All licensing conditions will be adhered to.

CCTV is installed and operated and maintained. All CCTV videos will be available on request to the police and/or the council.

Warning notices will be displayed to advise CCTV is in operation.

Challenge 25 will be implemented for the sale of alcohol to any customers to ensure those under 18 are not served.

Health and Safety legislation will be adhered to ensure the safety of the public, as well as ensuring electrical and fire safety. For information please see attached plans.

b) The prevention of crime and disorder

- Adhere to the licensing conditions, authorised activities and hours.
- CCTV is installed, operated and maintained. CCTV Images will be retained for a minimum of 14 days and be produced on request pf the police or council. The CCTV system is operational at all times whilst the premises are trading.
- Warning notices advising that CCTV is in operation will be displayed in public areas and at the
 entrance.
- An incident book will be maintained within which full details of all occurrences of disorder and refused alcohol sales at the premises will be recorded. This will be kept on the premises at all times and made available for inspection by the council and the police if required.
- Challenge 25 will be implemented for the sale of alcohol to any customers.
- Service of alcohol both on and off premises will be refused to anyone who appears to be anyway under the influence of alcohol or drugs.
- No customers will be permitted to take open containers of alcoholic drinks from the premises.

c) Public safety

- Irresponsible drinks promotions will not be permitted.
- There will be no promotion of 'happy hours' on the premises.
- The licence holder or people authorised by them must check the premises before it opens to the public to ensure there are no risks to patrons and that all safety precautions are in place.
- The licence holder will ensure that all staff receive appropriate training about emergency and general safety precautions and procedures.
- The licence holder will ensure that all staff receive appropriate training about emergency and general safety precautions and procedures.
- The licence holder will ensure that all staff are aware of their social and legal obligations and their responsibilities regarding the sale of alcohol.
- Free drinking water will be made available at all times the premises is open to the public.
- The telephone numbers of local taxi operators must be prominently displayed at the premises for the benefit of customers.
- All bottles and glasses and rubbish will be removed from public areas on a regular and frequent basis
- The electrical system at the premises, including portable appliances will be inspected and tested annually by a competent person a suitably qualified electrician and a satisfactory safety report obtained (please see attached electric plans).

- All safety certificates and inspection reports will be kept on site and made available for inspection by officers of relevant statutory bodies.
- The fire safety measures provided on the premises will be maintained in good working order, and their adequacy will be determined on a regular basis, by the carrying out of a fire risk assessment (please see attached plans).
- An adequate and appropriate supply of first aid equipment and materials must be available on the premises.

d) The prevention of public nuisance

- The licence holder will ensure that staff regularly patrol the premises both indoors and out to supervise the orderly conduct of patrons.
- Prominent, legible notices requesting people to leave the premises and the area quietly will be displayed at all exists.
- The licence holder will control the volume of recorded music at the premises.
- No music will be played externally.
- All external doors and windows will be kept shut, other than for access.
- Where outside areas are provided for the use of patrons facilities for the disposing and collecting
 of litter will be maintained.
- To minimise the effect of littering, the applicant will provide litter bins both inside and directly outside the premises. During opening hours, and at the close of business, arrangement will be made for litter from the business to be collected from the immediate vicinity and stored inside the premises pending collection.
- Where drinks are going to be consumed in outdoor areas they will be served in plastic or toughened glass.

e) The protection of children from harm

- A proof of age policy will be enforced.
- Challenge 25 policy will be employed where those individuals who appear to be under the age of 25 attempting to purchase alcohol will be asked for identification.
