Background

- Several successful bids for National / Regional capital funding for sustainable transport infrastructure
 - Transforming Cities Fund (£198M regional award, NTC allocated £26.7M)
 - Four Lane Ends Bus Priority
 - Walking & Cycling Links to Metro (5 stations Whitley Bay, Northumberland Park, Shiremoor, Percy Main, Four Lane Ends)
 - North Shields Transport Interchange (inc. Riverside Embankment Walkway, Gateways, 3 strategic cycle corridors)
 - Active Travel Fund (Tranche 2)
 - A191 Rake Lane Corridor (Foxhunters to Norham Road, including "Dutch-style roundabout")
 - Middle Engine Lane (Cobalt to "Black Path")
 - Coast Road Crossings (Willington Square Slips)

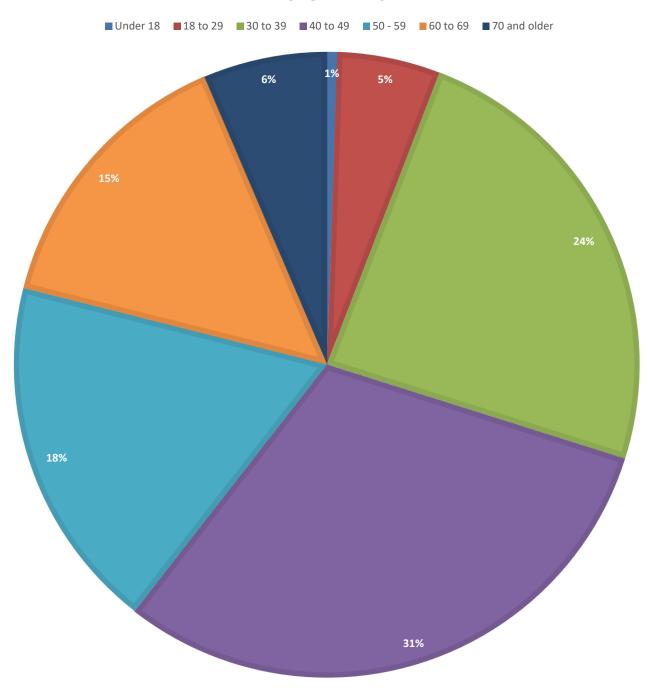


Background

- Routes identified for investment considered:-
 - Strategic Cycle Network / LCWIP
 - Propensity for modal shift of short journeys / forecast level of demand
 - Value for Money of investment / deliverability
 - Alignment with other funding opportunities (tie-in to S.278 / Regeneration schemes)

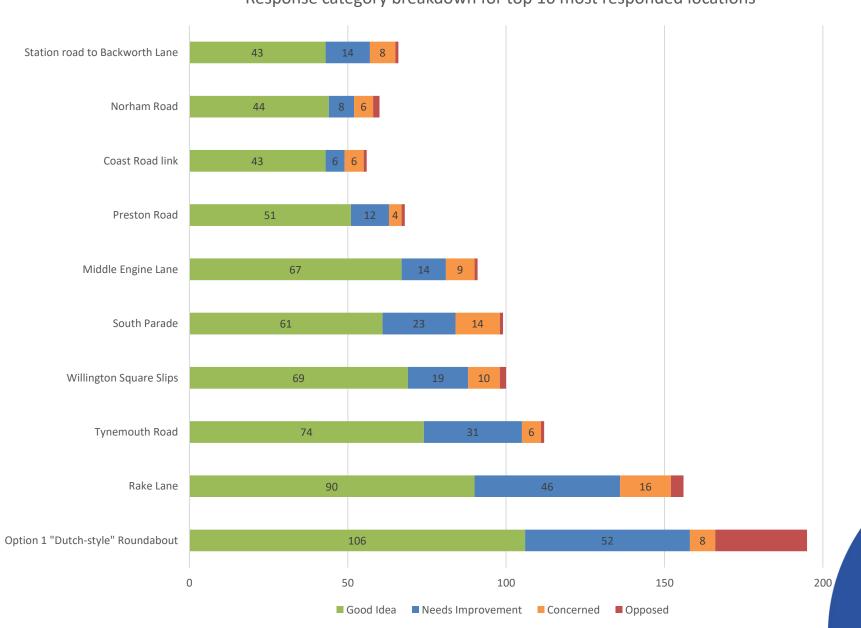

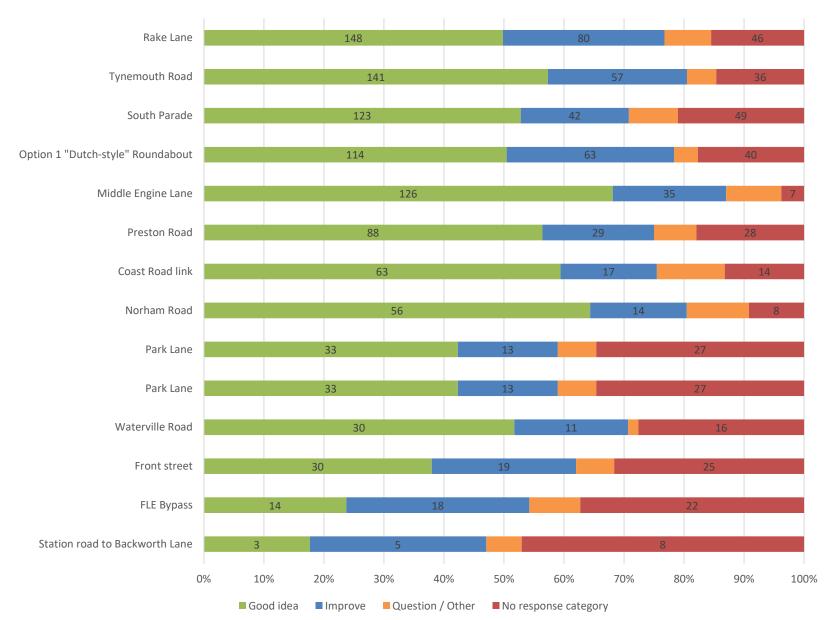
Response category breakdown for top 10 most responded locations

Focus - Dutch-style Roundabout

• 68% of cyclists thought it was a good idea, 27% thought it needed further improvement, 5% oppose it.

• 43% of drivers thought it was a good idea, 32% thought it needed further improvement, 25% oppose it.



Consultation - Themes

- Safety concerns raised regarding "dutch-style" roundabout, due to its uncommon priority arrangements and "driving standards of British motorists"
- Insistence that cycle routes should always be segregated without exception
- Concerns that some interventions may create/increase traffic congestion

Mostly constructive comments from which design modifications can be made

 Most "improve" comments made without consideration/constraint of budget/physical space
