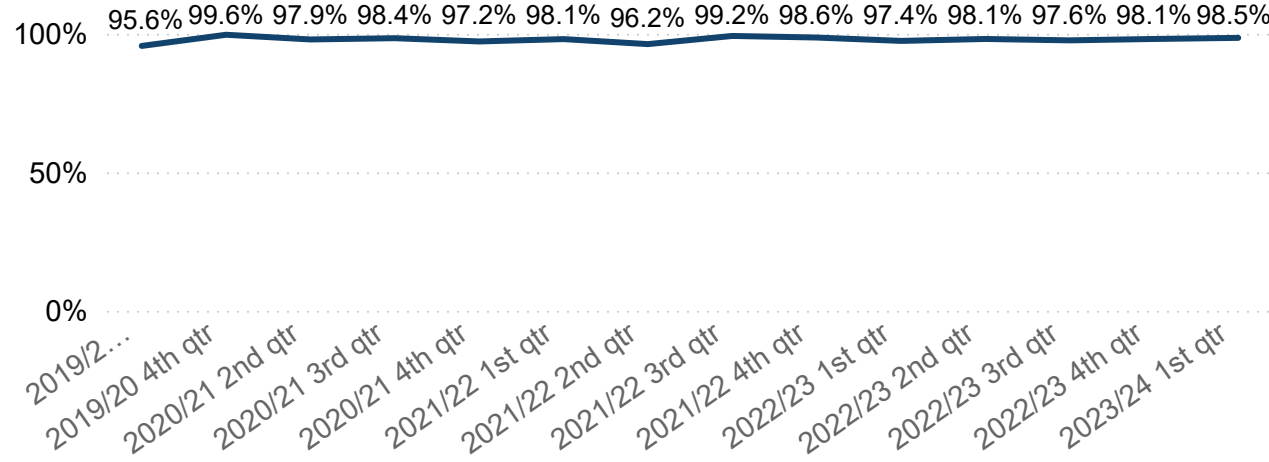

Proportion of children who received a 2-2½ year review using Ages and Stages Questionnaire (ASQ-3)

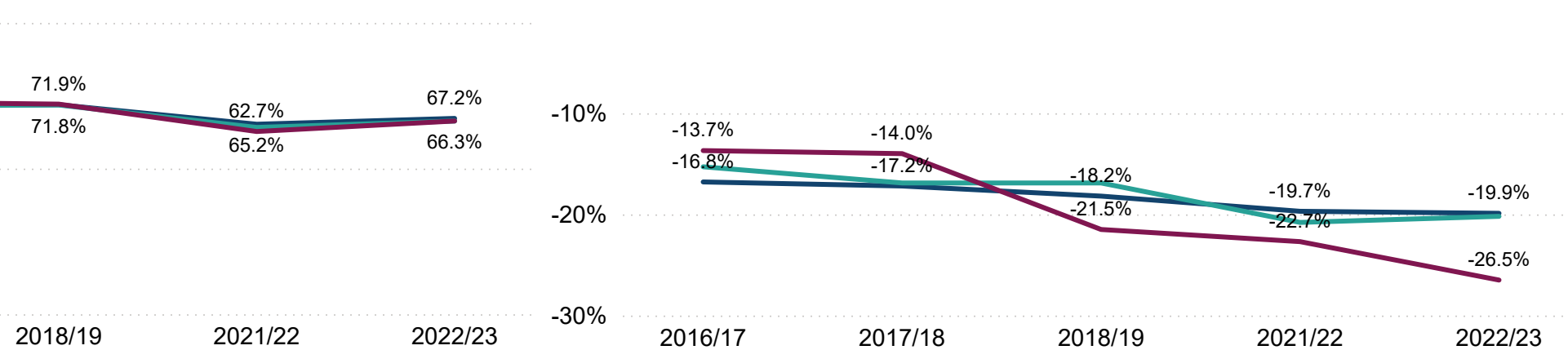


Gap between disadvantaged pupils and their peers reaching the expected level at Foundation Stage

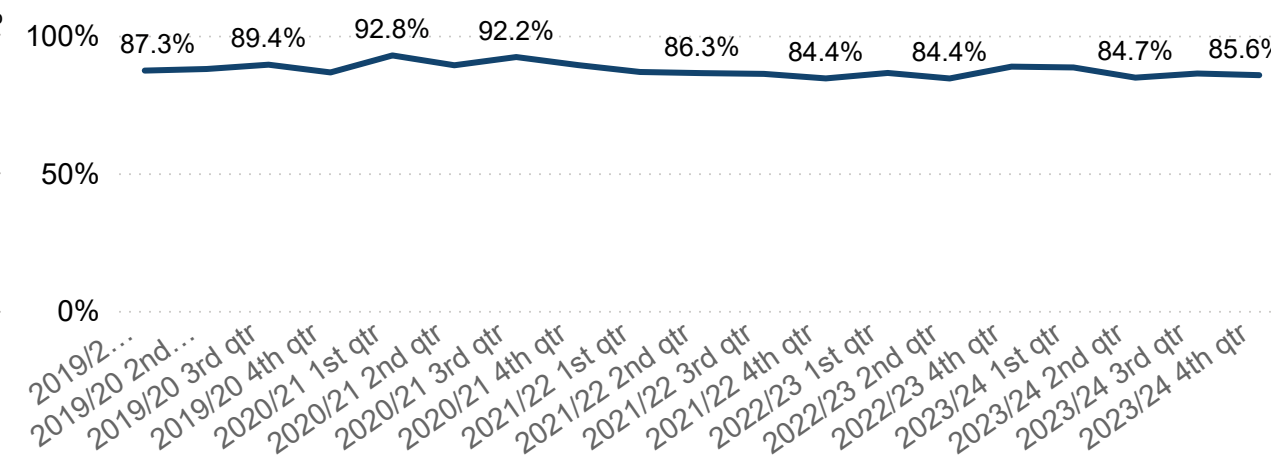

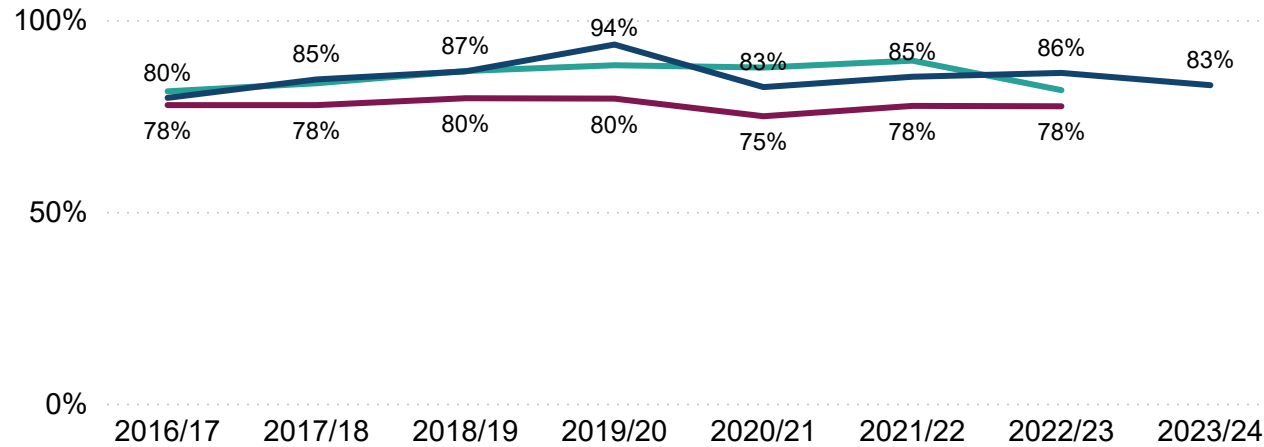

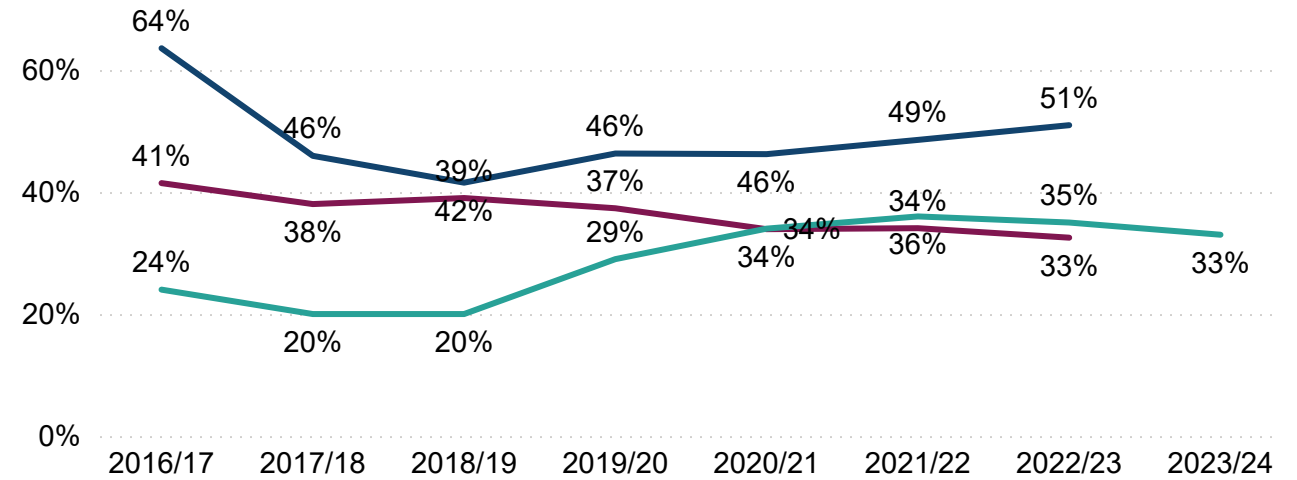

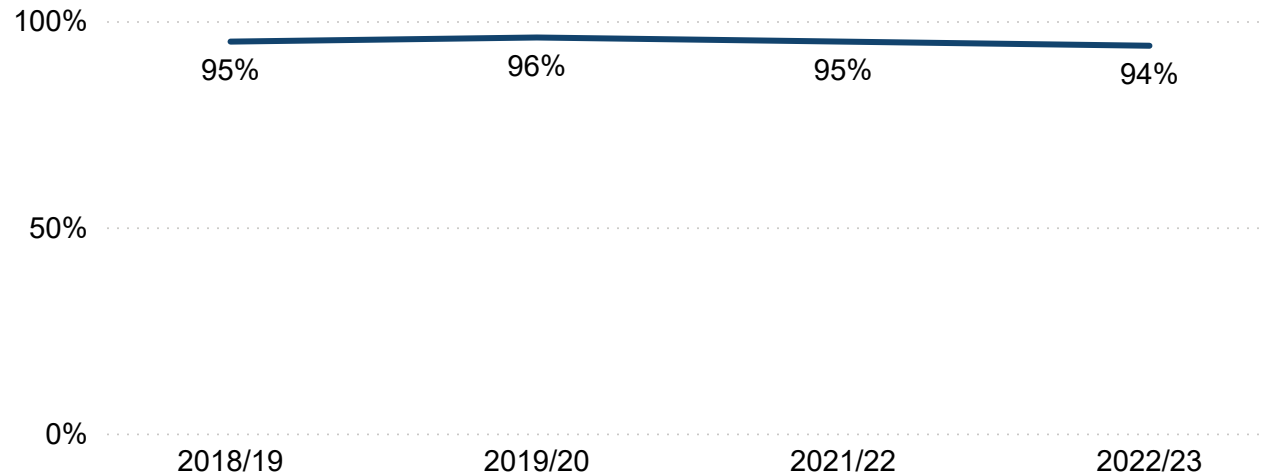

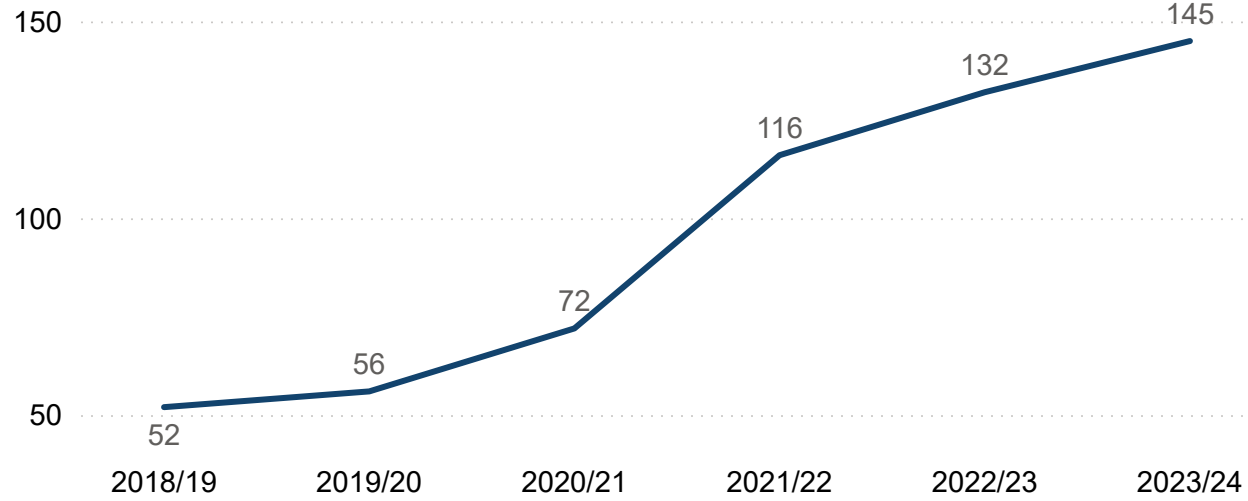

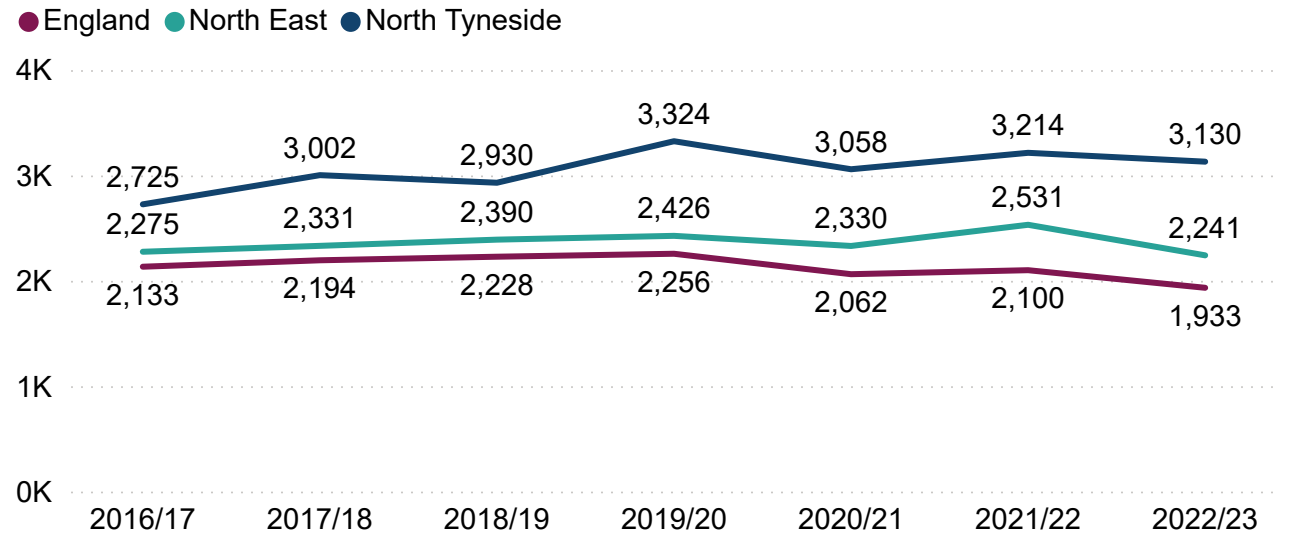

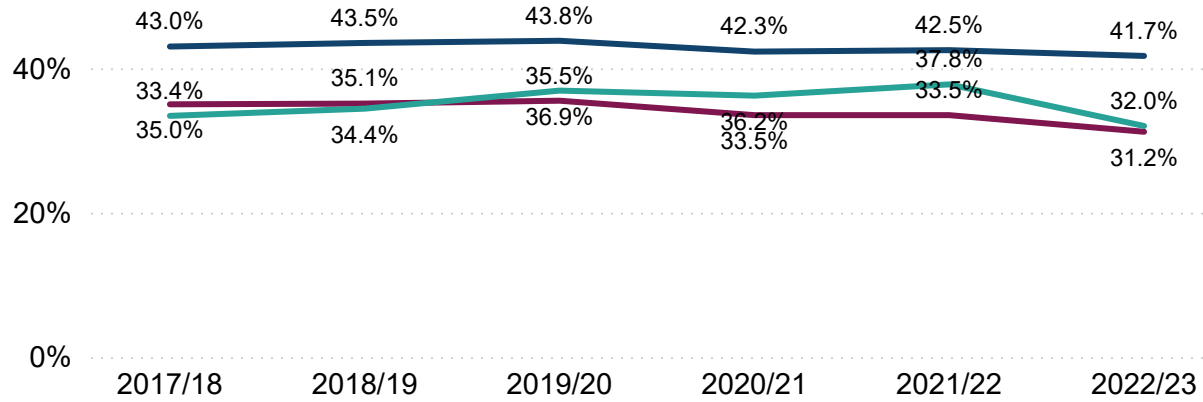

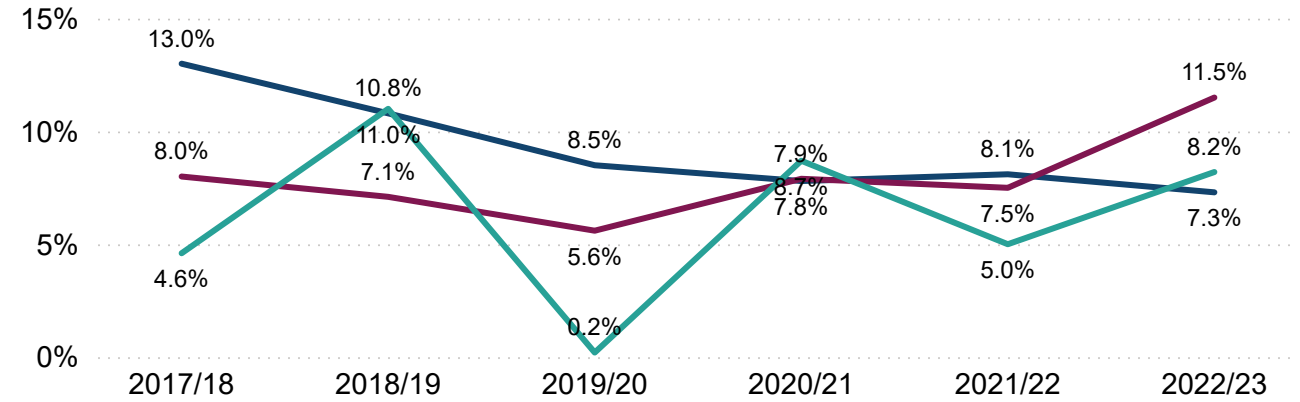

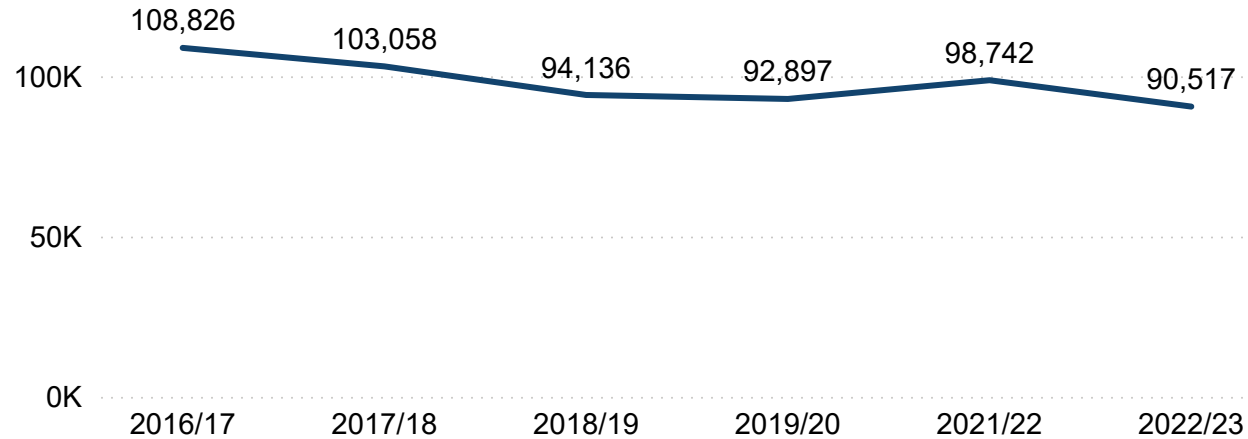

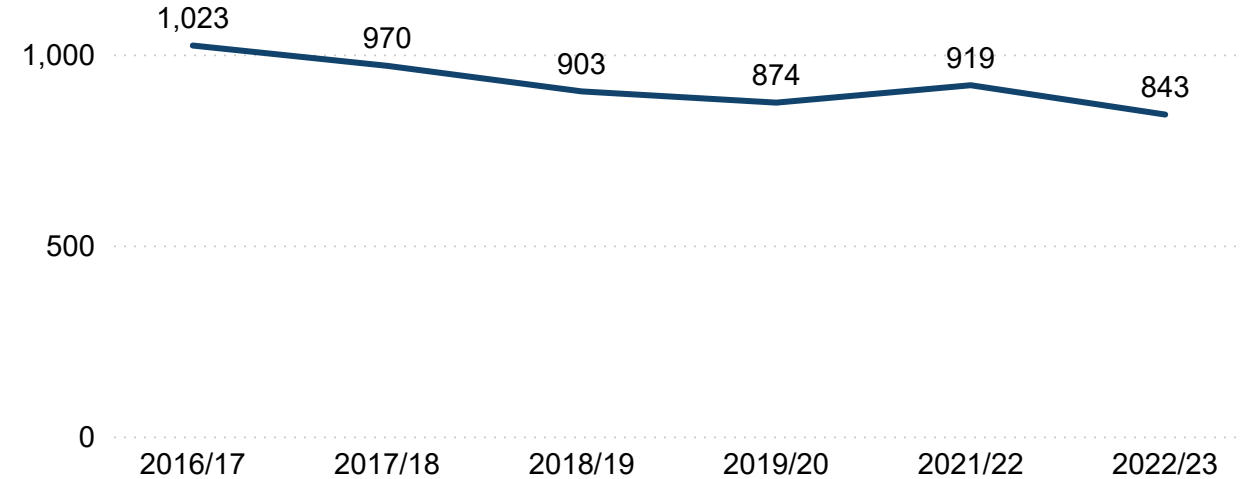

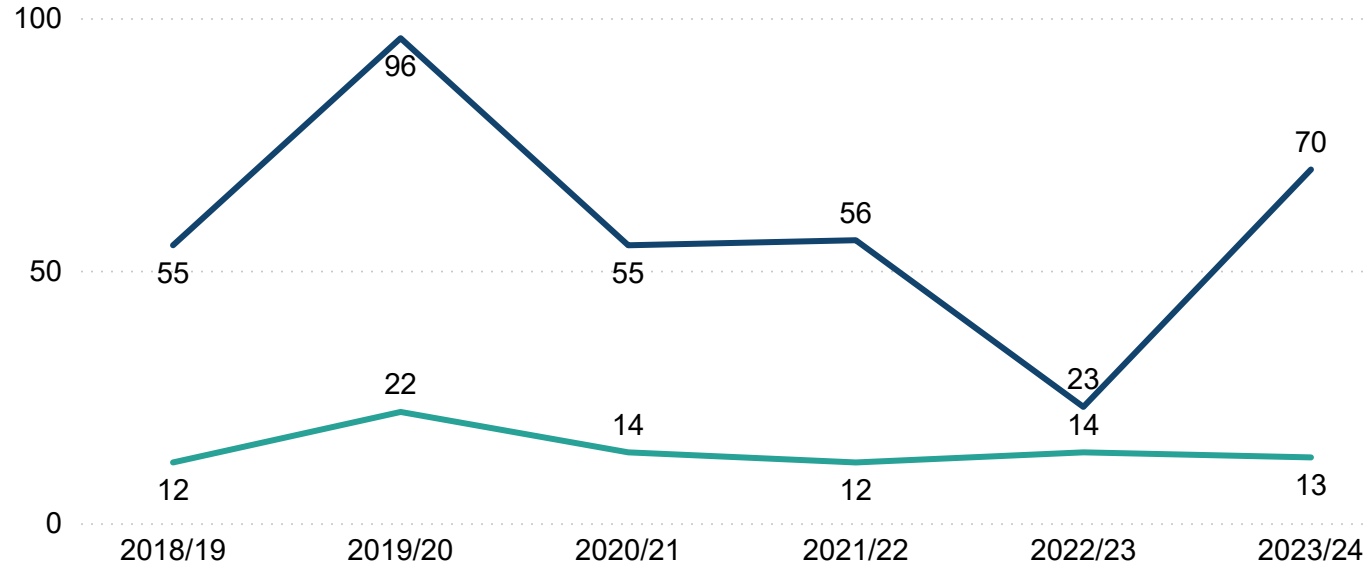

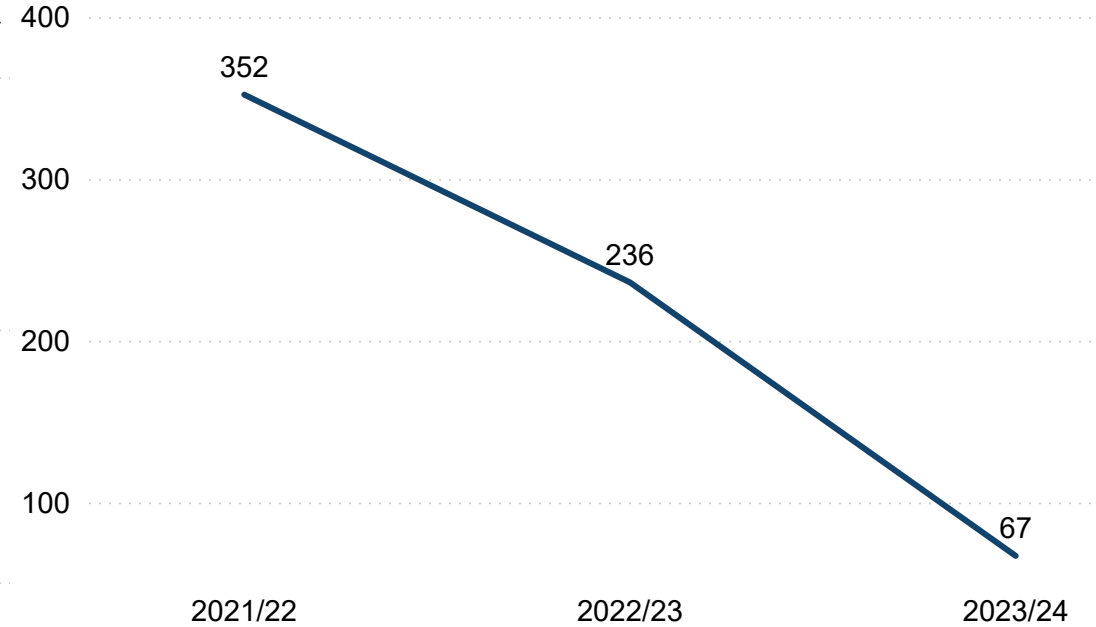

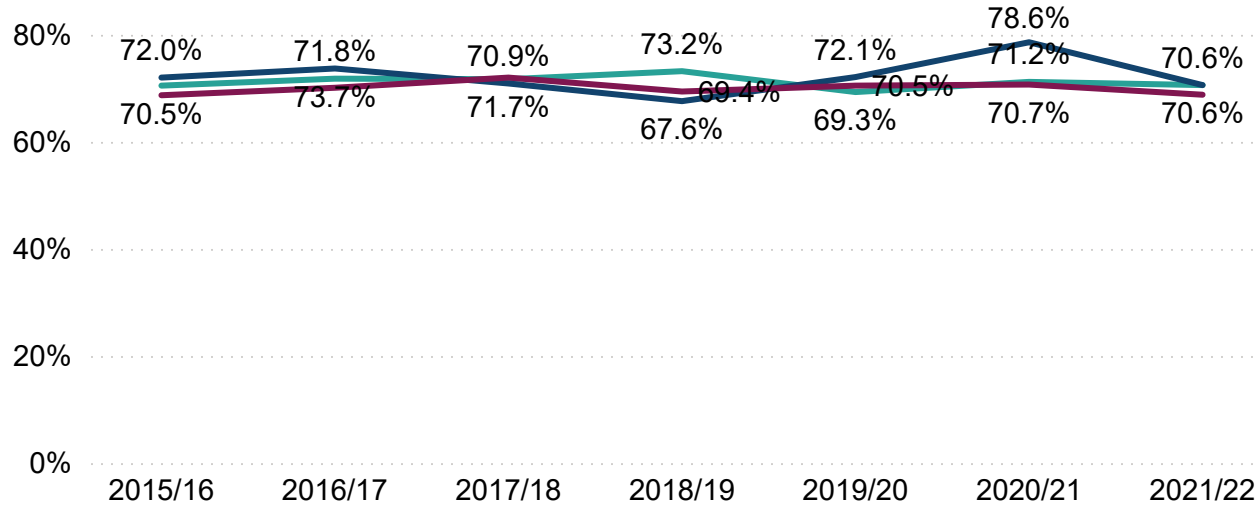

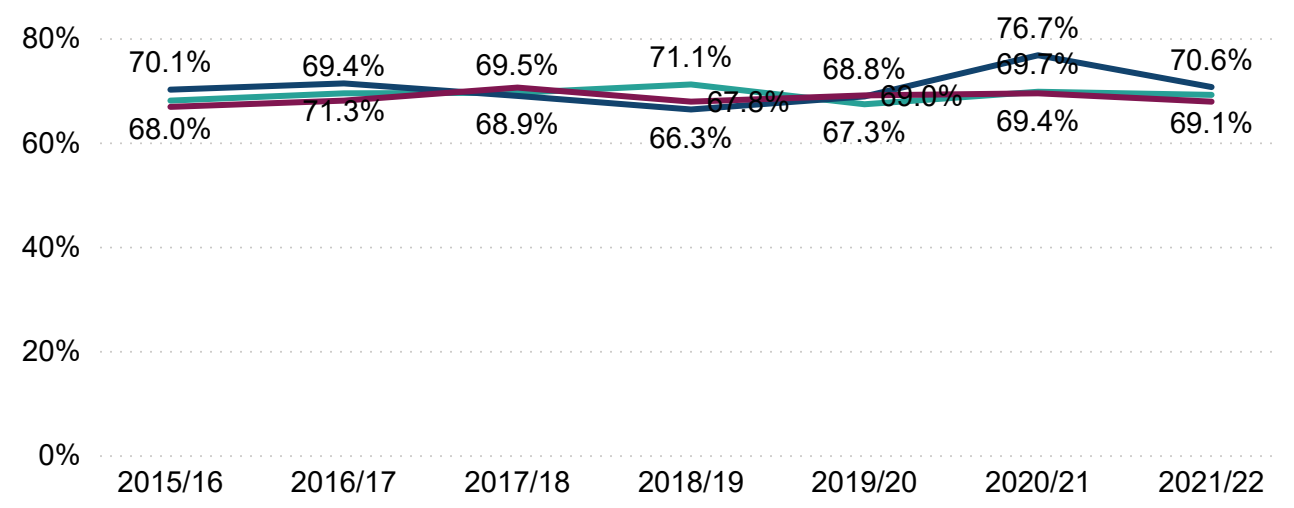

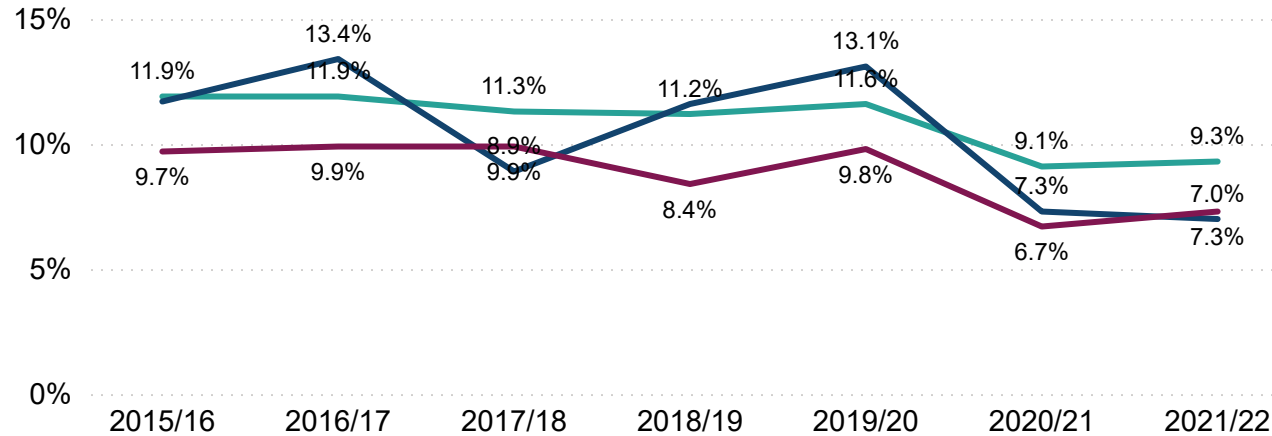

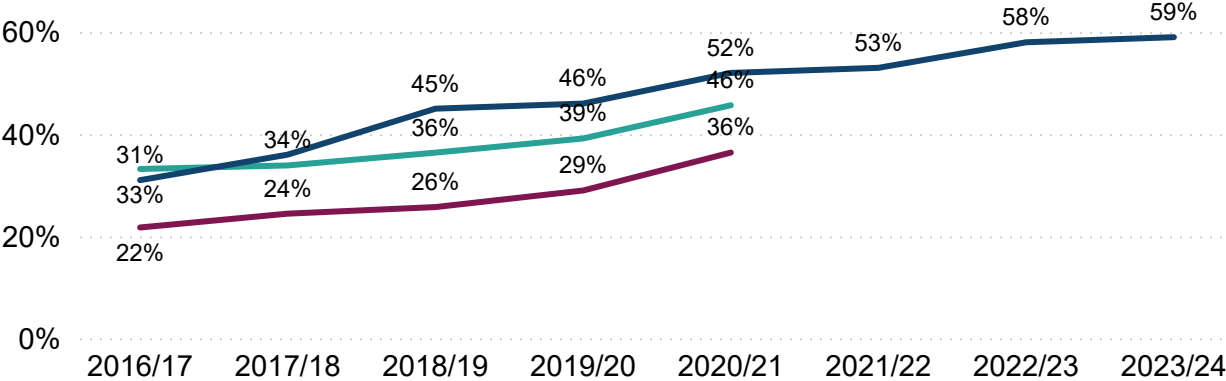

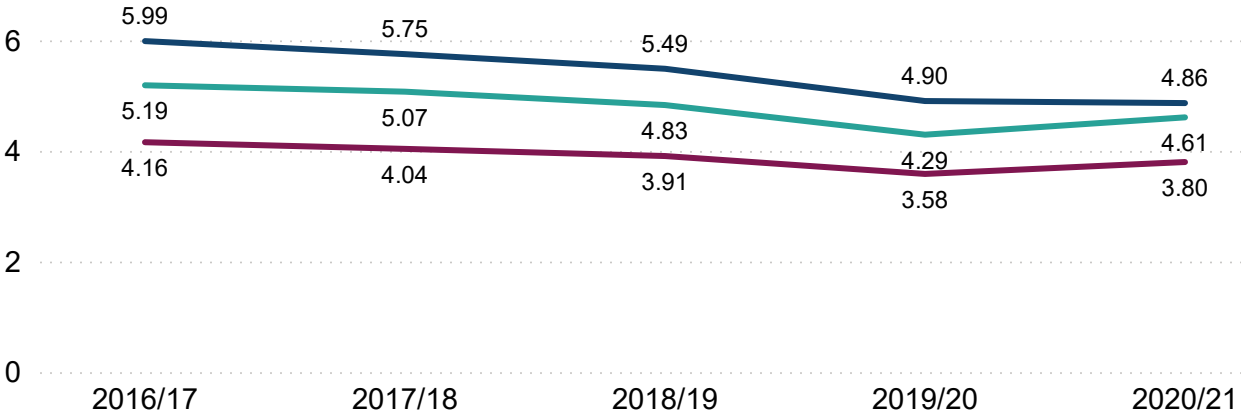


Per capita CO₂ emissions (tonnes)
