Tenders have included an updated social value question since April 2022, across all service areas within the authority. 70 of these tenders have been awarded to date.

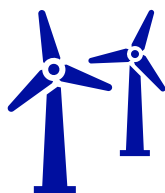
Each required at least one greener commitment to be made – working to support the authority's goal to be carbon net zero by 2030.

Over 80% of awarded tenders have required suppliers to set targets to reduce their tonnage of Carbon produced

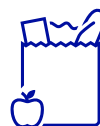


Key achievements



Over £182,000 offered to community projects within North Tyneside.

Over 1200 Suppliers and Service providers hours spent on school and college visits within North Tyneside. With an additional 180 staff hours donated internally.



Suppliers have donated £2,650 to help support Food partnerships

Contractors have worked to improve the life of the residents in sheltered accommodation by donating and installing defibrillators and improving communal outside spaces.



An intergenerational Art project has commenced in the PFI sheltered accommodation schemes. Two of the planned twenty-six events have taken place and involved the production of artwork by residents and pupils from local schools
